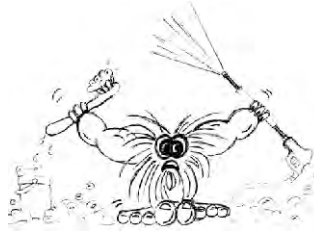

Bylaw 22-06 Animal Control Bylaw

Please take notice that at the August 10th, 2022 Council Meeting for the Village of Breton first reading was given to Bylaw 22-06 Animal Control Bylaw to provide for the licensing, regulation, confinement and control of animals.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, M-26, 2020 and amendments thereto, Section 7 (h) provides that a council may pass bylaws respecting to wild and domestic animals and activities in relation to them.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Breton deems it necessary to provide for the regulation of livestock, adding Urban Hens Program to the Animal Control Bylaw.

Definitions

2.8 “Hen” for the purpose of this bylaw shall mean a female chicken

2.9 “Pullet” a female chicken less than 1 year old

5. Urban Hens Program Ownership Requirements

5.1 A person must not keep hens unless registered in the Urban Hen Program.

5.1.1 An applicant in the Urban Hen Program must be 18 years of age or older.

5.1.2 An applicant must read and adhere to SCHEDULE E Urban Hens Program – Requirements and Best Practices attached to this Bylaw.

5.1.3 An application, including the first annual licensing fee, must be submitted and approved by the Village. Application form, SCHEDULE F attached to this Bylaw.

5.1.4 Urban Hen licensing fees are annually renewable and must be paid by January 31st of each year. Late registrations after January 30 with result in a \$5.00 late payment fee.

5.2 The Owner of an Animal is guilty of an offence if the Animal:

5.2.1 If a complaint is registered with the Village or Municipal Enforcement, an officer may attend the residence of a participant at their own discretion; an appointment will not be required.;

5.2.2 Participants must not exceed the keeping of four (4) hens.

5.2.3 Participants must keep the coop in good repair and in a sanitary condition.

5.2.4 Proper care and feeding practices must be followed to ensure the well-being of the hens.

5.2.5 Keeping hens when not registered in the program is prohibited

5.2.6 Participants must keep hens for personal use only. The selling of eggs, manure, meat or other products derived from the hens is prohibited.

5.2.7 The slaughter, or attempt to euthanize of hens, except by a veterinarian, within Village limits is prohibited.

5.2.8 Hens must not be permitted to run at large

5.2.9 If a complaint is registered with the Village Enforcement, an officer may attend the residence of a participant at their own discretion; an appointment

The proposed bylaw can be reviewed at length at the Village Office, 4916 – 50th Avenue Breton, AB. The next meeting of Council will be held on Wednesday September 14th at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers of the Carolyn Strand Civic Centre.

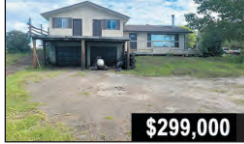

GRANDPARENTS SCAM CONTINUES - BE AWARE

There have been multiple stories about the Grandparents Scam and we hear more every day. Please protect yourself or your grandparents by making them aware.

Here is a news release about someone finally getting arrested but there are more of them out there.

On July 29, 2022 St. Albert RCMP received a call from a concerned grandparent, that their grandchild was in custody and they had been asked to pay bail of \$9800. The grandparent was waiting at their residence with the money for someone to attend to collect the bail money. St. Albert RCMP recognized the situation as the "grandparent scam" and attended the residence where an 18 year old male, Issa LOPEZ of North York, Ontario was arrested and charged with the following:

- Fraud over \$5000
- Fraud under \$5000

St. Albert RCMP were able to assist in preventing this victim from losing any money, and also identified a second victim, recovering \$4000 that the additional victim had paid to Lopez, for their "grandchild's bail". St. Albert RCMP were able to return the \$4000 to the victim.

Lopez was released on bail with conditions and his next court appearance is September 12, 2022.

RCMP would like to advised the community that jail money can only be paid at a police station or at a court house, and would like community members to contact their grandparents and/or parents to notify them of this to assist in the prevention of further frauds.

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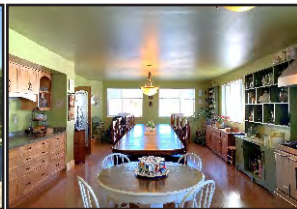
