



Counselling Subsidies – Breton and Area FCSS is pleased to offer Counselling Subsidies.

A subsidy is available for individuals, couples and/or families who are struggling with common, everyday issues to access short-term preventative counselling services. The goal is to:

- Improve relationships with better communication and conflict resolution skills;
- Improve mood with anger management and emotional support:
- Enhance personal growth with creativity, spirituality, selfesteem, self-awareness, goal setting;
- · Improve parenting skills by focusing on attachment;
- · Reduce stress with life balance; and/or
- · Learn new skills and behaviors.

The cost of counselling can be a barrier for many individuals and families. This subsidy is available to those who do not have access to coverage through health benefits or employee benefits, such as an Employee Assistance Plan (EAP), and whose family income is less than \$75,000 per year. Fees are determined according to a sliding scale based on income and family size. Fees range from \$15 per session to \$50 per session. The maximum number of sessions available is seven for individuals and nine for couples or families.

Counselling services are provided through a partnership with Karunia Counselling from Leduc.

We know that in this current environment many may have additional stress and anxiety. We also know that transportation may be an added barrier. These sessions can be arranged to be in person in the Karunia offices in Leduc, over the phone in your own safe environment or virtually on your computer.

To apply for the subsidy services, application forms are available through the Breton FCSS Office at 4916 50th Avenue or by contacting them at fcss@breton.ca or calling 780-696-3636. ALL APPLICATIONS ARE STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL.

Breton and Area FCSS will be doing the intake of the applications. Counselling services are provided by Karunia Counselling by Registered Psychologists, Registered Provisional Psychologists, Canadian Certified Counsellors and Masters or PhD level student interns under the supervision of a qualified psychologist. All applications will be kept in strict confidence.



NEW FUNDING FOR APPRENTICESHIPS

Alberta News

A \$12.4-million investment from Alberta's government will create almost 2,000 new apprenticeship seats across the province.

While Alberta accounts for 12 per cent of Canada's labour force, the province has approximately 14 per cent

of the country's apprentices. Through the 47 apprenticeship education programs across the province, there are 53,922 registered apprentices in Alberta, an increase of 19 per cent from the end of 2022.

- Apprenticeship Day, created in 2022 and celebrated on the fourth Monday of September, celebrates apprentices and recognizes the contributions the skilled trades have made in shaping the province.
- Alberta has 47 apprenticeship education programs, each of which lasts one to four years.



FUN FACTS ABOUT CANADIAN THANKSGIVING

from the internet

The Breton Booster and CE Media Signs & Promotional is very thankful for having the support of our readers, advertisers, friends and family. Here is some fun and interesting information about Thanksgiving for you:

- We've celebrated Thanksgiving in Canada for 140 years, starting in November 6, 1879.
- > Prior to 1957, Canada celebrated Thanksgiving on the third Monday of October. It officially moved to the second Monday of October via an announcement on January 31, 1957 by the Governor General of Canada.
- The United States celebrates their Thanksgiving on the fourth Thursday in November and Canada's is in October as it gets colder earlier and therefore, our harvest season is earlier.
- It was originally celebrated as a day of giving thanks for the blessing of the harvest and of the preceding year.
- The first Canadian Thanksgiving is said to have traced back to 1578 with explorer Martin Frobisher. He had been trying to find a northern passage to the Pacific Ocean and held his Thanksgiving celebration not for harvest but in thanks for surviving the long journey from England through the perils of storms and icebergs. On his final voyage to the far north, Frobisher held a formal ceremony in Frobisher Bay in Baffin Island (present-day Nunavut) to give thanks to God and in a service ministered by the preacher Robert Wolfall they celebrated Communion.
- Alternatively, some say that the origins of Canadian Thanksgiving are also sometimes traced to the French settlers who came to New France with explorer Samuel de Champlain in the early 17th century, who celebrated their successful harvests. The French settlers in the area typically had feasts at the end of the harvest season and continued throughout the winter season, even sharing food with the indigenous peoples of the area.
- With the exception of the Atlantic provinces of Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland and Labrador, New Brunswick, and Nova Scotia, Thanksgiving is now a statutory holiday in most jurisdictions of Canada.
- Columbus Day in the US and Thanksgiving in Canada have fallen around the same time since 1971.
- The cornucopia, also known as the horn of plenty, represents abundance and nourishment. It is particularly associated with the Thanksgiving

- holiday in North America.
- > Quebec calls Thanksgiving "Action de grâce."

How about some Turkey fun facts?

- Of all the options for food, why is Turkey synonymous with Thanksgiving? According to an article from www.slate.com here is why...."They were fresh, affordable, and big enough to feed a crowd. Americans have long preferred large poultry for celebrations because the birds could be slaughtered without a huge economic sacrifice. Cows were more useful alive than dead, and commercial beef wasn't widely available until the late 19th century. Chicken was more highly regarded than it is today, but rooster meat was tough, and hens were valuable as long as they laid eggs. Venison would have been another option, especially during the 17th and 18th centuries, though it would have required you to hunt for your Thanksgiving meal. There was plenty of ham or brined pork around, but it wasn't considered fit for special occasions. Eating turkey was also in keeping with British holiday customs that had been imported to the New World."
- During Thanksgiving 2020, 2.5 million whole turkeys were purchased by Canadians, equal to 36% of all whole turkeys that were sold over the year.
- > Turkey consumption can cause tiredness due to its tryptophan, a naturally occurring amino acid used by the human body to create serotonin, which promotes slow-wave sleep.
- The breaking of the wishbone tradition originated when the ancient Romans pulled apart chicken bones looking for good luck. The English adopted it in the 16th century and then In the New World, Pilgrims played tug-of-war with wild turkey bones.
- > The actual "wishbone" term emerged in the 1800's.
