### Mchale and Noahs Story

*“The loss of your spouse and child, the weight of that grief, is a burden no one should ever have to bear. But for Cody McConnell, this is the devastating reality he is now forced to live with every day.*

*In early September 2021, Cody, his partner, Mchale Busch, and their young son, Noah McConnell, moved into an apartment complex in Hinton, Alta. Unbeknownst to them, they moved in next door to Robert Major, a convicted sexual offender with a dangerous and violent history.*

*On Sept. 16, Cody came home from work to find that Mchale and Noah weren’t home. Not knowing where they could be and concerned for them, Cody went to the two parks near their new home to look for them. They weren’t there. When he got back home, Cody called friends and family to see if they had heard from Mchale. Cody then called the police, as well as his friend, Jared. While waiting for the police to arrive, Cody and Jared knocked on all the apartment doors on Cody’s floor, asking neighbours if they had seen or heard from Mchale that day.*

*Around 10 a.m. the next morning, Sept. 17, the RCMP’s*

*homicide unit arrived on scene. According to the RCMP, they had discovered Noah’s body in the dumpster outside the apartment building. It was after this discovery that they moved Cody to the hotel.*

*The RCMP were questioning Cody at the police station when they received additional information that Mchale had been found, deceased, in Robert’s apartment.*

*In an article from Global News, Robert was released from prison in 2017 and, at that time, police issued a public warning stating they had reasonable grounds to believe he would “commit another sexual offence against a female, including children, while in the community.” Robert was on several court-ordered conditions at the time, but it remains unknown when he moved from Edmonton to the Hinton area and how he came to live in an apartment complex with women and children, near parks and schools, without anyone realizing or doing anything to stop it.*

*Cody, Mchale and Noah lived next door to a violent, repeat sexual offender. Mchale and Noah’s deaths were senseless and completely preventable, and that’s what the Noah’s Law campaign is hoping to achieve – among other things, changes to Canada’s Criminal Code that will increase monitoring of these offenders. You can help us by spreading awareness of this campaign, signing our petition when it becomes available and speaking with your MPP and MP to let them know that Mchale and Noah have not been forgotten, that their deaths should lead to meaningful change within Canada’s criminal justice system so that no other family will ever have to go through a tragedy like this again.”*

### **Sweet Potato Fries with Curry Mayonnaise**

- 4 sweet potatoes (2 1/2 lb/1.25 kg)
- 2 egg whites
- 1 tbsp (15 mL) vegetable oil
- 1 tsp (5 mL) each ground cumin and paprika
- 1/2 tsp (2 mL) each salt and pepper
- Curry Mayonnaise:
- 1/2 cup (125 mL) light mayonnaise
- 1 tsp (5 mL) lime juice
- 1/4 tsp (1 mL) curry paste

Peel potatoes; trim ends and sides to create rectangles. Cut lengthwise into 1/2-inch (1 cm) thick slices; cut each lengthwise into 1/2 -inch (1 cm) wide strips or purchase a bag of ready cut potatoes. In large bowl, whisk egg whites until frothy. Bake in top and bottom thirds of 425°F (220°C) oven for 30 to 35 minutes, rotating and switching pans halfway through, until tender and edges are browned and crisp. Curry Mayonnaise: Meanwhile, in small bowl, whisk together mayonnaise, lime juice and curry paste; serve with potatoes. Makes 4 to 6 servings

### **Cheese Burger Chowder**

- 1 pound lean ground beef
- 2 medium potatoes, peeled and cubed, about 2 cups

- 1/2 teaspoon salt

### **Creamy Corn and Potato Chowder**

- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 large onion, finely chopped
- 1 rib celery, finely chopped
- 5 1/2 cups chicken stock
- 1 1/2 cups frozen corn kernels
- 1 large all-purpose potato, peeled and diced
- 1/2 to 3/4 teaspoon salt, to taste
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- Black pepper, to taste
- Fresh dill or parsley for garnish, chopped

Melt the butter in a large saucepan or medium soup pot. Stir in the onion and celery. Partially cover the pan and cook the vegetables over moderate heat for 9 to 10 minutes, stirring occasionally. Add the chicken stock, corn, potato, and salt and bring the mixture to a low boil. Lower the heat, cover the pot, and simmer for about 7 minutes, until the potatoes are just tender. In a small bowl, whisk together the cream and flour. Stir the mixture into the soup with the pepper. Bring the soup back to a low boil, then reduce the heat and simmer for about 8 minutes. Serve hot, garnished with herbs.

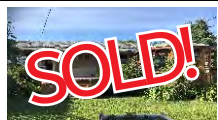

# LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

To the Editor:

After reading a FOIP document (Reference No. FOIP 2023-02) regarding a series of approaches, subdivision applications, and hard surfacing of RR81, several questions need answering.

Why did the document need to be FOIPed? Are not all records of county actions in the public domain?

Why was RR81 hard surfaced for 2 miles north of Hwy 621? My county map shows only 13 residences on that piece of road. Should not the beneficiaries of the expenditures pay (local improvement tax)?

If this road is paved, then each residence benefits by about \$220,000. You may want to note on the latest county map who owns land along this road.

Why were 3 approaches constructed before the subdivisions they serve were approved?

One document shows a request, and 6 minutes later it was fulfilled. Has anyone else in the county had such a speedy response?

According to a work order form (CON 1809), a land owner on RR81 paid \$2419.20 for 6 pieces of culverts. Our checking found the value of same to be about \$6300.00

Additionally, 3 loads of gravel were provided (6 pups) at \$381.55--in total.

No mention was made of the cost of labour, nor costs of paving to the property line for three subdivisions.

Since there was never (to this writer's knowledge) a rationale for the need for 2 miles of hard surfacing of the road in the first place, why was paving considered?

Sound like a sweetheart deal?

Contact your councillor. Find out their explanation of the situation.

Requests to Municipal Affairs to investigate county operations have always fallen on deaf ears.

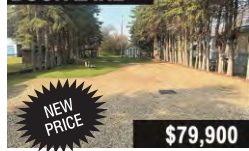
