

Dear Editor:

Response to MLA Mark Smith Regarding Equalization Payments

I take issue with MLA Mark Smith's opening statement in the Thorsby Target of June 18, 2021. He states "For decades, Albertans have watched as their hard-earned tax dollars were seized by Ottawa and redistributed among other provinces under a system of Equalization that has siphoned wealth from our job creators and our provincial treasury."

Instead, I would suggest that for decades Albertans have enjoyed high employment rates and high incomes, thus leading to high income tax payments, both to the provincial and federal governments.

Alberta does not send a cheque to Ottawa; Albertans pay federal income tax. With part of this revenue, the federal government redistributes to all provinces, on a per capita basis, the Canada Health Transfer, the Canada Social Transfer and Equalization payments. The purpose of Equalization payments is to enable all provinces and territories to provide public services which are reasonably comparable to those in other provinces and territories.

We are Canadian citizens and we live in a federation. Surely, we expect all Canadians to have access to equal services and benefits, no matter our postal address. If a referendum on Equalization is to be held, we must be informed and think very carefully of the implications.





Thorsby Gets Its First Pride Crosswalk By Amissa Jablonski

The town of Thorsby got in the Pride spirit this year - all thanks to a 13-year old resident! Avari Myler-Goodwill, a young leader in our community, felt that she needed to give a voice and recognition to LGBTQ2S+ individuals in and around the area. To do so, she approached Town Council with a presentation on why it was important for Thorsby to install a rainbow crosswalk during Pride month. With the help and support of her mom and stepdad, dad and step-mom, and numerous friends and their families, Avari was successful in petitioning Council to allow for its installation. She and eleven of her friends, with the help of her mom and step-dad, then worked together to bring her vision to life in the intersection next to Ruhr Valley Lumber and the public works building.

In Canada and the United States, Pride month is celebrated in June to commemorate the 1969 Stonewall Riots in New York City. The Stonewall Riots were a series of demonstrations by the LGBTQ2S+ community in response to police raids on the Stonewall Inn targeting community members. In 1970, to commemorate the Riots, many American cities held Pride marches in an act of protest against anti-gay legislation and these marches morphed into parades over time. Now, we see Pride has evolved as a celebration of self-acceptance, legal milestones, and social acceptance for the LGBTQ2S+ community. Many people see it as a celebratory, carnival-style event but it is important to remember Pride's history rooted in persecution and protest.

Just as Pride has evolved over the years, so has the LGBTQ2S+ community's understanding of itself. For many years, the focus was on using the terms homosexual, gay, and lesbian. Now, understanding and terminology have expanded to include a wide variety of ways of life and being. The term used here, LGBTQ2S+, stands for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer or questioning, and two spirit (an Indigenous term), with the '+' referencing additional orientations and gender identities such as pansexual, asexual, intersex, gender fluid, and non-binary. While there are numerous and evolving words to use, the most important thing to remember is that anyone considering themself part of the community is a person, deserving of basic human rights and respect.

This was a huge theme and motivation for Avari. She feels that Thorsby has a long way to go to be a truly inclusive community for all people. The Pride crosswalk was just a small step in making that vision a reality. One of Avari's greatest worries was that the crosswalk would be damaged or defaced by those who espouse anti-LGBTQ2S+ views, especially in light of some of the hurtful conversations that have happened on local social media. It is her hope that Thorsby Junior/Senior High School will soon start a GSA - gay-straight alliance - that would ideally help with some of these attitidues. GSAs are vehicles for dialogue for students of ALL backgrounds, orientations, and gender identities. Research shows that schools with GSAs have reduced bullying overall and they help build more inclusive schools by creating communities of allies and understanding.

Additionally, Avari hopes that a GSA would be able to help make Pride more visible in Thorsby. It would allow for a vehicle for fundraising for future rainbow crosswalks (quality road paint, like that used in other communities for their crosswalks, is expensive) and other events associated with Pride. By increasing such events, Avari believes that her dream for a more inclusive Thorsby will come true. Ultimately, she hopes that her work in making this idea a reality will show people that if you truly believe in something, you should stand up for it - no matter the doubts or fears you might have, you need to take the first step in making our world a better place for everyone!
