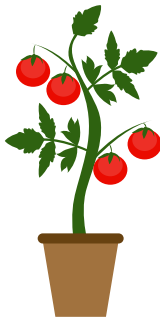

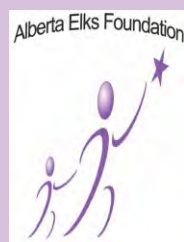

## HIGHLIGHTS

**Tax Rate Bylaw 1106-22**

Council adopted Bylaw 1106-22 to set the tax rate for 2022. There is no increase to municipal tax rates from 2021.

The bylaw leaves the tax rate at the 2015 level, for residential and farmland tax classes. It has not been increased since that time.

There is also a 30% rebate on municipal taxes for residential/farmland and commercial properties. The rebate is applied at the time of complete payment of taxes by June 30, and does not change the municipal tax rate. Those residents on the Tax Installment Payment Plan will have the rebate pro-rated on their payments.

**Support for Food Bank**

Council approved \$10,000 for the Drayton Valley Food Bank Society upon receipt of proof of purchase of new equipment, with funds from the General Operating Unrestricted Reserve.

**Support for 4-H Achievement Day**

Council approved an event grant of in-kind support of \$1,852 to assist with the set up and take down (including the removal of the straw and manure) at the Drayton Valley Omniplex for the Drayton Valley 4-H Beef Interclub's Achievement Day on May 30, and approved \$1,000 in funding to the club.

**Natural Burials**

Council directed Administration to apply to the Green Burial Society of Canada for the Green Burial Service Provider Category 1 designation within the Lodgepole Cemetery, to bring back the Cemetery Bylaw with the necessary changes, and bring back costing, including a communal memorial, for the 2023 budget process.

**Minister of Health meeting**

Council directed Administration to request a meeting with the Minister of Health to discuss concerns with physician recruitment and retention in the area.

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# Soul Care

A few days ago, my daughter asked me if we need to be honest all the time, or is it ok to say a little white lie sometimes? Worried a little, I asked her in what context she meant, and she explained that sometimes it feels better to lie to someone than to hurt someone's feelings.

This led us into a conversation about what it means to be honest and vulnerable. She wanted more explanation on the meaning of being vulnerable, so we explored the meaning which led me to Brene Browns' Ted Talks and her book *Daring Greatly*. Author, Brene Brown describes vulnerability as "uncertainty, risk, and emotional exposure." She shares that "it is that unstable feeling we get when we step out of our comfort zone to do something that forces us to loosen control."

Our conversation became larger than I had anticipated so we paused, and I just shared that being honest with each other is sometimes hard, but it is usually the best way, and if you are afraid of hurting someone's feelings, tell them that. Tell them you don't want to hurt them but need to share something that is on your heart. The key is to share it gently, kindly and with respect. And if you are still afraid that it will hurt them, just pray about it, and wait on God for the right time and opportunity. I am not sure if that was helpful or the right answer, but it is how I left it for now.

I did continue to reflect on the idea of being vulnerable. Being honest leads us to vulnerable spaces. It leads us to emotional risk, and it also creates the opportunity for emotional exposure. It also pushes us out of our comfort zones, and I do agree that it forces us to loosen control. Have you ever been in a vulnerable situation where you felt you needed to be honest and felt at risk? I think each of us have felt that at one time or another.

Many struggle to share the vulnerable side of ourselves. It feels too raw, to dangerous to be real. What if we are not accepted or liked? What if people disapprove of what we are sharing or feeling? Brene Brown shares that "vulnerability is at the core of shame, fear and struggle for worthiness." She also indicates that vulnerability is the core of joy, creativity and belonging.

We all hunger to belong, and in order to feel a part of something we need to be real and vulnerable. We need to be honest in who we are and there is no shame in that. I invite you to start to let go of what you think you need to say, do and be, and start being real with yourself. It is only when we start with ourselves that we are then able to be honest and vulnerable with each other. In that, we will find our belonging. The world is a better place when we are all real and living out our lives as intended by God. We are worthy and we belong, don't every feel like you don't. God created us. He knows us. We are his people. We belong to Him.

Psalm 100:3

Know that the Lord, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

### FREEDOM TO CHOOSE

You can believe that the green grass is pink all you want, but it will still be green. You could believe that the concrete sidewalk is a deep pool of water, but it will hurt if you dive in. You can believe in Santa, the Easter Bunny or a lifeless statue, but they won't save you from the punishment for sin. There is only one truth, one true and living God. You can imagine all sorts of things and believe them to be the truth, but your belief in them does not make them truth. You can even believe the governments religion which they call science, but it won't save you from covid, or any other sickness; nor will it help you learn about God's creation. There is a thing called truth. Truth doesn't change. According to Merriam-Websters Dictionary, truth is: "a (1) the body of real things, events and facts: ACTUALITY. (2) the state of being the case: FACT. (3) *often capitalized*: a transcendent fundamental or spiritual reality." God has given us the freedom to choose. We are free to believe whatever we want. He has given us authority and dominion on the earth, and He has created us in His image. God Himself even said, **"I call heaven and earth to witnesses against you this day, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live; that you may love the LORD your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, for He is your life and the length of your days;"** (Modern English Version Deut. 30:19-20). We have the freedom to choose, but our choices will determine whether we live a life filled with blessings or curses, life or death. God even gives us a suggestion. "Choose life." Choose to believe truth. **Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you remain in My word, then you are truly My disciples. You shall know the truth, and the truth shall set you free."** (John 8:31-32). There is a thing called truth, and if you believe and act on it you will be set free from the lies of the devil. **Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also. From now on you do know Him and have seen Him"** (John 14:6-7). Jesus is THE way, THE truth, and THE life. Only through Him can we access God the Father. **For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ. For it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith. As it is written, "The just shall live by faith."** The wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth through unrighteousness. For what may be known about God is clear to them since God has shown it to them. The invisible things about Him—His eternal power and deity—have been clearly seen since the creation of the world and are understood by the things that are made, so that they are without excuse. Because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him or give thanks to Him as God, but became futile in their imaginations, and their foolish hearts were darkened. Claiming to be wise, they became fools. They changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man, birds, four-footed beasts, and creeping things. Therefore God gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their own bodies among themselves. They turned the truth of God into a lie and worshipped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. For this reason God gave them up to dishonorable passions. Their women exchanged the natural function for what is against nature. Likewise the men, leaving the natural function of the woman, burned in their lust toward one another, men with men doing that which is shameful, and receiving in themselves the due penalty of their error. And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not proper. They were filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit. They are gossips, slanderers, God-haters, insolent, proud, boastful, inventors of evil things, and disobedient toward parents, without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, calloused, and unmerciful, who know the righteous requirement of God, that those who commit such things are worthy of death. They not only do them, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them (Rom. 1:16-32).

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Four significant legal challenges have been initiated against the federal government across the country. The Federal Court has granted the Government of Alberta's application to intervene on the non-constitutional issues, such as the unnecessary invocation of the *Emergencies Act*, since the province already had the legislative tools necessary to stop illegal blockades. Alberta has also advised the Federal Court of the province's participation on the constitutional issues that have been raised. With the court order allowing Alberta to intervene, Alberta will be involved in all issues raised before the court, constitutionally and non-constitutionally.

*"We will protect our province from the dangerous precedent set by the federal government in pointlessly invoking the Emergencies Act. Their decision to invoke the act violated the constitutionally guaranteed rights of Albertans, and all Canadians. It is our duty to do everything we can to protect Albertans' freedoms and liberties from this kind of breach. No government should have the power to seize a person's property or withhold access to their assets without due process of the law."*

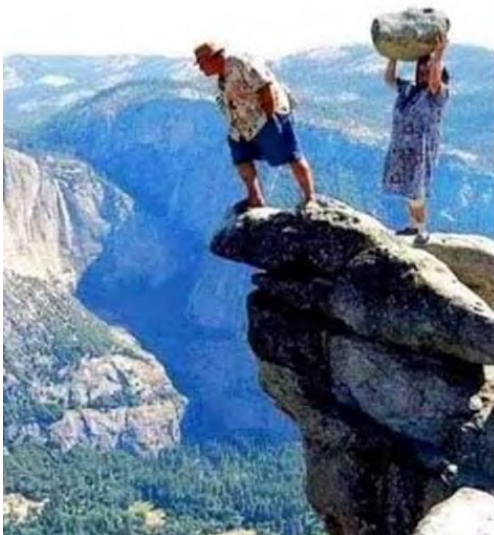
