LOCAL FOOTBALL PLAYERS PLAY FOR CANADA ON JULY 8

Orrin Blackmore and Brayden Thorimbirt, six man football All-Star players from Breton are heading to Hanna on July 8 to play for team Canada in the 25th Annual Canam Bowl.

The CanAm Bowl is a 6-man all-star game that showcases the USA (Montana, Nebraska, Wyoming, & Texas) against Canada (Saskatchewan & Alberta). Players selected to represent their country must be a high school graduate of the current year in which the game is played and have played at least their grade 12 year as a member of a 6-man football program.

The CanAm Bowl began July of 1997 when an American all-star team made the trip to Canada to play a Saskatchewan all-star team in Porcupine Plain, Saskatchewan hosted by Bjorkdale.

The prestigious CanAm Bowl XXV on July 8th will be at 1pm in Hanna, AB at the JCC Field. This game will also be live-streamed on Youtube. Cheer on our local celebrities Orrin (#23) and Brayden (#79).

THE FUTURE OF THE BRETON MEDICAL CLINIC

Submitted by Dr. Michael Mulholland, Acting Zone Medical Director, AHS Central Zone & Janice Stewart, Chief Zone Officer, AHS Central Zone

We would like to address the future of the Breton Medical Clinic which has been – and will continue to be – a cornerstone of the community.

Many of you may have learned recently that the physicians who have supported the clinic in recent years are retiring from, or otherwise changing, their private practice. We thank them for the care they've provided over the years and wish them all the best.

We recognize there may be concerns arising from these temporary changes in service. There will be no gap in physician coverage or support for long-term care (LTC) residents. Two new physicians based in Drayton Valley are now providing coverage to LTC as part of their practice in the area, and both will be seeing patients in their private practice in Drayton Valley.

Additionally, these physicians will also be supporting the Breton Medical Clinic later this year as part of AHS' continued work to assume full operation of the clinic.

Previously, operational responsibilities for the medical clinic have been split between physicians and AHS. In response to concerns brought forward by physicians, AHS will be solely responsible for the operation of the medical clinic when it resumes operation in November – if not before.

Between now and then, we are readying the space to implement the provincial Connect Care system. Doing so will help us introduce consistent processes that align with AHS practice standards, including electronic charting, information sharing agreements, and the reconciliation of old patient records.

Recruitment is also underway for office staff to support clinic operation, as well as for additional physicians to serve the Drayton Valley-Breton area. When the clinic resumes operation, it will be for two days per week to help enhance local access to

physicians directly in the community.

We know Breton residents value having access to a medical clinic in their community, and AHS is committed to supporting the continued operation of the clinic into the future. Our Medical Affairs team is working on reopening the clinic as soon as possible. As a reopening date is finalized, we will be sure to keep the community informed.

In the meantime, we will continue to collaborate with the Village, and other community partners, to support local health care now, and into the future.

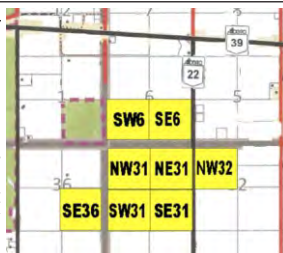

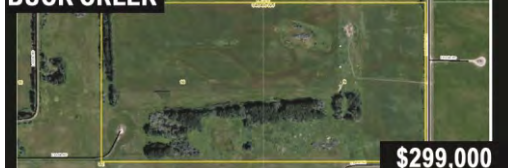

ROAD BUILDING BLAST FROM THE PAST

I came across 3 photographs taken in 1950, by Edith Shave. They show the construction of what is now Highway 20 on the east side of Breton. Looking in the story submitted by Miss. Shave to the Ladder of Time history book she writes that in 1950 the road was put in south going to Rimbey. "The road allowance was all bush and muskeg...not even a cow would walk there". A spring located on the west side of her land ran across the road allowance which caused many problems for the road construction crew. Two big culverts were put in the road way, with one having to be taken out twice before a suitable base for the culvert was obtained. Finally, the water from the spring was able to run under the highway and continue its journey through the Ravine in Breton.

Originally this portion of highway was Highway 39, later renamed Highway 12 and now is Highway 20. Prior to this piece of road being constructed, traffic had to travel through Breton from the north and reconnect with the road to Rimbey south of Breton.

As we speed along on a paved highway today this is what the road looked like just over 70 years ago. I wonder what a mile of road cost them to build in those days??

The 3 photos included were all likely taken from the south looking northward on what is now Highway 20.

STOLEN ITEMS FROM WINFIELD FIRE DEPARTMENT RECOVERED

Central Alberta District Rcmp Crime Reduction Unit Arrest And Charge Repeat Offender

Buck Lake, Alta. – On June 22, 2023, at approximately 8:30 a.m., officers of the Crime Reduction Unit were conducting proactive checks on prolific property offenders in the area of Buck Lake. Officers observed a pickup truck matching the description of a vehicle reported stolen and previously fleeing from police. After initiating a traffic stop, the driver fled, however, he was later arrested at a property near Winfield.

A search warrant was executed at a related property in Wetaskiwin County where several items, including those reported stolen from Winfield Fire Department, were recovered or seized, including:

- Hydraulic pump system and hydraulic hoses used in a "Jaws of Life" rescue system
- Makita gas-powered cut off saw
- Stolen Dodge truck
- Stolen holiday trailer
- 3.5 ounces of suspected methamphetamine
- Amachete

Murlin Scott Becker (40), a resident of Buck Lake, has been charged with numerous offences, some of which include:

- Possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose
- Obstructing a peace officer
- Possession of property obtained by crime over \$5,000 (x3)

After a judicial interim release hearing, Becker was remanded into custody and will be appearing in Alberta Court of Justice in Breton on July 26, 2023.

Winfield Fire Chief Barry Clarkson states, "Not only has this impacted our ability to provide life-saving rescue services since this equipment went missing, the re-certification process for the bit of gear that was recovered will take time. Most of us are volunteers, so the frustration with acts like this, especially when it complicates our ability to conduct rescue operations, is significant."

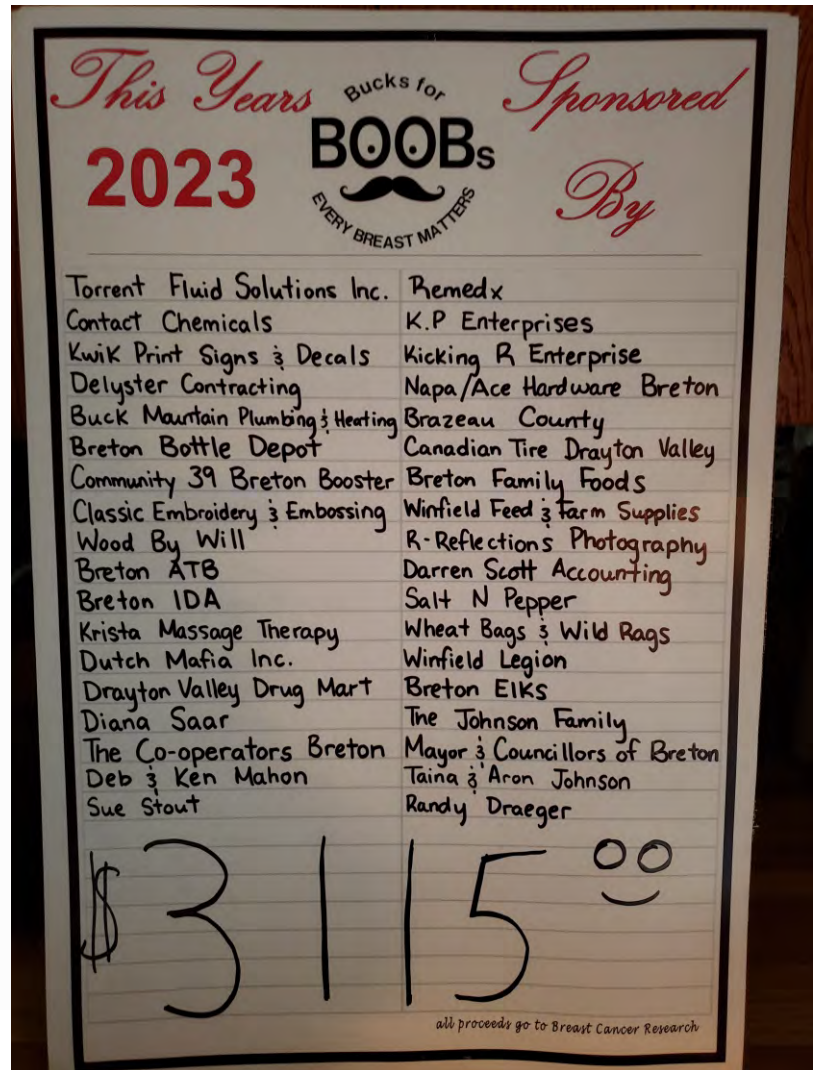

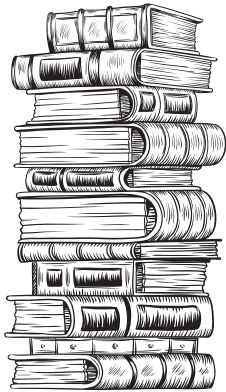

LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

To the Editor:

The county (Brazeau) held a well-attended public meeting concerning the fire that ravaged the county. Here are some thoughts about that meeting.

A “beef on a bun” was part of the meeting. As a product, it was mediocre at best—certainly not to the level of lunches councillors get at their meetings (on our dime).

A “preamble” given by a staff member lasted for close to an hour with repetition ad nauseum. This of course reduced the time for public input. Unfortunately, this procedure has been used by the county in many of their public meetings, in my view to reduce flack coming their way; i.e., fewer questions, fewer answers required.

As the meeting progressed, it became evident that few answers were forthcoming. For example, why was the “command” structure the way it was? Was “who answered to whom” the best arrangement under the circumstances? Why was the county CAO where he was in the chain? Does he have expertise in firefighting?

A figure of 150 feet was used to guide how much protection to property was provided. Why is 150 feet the magic number? Perhaps it’s enough of a buffer for oil installations, but is it good enough for residential assets?

As to the use of “community assets” (e.g., cats, water trucks, etc.) it is my understanding that the oil patch uses whatever is available most readily to attack an emergency. County command refused such help. Several fire-affected people had their property partly or totally protected because neighbours helped out. The rationale for county refusal (in this writer’s view) was thin.

What was the rationale for removing the fire ban when it was?

Since councillors were in attendance, but did not or were not allowed to contribute, justification for per diems is minimal.

Perhaps another meeting would be useful, especially with more information provided!
