

# ORANGE SHIRT DAY

The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation known as Orange Shirt Day on September 30 is a Canadian statutory holiday to recognize the legacy of the Canadian Indian residential school system.

The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation was first established as an observance in 2013, as part of an effort to promote awareness and education of the residential school system and the impact it has had on Indigenous communities for over a century. The impact of the residential school system has been recognized as a cultural genocide, and continues to this day.

The use of an orange shirt as a symbol was inspired by the accounts of Phyllis Jack Webstad, whose personal clothing—including a new orange shirt—was taken from her during her first day of residential schooling, and never returned. The orange shirt is thus used as a symbol of the forced assimilation of Indigenous children that the residential school system enforced.

The day was elevated to a statutory holiday by the Parliament of Canada in 2021, in light of the revelations of over 1,000 unmarked graves near former residential school sites. The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation is a statutory holiday for federal government employees and private-sector employees to whom the Canada Labour Code applies; the governments of British Columbia, Manitoba, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, and

the Northwest Territories also added the day to their relevant employment legislation as an observance.







### AS FIRE PREVENTION WEEK™ APPROACHES,

### THE DRAYTON VALLEY/BRAZEAU FIRE DEPARTMENT REMINDS RESIDENTS THAT

### "Fire won't wait. Plan your escape.™"

The Drayton Valley/Brazeau County Fire Services is teaming up with the National Fire Protection Association® (NFPA®)—to celebrate the 100th anniversary of Fire Prevention Week TM (FPW), October 9-15, 2022. This year's FPW campaign, *"Fire won't wait. Plan your escape*<sup>™</sup>", works to educate everyone about simple but important actions they can take to keep themselves and those around them safe from home fires.

"Today's homes burn faster than ever. You may have as little as two minutes (or even less time) to safely escape a home fire from the time the smoke alarm sounds. Your ability to get out of a home during a fire depends on early warning from smoke alarms and advance planning," said Lorraine Carli, Vice President of Outreach and Advocacy at NFPA.

The Fire Department encourages all residents to embrace the 2022 Fire Prevention Week theme.

"It's important for everyone to plan and practice a home fire escape. Everyone needs to be prepared in advance, so that they know what to do when the smoke alarm sounds. Given that every home is different, every home fire escape plan will also be different, "said Lynn Raines Fire Prevention Officer. "Have a plan for everyone in the home. Children, older adults, and people with disabilities may need assistance to wake up and get out. Make sure that someone will help them!"

Drayton Valley/ Brazeau County Fire Services wants to share these key home fire escape planning tips:

- Make sure your plan meets the needs of all your family members, including those with sensory or physical disabilities.
- Smoke alarms should be installed inside every sleeping room, outside each separate sleeping

area, and on every level of your home. Smoke alarms should be interconnected so when one sounds, they all sound.


- Know at least two ways out of every room, if possible. Make sure all doors and windows open easily.
- Have an outside meeting place a safe distance from your home where everyone should meet.
- Practice your home fire drill at least twice a year with everyone in the household, including guests. Practice at least once during the day and at night.

### Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework Resolution

**COUNCIL** 

Council will submit a resolution for the Pembina Zone meeting of the Rural Municipalities of Alberta (RMA) stating that the RMA requests the Government of Alberta amend the Municipal Government Act to define municipal services, thus providing the articulated scope, and mandate that municipalities present verifiable costs to justify cost sharing for the aforementioned defined municipal services.

### **Crime and Bail Resolution**

Council passed a motion to finalize a resolution for the Pembina Zone meeting of the Rural Municipalities of Alberta (RMA) recommending the creation of a Bail Sub-Committee which would include the stakeholders from the Ministry Analysis and the local Rural Crime Committee that would review the Cross Jurisdictional Analysis and any recommendations from the Ministry of Justice and the conversations with the Federal Government.

This committee would also meet several times a year to canvass stakeholders and Albertans on ideas for improving the justice system. These ideas would be reviewed by the committee, and after analyzing the suggestions the committee would present a yearly report to the Minister making recommendations on how to make the justice system work in an efficient fashion and address the problem of a judicial system that has become a revolving door.

### Northern Thunder Ranch

Following receipt of a report and additional information from the applicant, Council deferred the matter of a development permit application for the Northern Thunder Ranch to the October 18th Council meeting. The applicant proposes a kart school and event facility.



### **Fire Services Report**

Council received the Drayton Valley/Brazeau County Fire Services statistics report for June and July.

During those two months, the fire department received 94 total calls, with 37 calls in the County, 44 in Drayton Valley, six in Breton, and seven calls to provincial highways.

Of the calls in the County, eight were fire calls, eight were alarm calls, nine were calls to assist another agency, one was a motor vehicle collision, and five were miscellaneous calls.



To the Editor:

I filed a complaint with the Ombudsman about receiving a Trespass Notice from Brazeau County. (This notice indicated I was not to go onto any property owned by the County for a period of 60 days). I complied with this order, and the Ombudsman said they would be asking the County seven questions and I was to contact the County and I would be given the results.

I then contacted the County for these questions and the answers, and I was told they were FOIP'd-(freedom of information and privacy act). I then paid \$25 to have the FOIP removed as since I was the person the inquiry was about, I could get the information when the FOIP was removed. I was told this by both the Ombudsman and Municipal Affairs. To this date, I have not received this information. Why can't I get the information since it is about me? Is the County hiding something they don't want me to see?

I also asked for a Code of Conduct review. Apparently, the Council hired a private company to do the review. I was told that I was the first to be interviewed, and they interviewed all of the Councillors as well as some of the Administration. This supposedly took a week. The investigator told me that the results are now in the hands of the County, but still no results have been released.

Another instance is that of the Arbitration that took place between the Town of Drayton Valley and Brazeau County. The County has still not informed their ratepayers as to the results, or the costs that were involved in this arbitration.

One more item to ponder is a comment Councillor Ekstrom made during a discussion at the September 03/ 2022 meeting. The discussion was about letters from ratepayers who wished the letters to be included in the minutes. Councillor Ekstrom commented that Council did not need to acknowledge letters from the public. When Councillor Westerlund asked to make a motion at the same meeting, Reeve Guyon said he wouldn't vote unless he had a legal opinion!

Is this the way our County is being run? Do we need to pay to have legal council at meetings so business can progress? Are our council going to the sites that we the taxpayer pay millions of dollars to have done, and check on the workmanship? Is our council open and transparent? I think not! Ratepayers, go to a meeting or two and sit in to listen. Ask some questions. The bills are paid by you, the ratepayer, would you allow an employee or contractor to use your money this way?
