### **UPDATE FROM MAYOR AND COUNCIL**

#### THE 2022 BUDGET IS PASSED!

At a Special Meeting of Council on April 24th, 2022 Council passed the 2022 Budget. It has been a tough 2.5 years with COVID and in 2020 Thorsby residents were provided temporary tax relief which we know helped many residents during a very tough pandemic.

Covid is now ebbing in its intensity and the Town of Thorsby is now back to full operating capacity which we are all very excited about as this means life is returning to normal.

The town is also facing challenges such as inflation, reduced Federal and Provincial funding and the requirement of the Province for all municipalities, no matter their population, to pay for RCMP Policing, which are a valuable and necessary support in our community.

With all these changes and pressures, we were able to mitigate an increase no greater than the rates prior to Covid. Residents will see their taxes go back to the 2019 Rates in 2022; with a small addition to cover the RCMP levy by the province.

Administration has worked hard to keep costs down by finding efficiencies within the organization and only engaging in projects that are absolutely necessary at this time as to not burden the ratepayers further because we understand the pressures everyone is facing.

The average residential taxpayer will see an increase. This translates to a 26% increase and an approximate \$490.00 increase on the average household.

We would also like to remind you about our monthly payment option that is available to help spread the cost out over the year. Please contact the Town office for more information.

## TOWN OF THORSBY REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING NOTES

by Carol Rempel

#### May 24, 2022

- For Spring Cleanup two large bins are placed north of Westower from May 24- May 31 for items such as paint, light bulbs, batteries, metal, electronics etc. A list will be posted on site
- In 2016 a trust fund called Senior's Managing Funds was set up for transportation and program planning in the amount of \$27,812. Administration recommends Council approve the funds to be released back to the seniors.
- June was proclaimed Pride Month across Canada. Pride Month is meant to educate and identify key issues that affect LGBTQ people, as well as tell the storied history of how far Canada has come to accept LGBTQ citizens.
- Staff Sergeant Moore from the Thorsby RCMP detachment provided quarterly reports for Administration and Council in order to update on actions taken, and community trends. These reports are intended to provide transparency, education, and encourage questions from Council and Administration. It was recommended that Staff Sergeant Moore be invited to a future Council meeting.
- The Interim CAO and CFO contracts are up at the end of May. It was moved that the Council extend their contracts to September 2022.
- The Tax Bylaw 2022-04 was presented and approved by the council. The Tax Bylaw 2022-04 must be passed before the end of May every year so that taxes can go out June 1st in keeping with legislation. The Tax notices will be sent out at the end of the month. The tax rate will go back to the mill rate of 2019.
  - The 2022 budget is passed. It has been a tough 2.5 years with COVID and in 2020 Thorsby residents were provided temporary tax relief which helped many residents during a very tough pandemic.
  - The Town is facing challenges of inflation, reduced Federal and Provincial funding and the requirement of the province for all municipalities, no matter their population, to pay for RCMP policing, which are a valuable and necessary support in our community.

- Administration has worked hard to keep costs down by finding efficiencies within the organization and only engaging in projects that are absolutely necessary at this time so as to not burden the ratepayers further because we understand the pressures everyone is facing.
- There is a monthly payment option that is available to help spread the cost out over the year. Please contact the Town office for more information.





On May 10, 2022, the Warburg Pembina Surface Rights Group recognized a long-time activist for surface rights issues. Karl Zajes was honoured by the Provincial Government, Leduc County, and Brazeau County. Kudos to Karl for his unselfish and tireless efforts for the benefit of landowners for 42 years. In his words, "No one will be refused help, even if not a member."

Background by former president Frank Block

The group was started in the fall of 1980 with a packed hall, standing room only. The meeting was originally set up to get industry to understand why landowners needed to have lease rental increases. It was agreed to include the whole County of Leduc with a membership cost of \$50 lifetime membership. The first meeting saw 100 members sign up; since then the membership has grown to include members from all across the surrounding Counties and present count is over 800 members. Nobody will be refused assistance, member or not, if the need arises. The group meets every second Tuesday of the month at the Warburg Community Hall

The purpose of the group today is to provide a library of information on how landowners can obtain information on how to deal with industry. The group has regular speakers from Alberta Surface Rights Board, the Farmers Advocate Office, the Alberta Energy Regulators Office and other government agencies.

The first president was Gene Begg (1980-1981); Frank Block (1981-1988); Karl Zajes (1988-2015); Vant Hayes (2015-2016); Karl Zajes (2016-present)



#### GET TO KNOW AHS EMS DURING NATIONAL PARAMEDIC SERVICES WEEK

National Paramedic Services Week (May 22-28, 2022) honours the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) profession and recognizes the professionals who provide this vital public service. This year, through social media and other digital opportunities, AHS is offering a behind the scenes look at the work of EMS within the healthcare system and our communities.

AHS EMS operates 515 ground ambulances in Alberta, plus 11 medical aircraft. Approximately 5,600 EMS staff and paramedics respond to more than 589,000 911 events each year, or about 1,600 calls each day.

Our frontline responders are also active in Public Education and Emergency and Disaster Management Response, when Albertans need emergency medical assistance on a large scale.

Paramedics are often the very first point of contact for a patient entering the healthcare system and while most Albertans would be familiar with EMS 911 response, AHS EMS paramedics offer services to patients in a variety of ways, including:

- Incident Response Paramedics (IRP), who can offer specialized care during large scale or extended incidents, such as structure fires, as well as care for patients who may have suffered from contamination, such as carbon monoxide or chemical exposures.
- Flight Paramedics provide air medical care to patients requiring immediate acute care during transfers between larger centres as well as transfers of other ill or injured patients who require movement to a higher acuity facility. Airport Paramedics at both Calgary and Edmonton International Airports also provide emergency medical support to travelers and use specially equipped Segways for rapid response.
- Tactical Emergency Medical Support (TEMS)
  paramedics work with law enforcement to
  provide immediate advanced life support care
  during high-risk police operations.

- Community Paramedics are specially trained to provide short-term treatment for patients in their own homes under the medical direction of Physicians and Nurse Practitioners. This can include antibiotic administration, blood transfusions, and hydration therapy.
- Emergency Communications Officers (ECOs) answer 911 requests for EMS service and initiate the EMS emergency response to the scene; they also provide pre-arrival instructions (PAIs) over the phone such as how to perform CPR or relieve a choking emergency, or assist with childbirth.
- Rapid Access Paramedics (RAP) who respond on specially equipped mountain bikes to provide first response advanced life support in congested and crowded areas, such as events and festivals, where standard vehicle access may be challenging.

Many groups and individuals within EMS also provide vital support services, including Clinical Educators and the Vehicle Equipment Supply Service Technicians (VESST).
