LOCAL PASTOR SERVES OTHERS IN POLAND

I'm sure you have read local Pastor Natasha Westerhoud's weekly "Soul Care" reflection in our Booster. Well she is back from her humanitarian work with the refugees and will be highlighting some of her experiences in Poland. Here is her first submission.



"I am home. And it feels good to be back!!!

It is very difficult to put into words the life changing week I had encountered while serving in Poland. I thought that I would share bits and pieces of my time there through the next few weeks in the hopes to share my experience with the larger community I serve.

My journey started with a ten-hour flight into Warsaw while skipping eight hours ahead. I was grateful to land and meet up with one of my teammates who is a college student from Singapore. I thought we had navigated our way to the train station quite well, until we got to the 'English' ticket kiosk and found out it was out of order.

We moved on to the other kiosk only to be confused as we could not read or understand which ticket to buy for our next station. My teammate suggested we just get on the train without a ticket, what could go wrong? I on the other hand had some reservations only to be confirmed by a young man's voice behind us...'excuse me...a lot can go wrong...' He guided us to the right tickets and then went out of his way to join us on the next two of the three trains we needed to go on to get to Chelm, the city we were staying in. I appreciated his hospitality and he shared with me that he wanted us to have a good Poland experience. His name was Peter, and he is currently living in the UK and he was coming home to visit his mom, for the first time in almost three years. He shared with us that his mom is doing well but is in need of a bit of help as she has opened her home to 21 refugee's, 17 children and 4 moms. Of course, I wanted to hear the rest of the story, so in our two-hour delay for the next train we sat over a strong coffee and he shared his story with me.



Council appointed Metrix Group LLP as the provider of the external audit services for Brazeau County for the fiscal years of 2022-2024.



- The exact location planned for the fireworks display including a diagram of the grounds on which it will be held, showing the point from where the fireworks will be discharged, the location of all highways, and the lines behind which the audience will be restrained
- Written consent from the owner of the property on which the fireworks display will occur
- The manner and place of storage of all fireworks prior to, during and after the display
- The name and address of the vendor or vendors that supplied or will supply all the fireworks used in the fireworks display

His mom is in her late 70's and lives in a small simple home, but when the war started in Ukraine, she was convicted to do what she could, so she took in 21 refugees. They have been with her for almost 100 days. Peter shared she doesn't have much, just a small home with a bathroom and all she can offer is the floor to sleep on and some food and safety. Peter went on to share that his mom is doing well health wise, but she is tired, so he wanted to come home and help as much as he can. Our time was up, and I needed to leave, but not without a hug and some blessings.

This was day one of my journey and I have already experienced such radical hospitality.

- A young man going out of his way to help two women who seemed very lost.
- A mom who opened her home and heart to 21 strangers and is doing what she can with what she has during horrific times. All this to offer some hope in what would seem like a hopeless situation.

After getting on my last train, I had an hour to process all that I heard and witnessed, and was challenged to look at my life a bit deeper and ask myself in what ways do I offer radical hospitality?

Do I live a life that includes doing what I can with what I have so I can offer some hope?

If this is day one...I can't wait to see what the rest of the week holds!

AGE WELL AT HOME INITIATIVE

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead wishes to advise seniors of the launch of a new initiative called Age Well at Home, which will help seniors stay in their homes for as long as possible by providing them with practical assistance for everyday tasks. As part of the calls for proposals, organizations will be able to apply for funding for projects under two streams: In-Home Support Pilot Projects and Scaling Up for Seniors.

The In-Home Support Pilot Projects stream funds eligible organizations across Canada that have experience delivering one or more specific volunteer-based services to seniors. Organizations need to provide at least one of the eligible practical support services to low-income and otherwise vulnerable seniors in a local area, as well as help seniors navigate, and access eligible services provided by other local organizations. Eligible services are:

- light housekeeping (such as laundry, cleaning);
- meal delivery and/or preparation;
- home maintenance (such as repairs, yard work, lawn mowing);
- transportation (such as to appointments, errands):
- snow removal;
- volunteer drop-offs (such as groceries, medication, pet supplies); and
- friendly visiting in the home.

The Scaling Up for Seniors stream provides funds to eligible organizations to expand services that have already demonstrated results in helping seniors age in place. Applications must propose to deliver services in more than one province or territory.

Organizations are invited to apply for the In-Home Support Pilot Projects stream and the Scaling Up for Seniors stream of the Age Well at Home initiative until July 22, 2022.

To the Editor:

Here are some more "musings" concerning Brazeau County Council. (June 7/22)

It should be noted that the public will no longer be allowed to wear hats in chambers. The rationale for such is presumably related to "respect." One reason for hat removal was the picture of Queen Elizabeth. Another (attempted excuse) was that the council is a "quasi-judicial" body. It is not.

Two things should be noted. One: respect is earned, not legislated; and two: there are several official complaints ongoing (or in the works) regarding the "respect" of councillors either to each other or to the public. Look after your own issues of "respect"!

Come to your own conclusions as to the motivation for the above. (Apparently a councillor in a near-by county wears a hat to all county meetings, as did a former Brazeau councillor.)

It took over ½ hour to discuss the matter of hats; imagine the time to deal with shoes! How does this motion benefit the electorate? Did this discussion on such a petty matter create an "over-time" situation?

Another issue is a proposed road of a mile on Township Road 474 between RR52 and 53. It involves crossing three significant draws (valleys), one of which will cover a distance of several hundred yards of fill to about 45' depth. My view of staff assessment as to costs and completion issues are underestimated. Staff was required to provide a plan without land acquisition.

Since the solution requires land acquisition which may not be available (to handle 45' of dirt so it won't slide), why are they proceeding with the proposal (a more realistic figures is \$ 4 million—my estimate, considering that the adjacent mile cost \$1 million and it is on the level.

Other issues are lack of guard rails, narrowness of road, and an 8% grade making it too dangerous for a school bus.

It should be noted that this mile benefits only ONE family!

How is spending several million for the benefit of one family (yet again) of benefit for all the county? For answers, call the Reeve.
