# Serving the Breton Community for Over Half a Century

I was racking my brain for an interesting topic for this weeks Booster. When this happens, my go to source is the Ladder of Time, the community history book for Breton. While this publication is now forty years old, it gives us an insight into what the first fifty years of the Breton community looked like. It was with this in mind that I happened on two organizations who have faithfully served the Breton community for many decades, the Breton Elks Lodge #402 and the Breton Royal Purple Lodge #285.

The Breton Elks Lodge came into existence on March 22, 1956 with the ceremony of institution and installation of 59 charter members. While the article in the Ladder of Time does not go into great detail, it does indicate that the Lodge was very active in helping the community and have provided support for many projects over the years. In the early days of the Elks Lodge, a Christmas dinner for older, single men who had been involved in the logging industry and was provided at one of the local cafes. The Breton Elks helped sponsor the Breton Cadet Corp when they were active and for many years the Elks provided a bus for community groups to use. They also provided support to community members who had the misfortune to lose their homes due to fire.

When Elks Canada was found in 1912 it was a male only organization. In 1998, the Elks changed their constitution allowing both men and women to join the organization.

Today the Breton Elks are still serving the community as its members maintain the Breton RV Park, located at the Breton Golf course, and they have recently been busy doing upgrades at the RV Park. During the winter the Elks maintain the outdoor skating rink for use by the Breton community, which was used exten-

sively during this past winter when many other sources of recreation were shut down due to Covid 19 restrictions.

The sister organization to the Benevolent Order of Elks was the O.O.R.P., commonly known as the Royal Purple. The Breton Royal Purple was founded June 19, 1963 with 27 Charter members. Similar to the Elks, the Royal Purple have served the community in many ways, including providing catering services to the community for many years. Some of our readers may have had the Royal Purple cater for a family wedding. They have also raised funds in support of the Purple Cross Fund, supported fire victims in the community, and helped the Community Hall in many ways.

A salute goes out to the Breton Elks and the Breton Royal Purple, who have served and enriched their community for more than half a century.





While awaiting medical attention:


move the individual to a shaded area remove his or her outer clothing and shoes wrap the person in a wet towel until medical care is being provided.


