WINFIELD TRUCK STOP GRAND RE-OPENING JULY 15



In the early 90's, Winston Curtis fenced off about 10 acres of his land beside Hwy 20. With Doug Goltz as a partner, they moved in a building and started the Modeste Truck Stop. They offered fuel and a snack bar for passing travelers, then expanded with a restaurant later on. Modeste was a thriving business but, over the years it has changed hands multiple times with varying degrees of success, depending on who operated it and the business plan implemented.

Seeing an opportunity, Curt Shrader of the Bar2 Trucking Company bought the property, and found a talented cook to run the restaurant for breakfast and lunch. With possibility of supper hours in the future.

For the last 2 months, work has been ongoing to open the convenience store. They offer pre-made sandwiches, ice cream treats, coffee, pop, juice, items on a roller grill, Plus many more items. They are open 7am to 8pm, 7 days/week.





Preparations are in the works to bring in fuel service in the near future. They even have a hitching rail for our local horseback riders!

The grand opening is planned for next Saturday July 15th, offering a free slushie or an ice cream sandwich.

HEAT EXHAUSTION AND HEATSTROKE

For so many moths during the year we wish that is was warmer. Then summer arrives and some think it is just too hot! Make sure you take precautions not to have heat exhaustion or heat stroke. Heat exhaustion does not usually need emergency medical help if you can cool down within 30 minutes. If it turns into heatstroke, it needs to be treated as an emergency.

Check for signs of heat exhaustion.

The signs of heat exhaustion include:

- tiredness
- · dizziness
- · headache
- · feeling sick or being sick
- excessive sweating and skin becoming pale and clammy or getting a heat rash, but a change in skin colour can be harder to see on brown and black skin
- · cramps in the arms, legs and stomach
- · fast breathing or heartbeat
- · a high temperature
- · being very thirsty
- weakness

The symptoms of heat exhaustion are often the same in adults and children, although children may become irritable too.

If someone is showing signs of heat exhaustion, they need to be cooled down and given fluids.

Things you can do to cool someone down

If someone has heat exhaustion, follow these 4 steps:

- Move them to a cool place.
- Remove all unnecessary clothing like a jacket or socks.
- Get them to drink a sports or re-hydration drink, or cool water
- Cool their skin spray or sponge them with cool water and fan them. Cold packs, wrapped in a cloth and put under the armpits or on the neck are good too.
- Stay with them until they're better.

They should start to cool down and feel better within 30 minutes.

Preventing heat exhaustion and heatstroke

To help prevent heat exhaustion or heatstroke:

- drink more cold drinks, especially if you're active or exercising.
- wear light-coloured, loose clothing.
- avoid the sun between 11am and 3pm
- avoid excess alcohol.
- · avoid extreme exercise.

if you're inside on a very hot day, close curtains, close

windows if it's hotter outside than in your home and turn off electrical equipment and lights that get hot. This will also prevent dehydration and help your body keep itself cool.

Children, older people, and people with long-term health conditions (such as diabetes or heart problems) are more at risk of heat exhaustion or heatstroke.

JULY'S TRAFFIC SAFETY FOCUS IS IMPAIRED DRIVING

An Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors Stakeholder Message

Dear Traffic Safety Stakeholder:

Our traffic safety focus for the month of July is **Impaired Driving**.

Summer has arrived and many people are making the most of the warm weather to socialize with others. However, people should also think ahead to how they will get home safely. Collisions involving impaired drivers tend to happen more often during the summer months than the rest of the year. Impaired driving is preventable when drivers plan for a safe ride home.

Facts about impaired driving:

- In 2020, about one in eight drivers involved in a fatal collision was legally impaired at the time of the crash.
- Impaired driving collisions most commonly occur at night. Between 2016 and 2020, about half (48.4%) of impaired driving casualty collisions occurred between 7:00 pm and 3:00 am.
- On average over the last five fiscal years, almost 4,000 people were convicted of impaired driving in Alberta each year.
- Research shows cannabis use can reduce many cognitive and motor skills required to drive safely, such as tracking, reaction time, visual function, concentration, short-term memory, and divided attention. Combining cannabis with alcohol further intensifies the effects on driving skills, even if the doses of either substance are low.
- The effects of consuming cannabis edibles take longer to kick in and last much longer than inhaling the drug. It may take up to two hours to feel effects, which can last 12 hours or longer.
- According to Health Canada's 2021 Canadian Cannabis Survey, 21% of people who had used cannabis in the past 12 months reported they had driven within two hours of using cannabis, and 35% of those respondents did so within the past 30 days.


