The Taylors: A Family Of Pharmacists From John Elson

The Taylor family was first associated with Thorsby in the mid-to-late 1930's when William Bruce Taylor, then serving as a pharmacist's assistant at Allen's Drug in Leduc, appeared in a relief role at Allen's Drug in Thorsby (later owned by Joe Ruzicka). After finishing his apprenticeship (a program that no longer exists), he transferred to the University of Alberta, graduating with a B.Sc. (Pharmacy) in 1939. He then began his career with another pharmacist, Alex McDermid.

In 1951 Bruce bought half of Alex McDermid's pharmaceutical practice on Whyte Ave., Edmonton, after having worked there for several years. In 1962 Taylor's Pharmacy expanded to the shopping centre on 80th Ave, off 104th Street. Bob Taylor, son of Bruce, graduated in pharmacy from the U. of A.(1963) and had ready employment. The stage was now set for some important further developments.

As a new graduate, Bob worked these two stores for four years. In 1967 Taylor's Pharmacy expanded again, this time to Thorsby. Bob and his dad divided their time between Edmonton and the space they now shared with Dr. Myers Hankin. It was a joint enterprise as the Taylors purchased 2/3 of the store and Dr. Hankin 1/3 from the original owner. By Sept. 1967 the Whyte Ave. store was closed. The 80th Ave. store continued to thrive and served as a supply depot for Thorsby.

In 1971, Dr. Hankin passed away after selling his portion to the Taylors. Bob himself undertook the renovations as the pharmacy would now occupy the entire building. Twenty-six years later the old store was closed and a new one built on the corner of 49th Ave. and Hankin Street. Bob continued to serve the community until 2013 when he retired. For well over thirty years he was a volunteer with the Chamber of

Commerce and at the annual Sports Day. He also remembers the dusty gravel main street and a serious outbreak of bee stings that occurred one year. But far more importantly he remembers the annual Customer Appreciation Day and the most popular and delicious baking featured at the drug store. After forty-six years Taylor's Pharmacy was sold but the legacy of the Taylor family remains for posterity with the dedication of Taylor Park, situated on the site of the original store. Bob says: " I will never forget all the kindness given to me and the wonderful memories of my time in Thorsby".

Most striking is the fact that no fewer than seven members of the Taylor clan have been pharmacists. They are: Wm. Bruce Taylor (1910-2000), his brothers, Jim and Orville, his offspring Bob, Tom and Marilyn and his nephew Rob Taylor - an impressive roster.







News From Gayle Sacuta

In honour of the discovery of unmarked graves found outside residential schools in Canada, she donated to the Downie & Wenjack Fund, and purchased pins to further support the work of the foundation. Twenty pins were generously left at the library for any patron to keep.
