

## LET'S TALK ABOUT BOULEVARDS AND OBSTRUCTIONS

#### **Points Of Interest**

"Boulevard" means, an urban area, the part of a highway that is not a roadway and is that part of the sidewalk that is not especially adapted to the use of, or ordinarily used by pedestrians.

Here is what we are finding in the community while we patrol:

- Vehicles that are parked on the boulevard
- Holiday trailers that are parked on the boulevard
- Trees and planters being planted on the boulevard

We would like to remind the community that the boulevard is the property of the municipality, but we need your help to maintain them, so they look their best. Our boulevard is 10 feet from the curb as a reminder.

#### Please:

- keep grass on the boulevard cut to a length of no more than 10 cm.
- remove any accumulation of fallen leaves or other refuse or debris.
- notifying the Municipality if tree maintenance is required if they are boulevard trees
- keep grass inside the edge of the boulevard, or property line to avoid creeping on the sidewalk, curbs, or street.

These are all sections stated in our Community Standards Bylaw 2016-18

#### **Roadway Obstructions**

Here is what we are finding in the community while we patrol:

- No one can park on the street or alley way causing issues with blocking access, if you do, you must notify the office for approval. Deliveries for the purpose of unloading that doesn't exceed 30 minutes is ok
- No one can restrict pedestrian access across the sidewalks
- Reminder to please remove branches that are restricting sidewalk access, alleyway access, road access and restricts sight lines.

These are all sections stated in our Traffic Bylaw 2006-05 Traffic Bylaw 2006-05

We will be going out into the community to notify property owners.





#### **Recycling bags for pesticide containers**

Leduc County provides two agricultural pesticide container collection sites for pesticide containers up to 23 litres for recycling through the CleanFARMS program.

CleanFARMS has recently made changes to its recycling program; effective immediately, only bagged jugs will be picked up for their recycling program.

This will allow for efficiencies in trucking and handling – bagged jugs will now be compacted and transported to the recycling site for shredding.

Moving forward, loose jugs will not be handled for loading at the collection sites; ALL USERS of these facilities are now required to bag their empty, rinsed jugs before depositing them in the

collection site facility. A supply of bags have been left at both the Thorsby and the Nisku container sites for this purpose and you are also welcome to stop in to the Leduc County Community and Operations Centre at 1105 -5th Street, Nisku to pick up a supply of bags ahead of your crop spraying season. Please use the bags provided for this purpose as they are made from a plastic grade compatible with this recycling program and standard garbage bags or blue recycling bags are not.

CleanFARMS is working with ag retailers to provide additional disposal site options in the future.







Now a retired fisherman and trapper, the author was one of an estimated 150,000 First Nations, Inuit, and Metis children who were taken from their families and sent to governmentfunded, church-run schools, where they were subjected to a policy of "aggressive assimilation." As Augie Merasty recounts, these schools did more than attempt to mold children in the ways of white society. They were taught to be ashamed of their native heritage and, as he experienced, often suffered physical and sexual abuse. 

You can even believe the governments religion which they call science, but it won't save you from covid, or any other sickness; nor will it help you learn about God's creation. There is a thing called truth. Truth doesn't change. According to Merriam-Websters Dictionary, truth is: "a (1) the body of real things, events and facts: ACTUALITY. (2) the state of being the case: FACT. (3) often capitalized: a transcendent fundamental or spiritual reality." God has given us the freedom to choose. We are free to believe whatever we want. 
