MECCS & NEW HUMBLE CHARTER SCHOOL Making Professional Connections

from Mother Earth's Children's Charter School Newsletter
June 2022

Since we are a small school, it can be challenging for us to create meaningful professional development opportunities. Recently staff at MECCS and New Humble Charter School, near Calmar, decided to partner up and plan a day together. Even though our two schools are very different, we embraced that and shared our gifts with each other. We opened the day with a smudge and prayers in Cree and Stoney. The morning continued with MECCS teacher Mark Ehnes leading an introduction to traditional Indigenous games and explaining how to use them in the classroom. Mark is a trained instructor in teaching traditional Indigenous games, both indoor and outdoor. Mark then demonstrated to participating staff how to gather resources locally and make the equipment needed for these games. He taught the New Humble staff games that they would be able to do at their school, including

- Double Ball, using sticks to get a handmade ball into the goal
- Shinny, using sticks that look like the ones used in field hockey and a handmade ball
- Ring the Stick
- Salish Hoop and Dart, using spears to try to throw through rolling hoops
- Tie Up, which can be played inside or outside

A highlight of this session was when Mark showed everyone his medicine blanket with display pieces and resources for some of the games. After a short break, we learned about Indigenizing Education from MECCS teacher Maxine Hildebrandt.

The morning concluded with a tour of our culture camp/outdoor classroom area Oski Kisikaw Ena Mahkochih. The name is a combination of Cree and Stoney words that roughly translate to "New Day for Mother Earth."

The New Humble Charter School staff saw how we can use our outdoor culture camp for activities like making dry meat, holding ceremonies, and teaching Cree and Stoney language classes. They also saw how the outdoor classroom shelter and tipi can be incorporated into our teaching. Maxine

explained how our students built their own outdoor shelters.

After lunch, it was the New Humble staff's turn to share. They walked us through a number of their projects. From their egg-hatching project to their Humble Hooves program, they are passionate about hands-on learning and being connected to the land from the perspective of agricultural stewardship.

It was great to make connections, create another partnership, and share similarities and differences between our two programs. We are looking forward to continuing to build on this partnership in years to come.

The Judgment Is in Your Favour

If you believe in Jesus as your Lord and Saviour, the judgment is in your favour. Jesus is the righteous judge, and He has declared that you are free from the punishment for sin, because you are now righteous. **“He Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness. ‘By His wounds you were healed’”** (Modern English Version, 1 Peter 2:24). Now that we have accepted Him as our Lord, we get the benefit of the sacrifice that He made for us. **“But now, apart from the law, the righteousness of God is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets. This righteousness of God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all and upon all who believe, for there is no distinction. For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God has set forth to be a propitiation through faith, in His blood, for a demonstration of His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins previously committed, to prove His righteousness at this present time so that He might be just and be the justifier of him who has faith in Jesus”** (Rom. 3:21-26). We are innocent and have no need to fear God’s judgment if we continue to follow Him as Lord. Jesus said **“The Father judges no one, but has committed all judgment to the Son, that all men should honor the Son, just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him. Truly, truly I say to you, whoever hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has eternal life and shall not come into condemnation, but has passed from death into life”** (John 5:22-24). Paul wrote in his book to the Romans, **“There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, who walk not according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set me free from the law of sin and death”** (Rom. 8:1-2). Jesus has judged us to be free from the punishment for sin, and He has judged us to be free from sickness. In Matthew chapter 12 Jesus healed a man with a withered hand in the temple. Then He went out and was followed by a multitude of people, and He healed them ALL. Then Matthew quotes a prophecy from Isaiah chapter 42 to indicate that the healings Jesus did are a judgment to victory. Here is his quote of the prophecy, **“Here is My Servant, whom I have chosen, My Beloved, in whom My soul is well pleased; I will put My Spirit upon Him, and He will render judgment to the Gentiles. He shall not struggle nor cry out, nor will anyone hear His voice in the streets. A bruised reed He will not break, and a smoldering wick He will not quench, until He renders judgment unto victory; and in His name will the Gentiles trust”** (Mat. 12:18-21). Psalms 103:6 says, **“The Lord does righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed”**. Please read all of Psalm 103. God is not judging you by making you sick. His judgment is that you are healed and free!! Jesus healed All the sick in the multitudes of people. He NEVER made anyone sick. Acts 10:38 **“How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.”** Notice that the infirmities which Jesus healed are referred to as oppression of the devil. The infirmity came from the devil. If you believe in Jesus as your Lord and Saviour, He has declared a judgment of freedom and victory for you!!

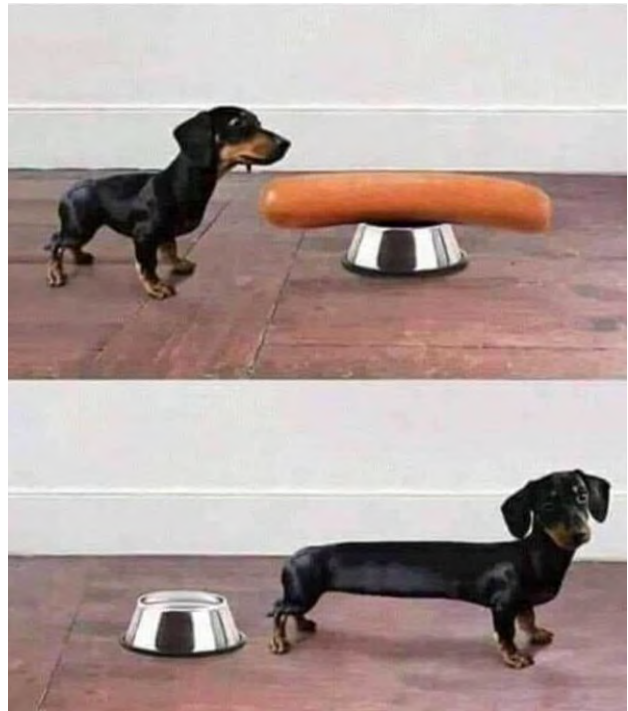
