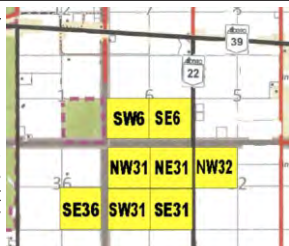

The Alberta Office to Combat Trafficking in Persons will also work to enhance public awareness and establish a more effective data collection process. This data will monitor the effectiveness of service delivery and help close the gaps in tracking cross-jurisdictional human trafficking incidents.

In response to this investment, Mr. Brandt recently said, *"This milestone wouldn't be possible without the countless organizations and individuals who shared their experiences and expertise in our journey with Alberta's Human Trafficking Task Force. Combating human trafficking requires collective action, and we applaud the province for taking a collaborative approach with the community."*

Our United Conservative government remains committed to fighting human trafficking in every corner of

the province. Human trafficking is a serious crime that violates the freedoms and rights of individuals, including children and youth, and attempts to destroy all personal identity and relationships. No community in Alberta is immune to the scourge of human trafficking, and we must all work together to prevent and combat this heinous crime.

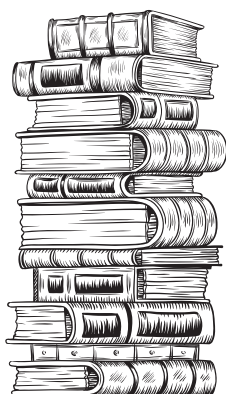
