

Often people don't think about the hazards that exist if disposing a cigarette into a dry planter. Materials such as peat moss, vermiculite and styrofoam pellets become very flammable when they are dry. Some planters will ignite quickly, while others smoulders for hours or even days before finally igniting causing serious damage to property. Please only use

designated outdoor cigarette waste containers that are designed to not catch fire. Planters are not for cigarette disposal at any time of the year!
