Recycling bags for pesticide containers

Leduc County provides two agricultural pesticide container collection sites for pesticide containers up to 23 litres for recycling through the CleanFARMS program.

CleanFARMS has recently made changes to its recycling program; **effective immediately, only bagged jugs will be picked up for their recycling program.**

This will allow for efficiencies in trucking and handling – bagged jugs will now be compacted and transported to the recycling site for shredding.

Moving forward, loose jugs will not be handled for loading at the collection sites; ALL USERS of these facilities are now required to bag their empty, rinsed jugs before depositing them in the

collection site facility. A supply of bags have been left at both the Thorsby and the Nisku container sites for this purpose and you are also welcome to stop in to the Leduc County Community and Operations Centre at 1105 – 5th Street, Nisku to pick up a supply of bags ahead of your crop spraying season. *Please use the bags provided for this purpose as they are made from a plastic grade compatible with this recycling program and standard garbage bags or blue recycling bags are not.*

CleanFARMS is working with ag retailers to provide additional disposal site options in the future.

Therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live; that you may love the LORD your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, for He is your life and the length of your days;"** (Modern English Version Deut. 30:19-20). We have the freedom to choose, but our choices will determine whether we live a life filled with blessings or curses, life or death. God even gives us a suggestion. "Choose life." Choose to believe truth. **Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you remain in My word, then you are truly My disciples. You shall know the truth, and the truth shall set you free."** (John 8:31-32). There is a thing called truth, and if you believe and act on it you will be set free from the lies of the devil. **Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also. From now on you do know Him and have seen Him"** (John 14:6-7). Jesus is THE way, THE truth, and THE life. Only through Him can we access God the Father. **For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ. For it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith. As it is written, "The just shall live by faith."** The wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth through unrighteousness. For what may be known about God is clear to them since God has shown it to them. The invisible things about Him—His eternal power and deity—have been clearly seen since the creation of the world and are understood by the things that are made, so that they are without excuse. Because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him or give thanks to Him as God, but became futile in their imaginations, and their foolish hearts were darkened. Claiming to be wise, they became fools. They changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man, birds, four-footed beasts, and creeping things. Therefore God gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their own bodies among themselves. They turned the truth of God into a lie and worshipped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. For this reason God gave them up to dishonorable passions. Their women exchanged the natural function for what is against nature. Likewise the men, leaving the natural function of the woman, burned in their lust toward one another, men with men doing that which is shameful, and receiving in themselves the due penalty of their error. And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not proper. They were filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit. They are gossips, slanderers, God-haters, insolent, proud, boastful, inventors of evil things, and disobedient toward parents, without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, calloused, and unmerciful, who know the righteous requirement of God, that those who commit such things are worthy of death. They not only do them, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them (Rom. 1:16-32).

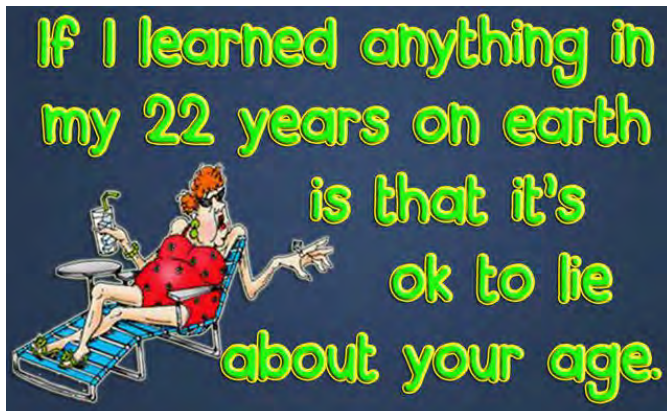

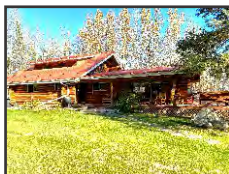
