As part of the summer staff, the Lifeguard is also responsible for maintaining a safe waterfront environment while campers participate inwaterfront activities. These programs will usually be led by the programmers, however, certain programs may be designated as counselor-led.

Qualifications:

- . Must be at least 18 years of age
- · Must have an interest in working with young people
- Current National Lifesaving Society (N.S.) and Aquatic Emergency Care (AEC) certification
- Related education or experience working with young people
- · Experience living away from home, or in a communal setting would be an asset. There is the ability to live on site for the duration of the camp.

Lifeguard Responsibilities:

- Maintain a safe waterfront environment. This includes removing debris or waste from the lake, ensuring that an appropriately sized swimming area is clearly delineated with a buoy line and "No Boat" signs, and securing the beach with "lifeguard not on duty" sign when the waterfront is not in use.
- · Work with programmers to ensure that all canoes, paddles, life jackets and other waterfront equipment is kept in excellent condition and properly stored.
- · Explain the waterfront rules prior to each water related activity.
- Use appropriate life guarding techniques to ensure swimmer or canoeist safety. This includes maintaining the N.S. prescribed ratio of 1:40.
- Be aware of the swimming ability of each person involved in waterfront activities prior to any waterfront activities.
- Understand emergency waterfront procedures. This includes proper maintenance and storage first aid kit (assembled in conjunction with the staff). In the event of an actual emergency, the lifeguard will be responsible for necessary duties.
- Work with the director to ensure that each staff member understands their role during a water safety emergency.
- Make final decision to proceed with canoeing, swimming, or water activities based on weather.

ITS GRASS CUTTING SEASON EVERYONE

Summer is in full swing in the Town of Thorsby and the grass is growing very quickly.

We are asking everyone to maintain and cut their grass regularly (10 cm height) on their respected properties throughout the summer months. Many questions are coming up about dandelions on private properties and what can be done about it. We won't force anyone to spray as its up to everyone's own personal choice, but we ask that you maintain regular grass cutting on your property and boulevard. This will control the spread of seed spores and will make your neighbor very happy. Remember Dandelions are not a noxious weed and are food for Beekeepers Bees.

When you are cutting the grass, we also ask that you keep the grass cuttings on your property or the boulevard only. We want to remind residents and businesses that grass cuttings can not be left on the sidewalk. We also ask that you do not shoot the grass cuttings onto the street as that can cause challenges to our storm water drains and gutter flows. We all pay to have the streets cleaned and looking their best, so it makes sense that we all do our part to eliminate additional debris on the streets throughout the season.

If you have lawns that are creeping onto the sidewalk, please cut back the sod to the edge. This is part of

regular required yearly maintenance that helps users of the sidewalk have full access to the sidewalk to walk on or those with a walker or wheelchair. Eliminating tripping hazards from the sod on the sidewalk is important to all users in the community.
