TES GRADE 2'S CLEAN UP THORSBY IN OCTOBER

The Thorsby Elementary School grade 2 classes recently invited me to their classroom so they could tell me about the Great Pacific Garbage patch and what it has inspired them to do. Here are a few things I learned from this smart group of students:

"There's a whole bunch of garbage and we want to clean it up. It's mostly plastic" says Scarlet.

"It's Humongous and lots of garbage and plastic and fish are eating it and it's not good for our environment" says Autumn *"and we can see all the plastic they ate when they die"*

"It's 3 x bigger than France" says Eli

"Plastic kills fish" says Holden

"Garbage ends up on the land" says Jay

"Litter goes to the ocean" says Bryn

All of this is true and here is more. When looking it up online according to National Geographic The Great Pacific Garbage Patch is a collection of marine debris (litter) in the North Pacific Ocean. While many different types of trash enter the ocean, plastics make up the majority of marine debris for two reasons. First, plastic's durability, low cost, and malleability mean that it's being used in more and more consumer and industrial products. Second, plastic goods do not biodegrade but instead, break down into smaller pieces. Abandoned fishing gear and nets make up another large part of this collection of floating trash.

The National Ocean and Atmospheric Administration's Marine Debris Program has estimated that it would take 67 ships one year to clean up less than one percent of the North

Pacific Ocean. That is a pretty big job for 35 grade 2's but instead they are going to start here in Thorsby.

Here is what the grade 2's plan to do:

"Clean up the whole town of Thorsby" says Macy

"To get the whole school to separate and clean up" says Jace

"Use less plastic" says Bethany

"Get the high school to help" says Bryn

Starting next week this great group of students with their teachers Mrs. Walker, Mrs Neufeld and maybe even some RCMP friends will be cleaning up Thorsby. To further save on plastics, they will even be using reusable bags to collect the garbage and then put it all in one big plastic bag to go in the trash. Keep an eye out for them!!

Here is what the grade 2's said you can do to help?

- Many of the students mentioned that lots of the garbage is between the high school and Esso so you can tell your kids and teens the importance of not littering.
- Avoid single use plastic bags and use reusable containers when possible
- Use paper or metal straws instead of plastic
- When you are out for a walk with your friends or family, pick up garbage on your way (but don't forget your gloves)

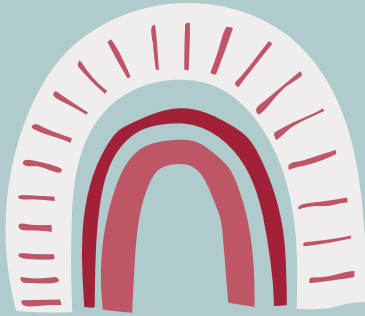

CAO and CFO contracts renewed

Councillor Musson made a motion to extend Donna Tona, interim CAO and Cindy Van Leest, interim CFO's contract until April 2026. Four Councillors were in favor with Councillor Gilbert opposed. Administration recommended that Council consider the stability of the municipality in their decision. They are in the middle of a very serious audit, heading to budget, and are still in the middle of building a foundation with heavy policy work, bylaw work, a grant to project manage and regional water to "bring to life". Both CAO Donna Tona and CFO Cindy Van Leest come highly skilled and knowledgeable in Municipal Government and are willing to continue to work towards the betterment of Thorsby.

For comparison, here are the past administrative salaries: **2017** - \$165,539 **2018** - \$182,031 **2019** - \$186,140 **2020** - \$166,732 **2021** - \$181,016 **2022** - \$151,000 **2023** - \$168,000 (proposed)

Commercial Tax Incentive

Council agreed to give Matt Ruhr from Ruhr Valley Lumber a tax refund of \$5027.32 as per the Commercial Tax Incentive Policy #2012-005. Mr. Ruhr had approached the past administration because he believed he qualified for this incentive but his application was not accepted. Upon investigation, this current administration determined through land titles, and examining all tax files of Hoffman's Hardware Store that the basis for previous refusal is unwarranted by virtue of Mr. Ruhrs purchase of the current building and the extensive renovations completed within it. The Tax incentive Policy #2012-005 clearly indicates there are commercial tax incentives for new businesses in an existing building as well as a Business Renovation Incentive.

Trade-In of Side by Side for a Quad

Council approved the 2012 Side by Side be traded straight across with an approximate value of \$5,500 for a Quad. The quad includes a snow blade, winch, good tires and a removable cab. Public Works manager Andrew Kearley feels the quad will be of more value to the town year-round and more suitable for Public Works.

Arena Ice Mesh

Administration requested Council's permission to destroy the mesh system previously used in the arena

ice. Ms. Probe and her team believe that former Public Works Manager Wayne purchased the arena mesh in 2019 for approximately \$25,000. The steel roller was also custom built to store it at an approximate cost of \$5000 - \$6000 dollars. The mesh is torn, discoloured, does not unroll flat and is extremely labour intensive for install & removal. The Complex has now purchased a much more economical and easy to use paint machine. It is believed that the mesh was purchased because they were told the paint was not environmentally friendly but Complex Manager Probe assured the Council the paint is safe and environmentally friendly. This request to destroy the mesh was approved and to put the steel roller into cold storage.
