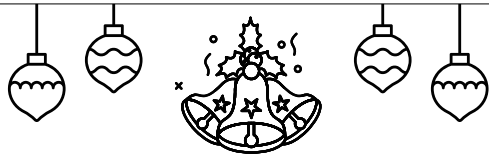

Frank passed away in 1968, leaving the family business to his children, Hedy and Richard. Stanley Hoffman remained active at Hoffman's Hardware until 1984 when he retired. In later years, Michael joined the business and was eventually bought out by Geoff, Richard's son. In 1986, Hoffman's added building supplies as part of their product mix. They continued to expand and grow the business.
