The Property Assessor is available to discuss any concerns or questions you may have about your property assessment by phoning Compass Assessment Consultants Inc. at 1-800-251-9711.

Anyone wishing to appeal the assessment value on any property listed on the assessment roll must do so by August 1, 2023, using only the prescribed "Assessment Review Board Complaint" form #LGS1402 (2009/08), which is available at the Village Office. The appeal must be accompanied by a \$50.00 fee per residential parcel or \$100 per non-residential parcel, which will be refunded to the complainant if the complaint is successful.

The amount owing on the property tax notice must be paid by June 30, 2023.

The Village of Breton - Waste Transfer Site Reopens June 1 Operating Hours Thurs Fri Sat 10am to 5 pm

After the recent fire at our waste transfer site Village Council reviewed the operations of the site and have instituted additional safety measures. These will take effect in stages as indicated below.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

The following waste must be **taken directly to a landfill**. Waste can be taken to the Drayton Valley Landfill located at HWY 22 and 58 Ave. Tipping rates vary at the Drayton Valley landfill starting at \$6.00 for residential waste.

- Bleach, Drain, Toilet/Oven Cleaners etc.
- Paint/Stain Cans & Motor Oil Filters
- Tires & Car/Truck Batteries
- Herbicide, Pesticide Containers
- Fluorescent Tubes/Ballasts, Light Bulbs,
- Halogen Lights & Fixtures & Household Batteries
- Caulking Tubes/Cement Powder Boxes
- E Waste, Computers, Monitor's DVD Players, TV's,
- BBQ's & Lawnmowers
- Furniture, Mattresses, Sofas, Box Springs, etc.
- Lumber, Decking, Concrete, Shingles, Insulation & Drywall

Trees, branches and yard clippings will still be accepted as per usual. This waste will no longer be burnt each year. It will be chipped twice a year and the mulch from the chipping will be available for resident use. No cardboard, paper, lumber etc is permitted to be disposed of within this pile. All cardboard is to be placed in the newly provided bin.

For the month of June the Waste Transfer Site will still accept household waste free of charge. As of **July 1st this will no longer be accepted for free**. Residents will be able to purchase garbage bags at a cost of \$3.00 per bag from the Village office. These bags will be the **only items accepted for waste**





State of Local Emergency Renewed

Brazeau County has renewed its State of Local Emergency (SOLE) for another seven days due to the ongoing threat of wildfire.

The SOLE can be rescinded before that time.

A State of Local Emergency gives a municipality powers it does not otherwise have to manage an emergency situation.

In particular, Brazeau County has declared the SOLE to make use of four powers under the Emergency Management Act:

- put into operation an emergency plan or program;
- control or prohibit travel to or from any area of the county;
- order the evacuation of persons and the removal of livestock and personal property from any area of the county that is or may be affected by a disaster and make arrangements for the adequate care and protection of those persons or livestock and of the personal property;
- cause the demolition or removal of any trees, structures, or crops if the demolition or removal is necessary or appropriate in order to reach the scene of a disaster, or to attempt to forestall its occurrence or to combat its progress.

Tax Due Date Extended to July 31st

Council passed motions to move the tax due date deadline to July 31, 2023 due to the recent wildfire that affected members of the community. Late penalties will not be charged before August 1.

Weed Inspection Rates

Responding to a request from The Agricultural Services Board, Council passed a motion to set rates for contract weed inspections services to the Village of Breton and the Town of Drayton Valley at \$350 per day for the 2023 calendar year. The rate had previously been \$250 per day.

Noise Control Bylaw 1140-23

Council gave all three readings to Noise Control Bylaw 1140-23, which replaces the previous Noise Control Bylaw. The new bylaw includes:

 General updates, cleaning up of the bylaw, including simplifying definitions, correction of typographical errors and formatting, and utilizing consistent language in the Land Use Bylaw;

- Reduction to the nighttime decibel limit in Residential Districts from 70 dBA to 60dBA;
- Adding a definition and creating a new section for Natural Resource Extraction and Processing District; and
- Clarification on procedures for measuring noise readings.

Technology, Innovation, and Investment Committee

Council approved the creation of the Technology, Innovation, and Investment Attraction Committee to help guide the Western Economic Corridor and other initiatives. Council appointed Reeve Bart Guyon and councillors Glen Gunderson and Kara Westerlund to the committee. Administration will develop a Terms of Reference for the committee.

Alberta Rural Health Week

Council designated May 30 – June 3, 2023 as Alberta Rural Health Week in Brazeau County, and urged all community residents to show appreciation for the contributions of the rural health professionals and community volunteers whose abilities and efforts enhance the quality of life in rural Alberta.
