

THORSBY RCMP INVESTIGATE SERIOUS COLLISION WITH INJURIES BETWEEN A DUMP TRUCK AND SEMI TRUCK

Thorsby, Alta. – On Sept. 20, 2022, at approximately 1:13 p.m., Thorsby RCMP received a 911 call of a serious collision involving a semi truck and a dump truck on Highway 778 near Township Road 490 in Thorsby.

Thorsby RCMP attended, along with Emergency Medical Services and Fire Services. The 69-year-old male driver, a resident of Leduc County, was ejected from the dump truck and sustained serious, but non-life-threatening injuries. The 69-year-old driver was transported to hospital by STARS. The 48-year-old male driver and lone occupant of the semi truck, a resident of Millet, was checked on scene, and transported to hospital by ground ambulance with what appeared to be more minor injuries.

The Thorsby RCMP's preliminary investigation indicates the International 7000 series truck proceeded eastbound along Township 490 and was struck by the dump truck travelling southbound on Highway 778. The dump truck rolled onto its side and came to rest in the east side ditch of Highway 778.

Highway 778 and Township Road 490 traffic was shutdown for a few hours, but has since reopened.

- 2. That Leduc County set the election date of Dec. 12, 2022 to conduct the by-election for division 3 councillor. Voting hours are from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- 3. That Leduc County set the advance vote date of Saturday, Dec. 3, 2022 to conduct the by-election for division 3 councillor. Voting hours are from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- 4. That Leduc County appoints the following returning officer/substitute returning officer for the 2022 by-election: Joyce Gavan, Returning Officer & Rick Thomas, Substitute Returning Officer
- 5. Leduc County Council review the vacancies on boards/committees and determine appointment(s).
- Council received as information the Aug. 26, 2022 notice of resignation from Kelly Vandenberghe as division 3 councillor.
- Council set the election date of Monday, Dec. 12, 2022 to conduct the by-election for division 3 councillor; voting hours are from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Council set the advance vote date of Saturday, Dec. 3, 2022 to conduct the by-election for division 3 councillor; voting hours are from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Council appointed the following returning officer/substitute returning officer for the 2022 byelection: Joyce Gavan, Returning Officer & Rick Thomas, Substitute Returning Officer
- Leduc County Council reviewed the vacancies on the boards/committees and will consider appointments at the upcoming Organizational Meeting, which will take place on Oct. 25, 2022.

Warburg arena redevelopment phase II

At the Sept. 21, 2021 Council meeting, Council supported the following motion:

240-21 Councillor Scobie – that Leduc County Council supports the five-year capital plan as presented by the Village of Warburg and authorize administration to support the Village in provincial and federal grant

funding applications.

Since that time, administration has been working with the Village of Warburg to identify grant opportunities that will support the County and Village's investment in the next phase of arena redevelopment.

- In spring 2022, the Village of Warburg submitted an application to the Province of Alberta through the Community Facility Enhancement Program and a major project request of \$1,000,000.
- The province has requested additional information from the Village prior to making a final decision, including a confirmation of financial support from both the Village and County and matching, approved commitments by each municipality.
- Administration recommended Council provide conditional funding support of \$1,110,000 to the Village of Warburg to support arena phase II funding applications.

Council approved the recommendation.


