TES STUDENTS JOIN IN INDIGENOUS DAY CELEBRATION AT RUNDLE'S MISSION

"A day of celebration, learning and sharing" describes the activities at Rundle's Mission on National Indigenous Peoples Day, Tuesday June 21st. Over 100 people attended the event which was organized by Rundle's Mission Society. The grade 5 students from Thorsby Elementary School, accompanied by their teachers Mrs. Maxwell and Mr. Warren, came for the day. They arrived first thing in the morning on the school bus and participated in activities relating to the history of Rundle' Mission, the Indigenous connection and the natural location there. Students learned about Cree Syllabics and had the opportunity to make their own wood pendant with syllabics on it. Later in the morning, members of the public arrived and everyone gathered on the hillside to hear Elder Holly Johnson from Samson Cree explain the significance of the tipi and each pole. While she explained the Indigenous teachings, men put the canvas on the tipi and secured it to the ground. This was followed by a blessing by Elder Lester Brown and the sharing of food as a traditional feast. Following the feast, guests were entertained with some traditional dances. Shirley and Eva Atkinson, former students at TES, jingle danced and many people commented on their dresses. Guests were also entertained by 5 year old twins from Masckiwicis. Kalaya Buffalo Jingle Danced and Alyrika Buffalo showed us her Fancy Shawl dance, both in beautiful dancing outfits.

A hearty thank you to all who helped make the day a success – the folks from Samson band, Rundle Mission staff and volunteers and the staff from Leduc County Parks and Recreation.

Rundle Mission invites you to come to the lake, see the tipi, learn the history and explore the trails and amenities of Rundle Mission. It is a wonderful meeting place!



What we are finding in the community:

- Vehicles that are parked on the boulevard
- Holiday trailers that are parked on the boulevard, street and alley

- keep grass inside the edge of the boulevard, or property line to avoid creeping on the sidewalk, curbs, or street. (10 cm)
- Do not blow grass onto the streets and sidewalks. If you do, please remove it from our paved streets as it affects our drainage.
- Please keep holiday campers and utility trailers parked in your driveway or at the back of your property. They can not be parked on the public street and must always remain attached to a vehicle.

TOWN OF THORSBY COW MEETING NOTES

- The Chamber of Commerce sign will stay at the north entrance and is earmarked for some updating. Previous Council and administration were going to tear it down to put up a digital sign purchased in 2021 but the new Chamber of Commerce appealed to our CAO and Council to find a new location. The sign belongs to the Chamber and the Chamber pays the electrical bill. According to Alberta transportation, the new digital sign is not allowed to face Highway 39 or have phone numbers or emails. It is for community events only. Council is now looking to place the digital sign at the entrance of the Industrial Park upon approval of Alberta Transportation.
- Warburg has invited our community to participate in Heritage Days on June 25th.
- Administration is in the process of populating the new portal program with agendas and minutes and preparing it for public release. The portal also functions as a digital way for Councilors to take and keep on-line versions of notes, and have the ability to send live notes between staff and councilors that are also using the online version. Administration hopes that this program will allow for better transparency with the public and will help to move towards reducing the amount of paper waste each month. This program was included in the administrative section of the 2022 Budget.
- The senior's centre parking lot project of paving is complete after working with Select Engineering and the Town of Thorsby after receiving a grant.
- The Administration and the Town of Thorsby is working diligently at selling our raw water. They are working very closely with the Water treatment contractors as they sit on boards that understand our needs and requirements about water. These enhancements and business practices will bring revenue to the Town. Once we have the grant structures locked down for application more information will be forthcoming.
- Bylaw is continually working with residents on their grass cutting, dandelion spraying, boulevard and roadway obstruction requirements, and searching for contractors to address unsightly areas. Many areas are

- documented that require grass cutting and working with Administration to find Property Owners of unmaintained properties. As per the budget, littering signs and Dog waste dispensers and bags will be located in strategic areas in the community.

Reply:

Ms. Rachel Bendayan (Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Tourism and Associate Minister of Finance, Lib.):

"Mr. Speaker, this week, the Conservatives proposed a number of economic policies. One of them was an order to cancel our price on pollution. A price on pollution, we know, is the most effective way to tackle climate change. The other was to give oil and gas companies a break by dropping the GST. The GST works in this country in the following way: The government taxes the oil and gas companies, and the oil and gas companies pass that tax onto consumers. If we drop the GST on oil and gas companies, there is absolutely no guarantee that Canadian consumers will see any benefit at the pumps. It is a tax reduction on oil and gas companies, pure and simple."

ELECTRICITY REBATES TO START ARRIVING ON JULY **BILLS**

Beginning in July, almost two million Albertans will receive rebates on their electricity bills to help them manage high electricity costs.

More than 1.9 million homes, farms and small businesses will receive monthly credits of \$50 on their July, August and September electricity bills, for a total of \$150 in rebates.

The Alberta government's \$300-million rebate program will help alleviate some of the high utility costs that many families and businesses have faced during recent months.

Quick facts

- All utility customers currently connected to the electricity system that have consumed electricity within the past calendar year, up to a maximum of 250 megawatt hours per year, are automatically eligible for the rebates.
- Consumers will receive the rebate as a credit to their electricity bills from the utility provider that provides their electricity.
- The rebate will appear as an individual line item on the electricity bill as the "GOA Utility Commodity Rebate."
- Consumers will receive \$50 each month for three consecutive months, with most rebates starting to show on July's electricity bills.
