



Seniors and families with children under 18 can apply for their payments online starting January 18, but can get ready now by signing up for a Verified Alberta.ca Account www.alberta.ca/affordability-payments.aspx #apply

Anyone receiving monthly benefits through AISH, Income Support, Alberta Seniors Benefit or services through Persons with Developmental Disabilities (PDD) will get their payments automatically but will need to apply for additional payments if they have kids under 18.

Breton FCSS can assist with helping you navigate through this process if you need to apply.

Community Volunteer Income Tax Program

FREE INCOME TAX PREPARATION - For Low Income Persons, Families, seniors and students. Although this is something that most of us would like to avoid thinking about and doing, I am afraid that this is unavoidable. You need to file your income tax each year, even if you have no income to report. By doing this you may receive benefits that you did not know you were eligible for. Also, in the event of the death of your spouse, benefits can easily be transferred to you, if you have filled a return for the last calendar year. If you did not file a tax return in

2021 you may not be receiving benefits from the government that you are eligible for. The focus of the Community Volunteer Tax Program is to assist those individuals who have limited income. This includes seniors, families, and students. If your income was approximately in one of the following categories, you may qualify for assistance. *1 person - \$35,000 / Couple -\$45,000 / Family - \$52,500

We are not able to complete returns with income from the following sources: Capital Gains or Losses, Farming Income, Rental Income, Self-Employment, Interest exceeding \$1,000, Bankruptcies, Deceased Persons

This service is FREE to those who qualify. If you require this service, please gather your information, and bring it to the Village of Breton office Monday to Thursday between 8:30 - 4:00. Clients will be notified when your return is completed. The program will run from March 1 - April 30, 2023. We require the following information to complete your return:

- Personal Information (Social Insurance Number, Birth date, Marital Status, Address)
- Dependent's information spouse/ children's names, birth dates.
- All "T" Slips (T4's, T4A, OAS ect.)
- All Forms, Schedules, and Labels you have received from Revenue Canada.
- Receipts for any expenses such as medical, moving, tuition, sporting activities. Printouts from your pharmacist are available for those with numerous prescriptions.



Recreation Cost Sharing Agreement with Town of Drayton Valley

Council passed a motion to empower the Reeve and Chief Administrative Officer to execute a revised Recreation Cost Sharing Agreement with the Town of Drayton Valley. The agreement, which expires in March 2024, will see the County continue to pay 50% of the net operating costs of recreation facilities and a percentage of the costs for the Early Childhood Development Centre (ECDC) equal to the percentage of County users of the centre.

The County has paid the Town \$454,548.28 in the year 2020 for its contribution toward the Town's operating costs for the facilities, other than the ECDC. The County will make an immediate payment of \$591,592.94 (the Retroactive Recreation Advance) to the Town. In respect of the County's Judicial Review, of the arbitrator's decision, if the Court decides in favour of the County, the Town shall repay the Retroactive Recreation Advance.





To the Editor:

With reference to the FCM 2023 Sustainable Communities report, kudos to the Reeve for submitting the report. It has to be one of a very few.

The following is my take on this report:

The first paragraph mentioned that there were "... more sessions than we could have possibly attended." Since we haven't seen reports from the other reps, are we to assume that all three county reps went to the same sessions?

And what value is it to Brazeau County to have P. Polievere interested in what we do (or don't do) here? Tax reductions and rebates were mentioned, but was the effect of these on how the \$40 million overspending fits in or who benefits the most from this decision? Was the whole story told here?

In the second paragraph, it is mentioned that "... two question periods ..." had many questions unanswered by the Conservatives. What value is this to us? Why do we spend tens of thousands of dollars to attend sessions when questions are unanswered? We have that in our own Ratepayers' hour. What connection do the federal Conservatives or any other political party have to the local situation in Brazeau County?

Other comments in Paragraph 2 refer to "...our citizens first" philosophy. The effect of that philosophy hasn't made it to this observer yet (take in a ratepayers' hour sometime) or note also the use of "workshops" to eliminate public participation.

It is stated that "... we've also saved almost 5 million dollars in administrative costs." Where?

As far as the statement about improving public engagements, when was the last county public meeting held and for what purpose?

With regard to the Violet Grove Wetlands and Solar Aquatics Facility in Cynthia, was the whole story told? How much has it cost the rest of the county for these projects when perhaps lagoons (like the rest of us have) work just as well for a whole lot less.

As to the comment about sustainability, where will the money come from to establish these projects as our reserves are nearly depleted.

Noting the statement about attracting business, it appears that the only ones moving in are toxic style dumps--why would we want them? What do they contribute to the enhancement of the county?

Other questions: where has the \$250 million infrastructure referred to been spent? On what infrastructure? Is this why we won't properly fix the Moose Hill bridge? What/where are the innovative businesses that enhance our oil and gas, our forestry, and agriculture? Where/what are the "clean technologies" as mentioned?

In conclusion, what really will be the benefit to the county of the thousands of dollars spent on this conference? Call your councillor to see how they defend the expenditure.




