

Secure your cargo

As a driver, you are responsible for making sure the cargo you are carrying is secured to your vehicle.

- ▶ Use tie-down straps to properly secure objects.
- ▶ Place light objects lower in the container instead of on the top, to prevent them from exiting the container.
- ▶ Tie large items, like mattresses and construction equipment, directly to your vehicle with appropriate tie-down straps.
- ▶ Put loose items, like garbage and yard waste, in a covered container so they are easier to secure.
- Attach a safety flag to any items that extend beyond the back of your vehicle so they are more visible to other motorists.
- ▶ Place a tarp over loose items or those that billow in the wind to ensure they don't fall from your vehicle.
- ▶ If you are transporting earth, sand, gravel or other loose material, it must be at least 75 millimetres below the top of the container or your truck's box, and must be completely covered at all times.

TOWN OF THORSBY Council Meeting Notes

Committee of the Whole - March 22, 2022

Light at the School Crossing

There was some discussion with our MLA Mark Smith regarding the signalization at the School Crossing on Secondary 778. The Provincial Government is reluctant to work on it currently as there is a whole Provincial plan in the works. The council has directed the Mayor and Administration to inform the Black Gold staff of the current state.

Public Works Presentation by Andrew Kearley

Andrew Kearley presented a draft budget for Public Works. Many costs are unknown, but he presented what he thought were the most cost-effective decisions for the Town of Thorsby.

Donna Tona, Interim CAO

"Council requires time to deliberate the budget as a whole and to have time to consider all the figures before the final deliberation and passage of the Budget and the passage of the Tax Bylaw. As well, the Administration is proposing 2 meetings per month starting in May to facilitate work schedules and to make sure the agendas are substantive."

Thorsby Hotel Delegation - Special Event

Deepak Nair from the Thorsby Hotel made a presentation regarding a Motorcycle Event proposal in the summertime. Thorsby Hotel and Lone Wolf Mechanical have joined forces and would like to host this event for approximately 500 motorcyclists. They have proposed a 3 day event which includes a show and shine, pancake breakfast, live music, food vendors, and a satellite bar. It will be a fundraiser, yet to be determined and will be a family event.

The council had concerns about the logistics, security, lodging, policing, AHS, AGLC, permits, and licensing. More discussions will be held before a council decision will be made. Possibly a new by-law as well.

TURNED YOUR YARD INTO A MINEFIELD?

HAS YOUR DOG

Think about your yard. It's almost spring! You're excited to get in the yard. You go out in the back yard and cue the dreaded music.... Your dog has turned your yard into a mine field over the winter!

Here are some facts about DOG POOP. Did you know?

- Dog Poop Is Not Fertilizer
- It's an Environmental Pollutant
- It Carries Diseases
- It Can Overwhelm the Ecosystem
- It Smells Bad and You're Neighbours are complaining

How to Clean Dog Poop From Grass

For messier deposits, such as loose stool or dog diarrhea, one suggestion is using compressed air to freeze the stool before picking it up. You could also sprinkle a small amount of clumping cat litter on top of the poop, which will make it easier to get it all. Another recommendation is following up by spraying the spot with a commercial disinfectant to kill any bacteria or viruses that might get left behind — make sure to use one that is not harmful to your dog or keep them away from the area while it does its job. And be sure to wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water if there's any chance you've come into direct contact with animal feces.

LEDUC COUNTY MEETINGS NOTES

Please note that these notes are not an official record of Council meetings; official minutes are posted online once approved by Council.

March 8, 2022 Public presentation

David DeBruin and Richard Haas, with Voltarix Group, provided a public presentation related to the Creekside Solar Project located south of Calmar near the intersection of Township Road 494 and Range Road 271. As part of their presentation, David and Richard requested the following information be provided from Leduc County to Voltarix by March 31:

- A copy of the documentation where a Leduc County vote was taken in opposition of this project.
- A copy of the documentation where the Mayor was authorized to speak on behalf of the County.
- Requested Council to discuss the necessity of another meeting with Voltarix, and provide a date and agenda for an in-camera meeting, if requested.

Deputy Mayor Smith thanked the presenters and advised that administration would respond to their request.

Sponsorship request - Canadian Energy Museum

In June, it is the 75 anniversary of the Leduc #1 oil discovery. An anniversary event will take place on June 18 at the Canadian Energy Museum. A sponsorship request was submitted to Leduc County for event support. The sponsorship and grants committee reviewed the request and recommended a sponsorship of \$5,000.

Council approved the sponsorship request.

Public hearing: Alternate Advertising Bylaw 22-21 (second and third readings)

A public hearing was held at 1:15 p.m. for the Alternate Advertising Bylaw.

A report was provided by administration that shared the following information:

- On Dec. 14, 2021 Council provided first reading to the bylaw.
- The public hearing was originally scheduled for Feb. 8, but was deferred to March 8 to allow for a second round of public participation due to an omission in the

January advertisements.

- In October 2017, the Municipal Government Act (MGA) [s. 606(1)] was amended to allow municipalities' flexibility on mandated communication to residences by allowing for alternate advertising methods to meet local needs. This flexibility with notification methods allows for current and future technologies and allows municipalities to adapt their communication to meet local requirements.
- The introduction of this bylaw will ensure that posting to the County website is authorized as a method of official notification.

Next, registered speaker Karen Neilson provided a statement in opposition to the bylaw. Karen also submitted an additional letter from Michelle Mitchell for the record.

Next, registered speaker Kevin Neilson provided a statement in opposition to the bylaw.

Afterwards, staff member Renee Klimosko read into the record the letter submitted from Michelle Mitchell, which stated her opposition to the bylaw.

The public hearing concluded at 1:42 p.m.

Bylaw 22-21: Alternate Advertising

Bylaw 22-21 was given second and third readings.

Business Retention and Expansion (BRE) Feasibility Study project funding request

A recommendation was made for Council to approve funding for the BRE program and Business Retention Centre (BRC) facility pilot project in the amount of \$89,000 in 2022 and \$526,000 in 2023, for a total of \$615,000. This funding would extend the timeline of the project from one year to two years.

The funds would come from the special purpose operating reserve and administration will pursue additional grant opportunities to offset the draw from the reserve.

Council approved the funding request.

Tips to Stay on Track (Now that 2022 is No Longer the 'New Year')




