Dianne Hunter (pictured on the left) a local Warburg area resident competed in the Canadian Archery Outdoor Nationals in P.E.I. July 21-24. She brought home the following medals:

- 3D archery - Silver
- Field archery - Gold
- Target archery - Bronze

Here is her story about the trip to P.E.I..

“Air Canada did not deliver my bows until the 3rd day of 3D archery unknown yardage, just in time for me to shoot the shoot out portion of the competition. We shoot up to 50 yards.

There was a gentleman named Duncan who lent me a bow so that I could compete. I had 6 hours to get it tuned to me and sighted in. He spent the time and cares deeply for the sport. He is from Covewood, P.E.I..

They had a new format for the field target competition with unknown yardage and known yardage. Challenging and a shoot off the next day.

Target archery has heavy completion with an elimination round. My opponent and I shot point for point and still tied. We had a one arrow tie breaker and I won with the arrow closest to the center”.

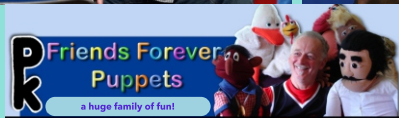

JULY HIGHLIGHTS

July 10 th , 2022 Area of Leduc County - RCMP received a report of a male uttering threats to a property owner. RCMP attended and located the male who was arrested on 14 outstanding warrants, and 9 new charges. A hearing was conducted with the Justice of the Peace and the male was remanded.

July 11 th , 2022 Area of Breton - RCMP conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for stunting/driftng. Breath samples were obtained leading to the youth driver having their license suspended for 30 days, the vehicle seized for 7 days and a \$200 fine.

July 12 th , 2022 Area of Buck Lake - RCMP, with the assistance of the Crime Reduction Unit, assisted in an ongoing investigation leading to two individuals being arrested on numerous charges and outstanding warrants. One female was released on cash bail, and one male was remanded.

July 16 th , 2022 Area of Leduc County - Police conducted a traffic stop along Highway 39 for a truck and trailer with no brake lights or turn signals. The vehicle was confirmed stolen and the driver was arrested on scene. Police issued violation tickets, and the vehicle was towed.

THE FUTURE OF POLICING IN ALBERTA

Albertans can learn about what the future of provincial policing may look like through a new website.

The www.futureofABpolicing.ca site provides the public with information about the opportunities a new provincial police service could bring, including improved civilian oversight, more front-line police officers and better service levels across the province.

“Albertans have told us they want more details about the potential benefits of a provincial police service. As all levels of governments across the country review their policing models, Albertans need to have all the information available to ensure they lead this national discussion and make sure the future of policing in the province meets their needs.” Tyler Shandro, Minister of Justice and Solicitor General

While no decisions have been made on proceeding with an Alberta police service, the government is doing the due diligence it promised by going directly to Albertans to talk about this public safety topic.

Municipal and First Nations police services

Currently, a number of municipalities and First Nations have their own police services and others are exploring the possibility of setting up their own. Alberta’s government supports this work and has established a grant to support municipalities and First Nations as they explore the possibility of forming their own police service.


In addition to increasing the number of officers in rural areas, transitioning to a provincial police service would improve governance and give municipalities more say in setting their own policing priorities. This model would also provide greater coverage, reduce response times and lower case loads per officer.

Quick facts

- Alberta hired PwC Canada in October 2020 to study the feasibility of transitioning to a provincial police service.
- Their report found many opportunities associated with this transition and offered options for how a future provincial police service would look.
- Under the current RCMP contract, policing is the same for all eight provinces, three territories and several municipalities that use these services and provides little opportunity for local input to meet their needs.
- The federal government has indicated that there are sustainability issues across the whole of the RCMP. The prime minister recently directed Public Safety Canada to conduct a review of RCMP contract policing.
- Several provinces and municipalities that currently use RCMP contract policing are considering alternative policing models.



The Warburg Seed Cleaning Co-op started in 1964 when farmers in need of a better way of cleaning their seed and controlling the spread of weed seeds got together to raise 1/3 of the funds needed to build the plant. The other 2/3 of the funds came from Leduc County and the province of Alberta. In the early years, the main business was just seed cleaning. Over the years, the business has grown to include Forage seed sales, grass seeder rentals, canola gathering point for Canbra Foods which eventually was taken over by Richardson Pioneer, obtained more land for our bin yard which meant we could offer more varieties of seed to sell, ring road to accommodate the large trucks and trailers. Warehouse so we could better handle forage seed and tote bags. It also gave us a better place to conduct repairs and storage. Part of the warehouse also serves as AWSA compliant herbicide storage for chemical sales. 2010 saw the installation of an optical sorter and a new wind & screen. The color sorter was a major advancement to grain cleaning. In the past few years, the plant has seen some major updates, such as a new gravity table, a 4000 bu. bin for incoming seed storage, 6000 bu. of overhead clean seed storage, the addition of a 90 foot truck scale and a new color sorter with true color and infrared cameras for even more advanced cleaning capabilities. We also added a roller mill and blender for feed sales so we can offer a variety of feed grains in small 50-pound bags, mini bulk bags or bulk.
