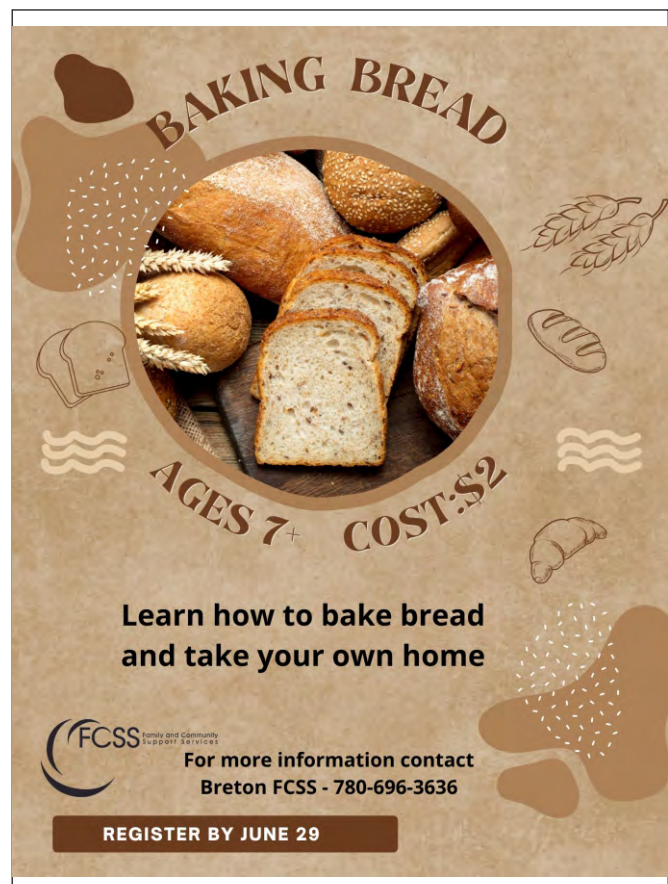
Summer Youth Program

BRAZEAU COUNTY PROPERTY TAXES DUE JUNE 30

Payment of Brazeau County property taxes is required by 5 p.m. on June 30. Penalties of 1% will be applied to any outstanding taxes on the first business day of July.

Those eligible for the 30% municipal tax rebate must pay their taxes in full by the deadline in order to receive the rebate.

If you have not received your 2022 tax and assessment notice contact the Brazeau County office at 780-542-7777 as soon as possible to avoid penalties.

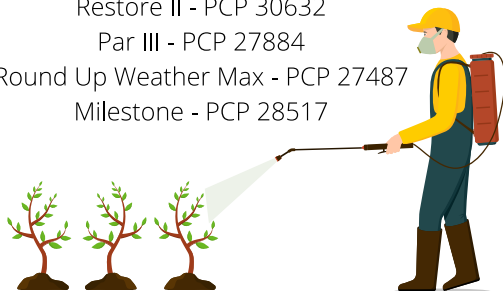

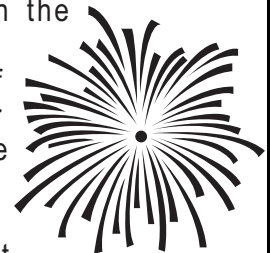
CONSUMER FIREWORKS ARE NOT TOYS.

They are in fact, powerful pyrotechnic articles and, for this reason, both their sale and purchase are regulated.

Fireworks permit can be obtained from Drayton Valley Brazeau County Fire Services at 5120- 52nd in Drayton Valley during regular business hours, for a \$10 fee.

Fireworks permit application shall include the following information:

- Name, address, and signature of applicant
- The date and time of proposed display
- A detailed description of the proposed display
- The exact location planned for the fireworks display including a diagram of the grounds on which it will be held, showing the point from where the fireworks will be discharged, the location of all highways, and the lines behind which the audience will be restrained
- Written consent from the owner of the property on which the fireworks display will occur
- The manner and place of storage of all fireworks prior to, during and after the display
- The name and address of the vendor or vendors that supplied or will supply all the fireworks used in the fireworks display

INTEREST RELIEF FOR AGRICULTURE PRODUCERS

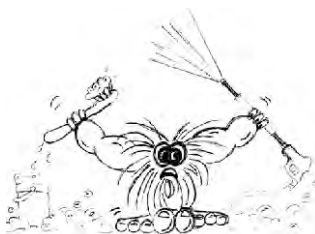

"IT'S NOT THE SIZE OF THE ARTIFACT THAT TELLS THE STORY"

Over the past year, I have written about some of the artifacts contained in the Breton Museum's collection. As we come up to Canada Day, I want to focus on a little lapel button we have in our collection. The pin is from the Antross Community Picnic which was held July 1st in Breton. The pin is dated 1929 with the "Proceeds in Aid of Hospital". It would appear that even in 1929 the community was looking to establish a hospital in the Breton Community. It would be 1963, over thirty years later, before this dream of a hospital in Breton would be realized. While this pin is now ninety-three years old, I still see this type of community spirit alive in Breton as we approach July 1st. While the cause changes the spirit of community is still evident. The "Buck for Boobs" fundraiser to be held looks to raise funds for Breast Cancer Research.

This small unassuming pin shows that it isn't always the size of the artifact that contributes to its value in the museum's collection, but the story that goes with it. The value lies in the story of the artifact to help tell a story about our community's history.

Sometimes the story isn't complete, as is the case with this artifact, and we continue to seek more information. Unfortunately, there is no one left from that time period to ask more questions about the details of raising funds towards the hospital. Here is what we do know about the lapel pin. It was donated by Ross and Betty Williams about fifteen years ago. It had



been found by Ross's mother, Thelma Williams, in the house she resided in for many years in Breton.

We are often approached at the museum about potential donations of items and ask ... what are you looking for... my answer is what do you have, and will it help us tell a story about Breton and District. It isn't always about being big, rare or of great monetary value. The little lapel pin is a prime example.

HIGHLIGHTS

Fire Services Report

Council received the Drayton Valley/Brazeau County Fire Services statistics report for March, April and May. During those three months, the fire department received 103 total calls, with 44 calls in the County, 43 in Drayton Valley, three in Breton, and 15 calls to provincial highways. Of the calls in the County, 24 were fire calls, 15 were alarm calls, 10 were calls to assist another agency, two were motor vehicle collisions, and two were miscellaneous calls.

Support for Rodeo Queen

Council approved a \$1,000 Youth Sport grant to Tawnie Thompson, to support her competing in the Rodeo Queen component of the National High School Rodeo Finals in Wyoming July 17-23. Thompson was crowned Miss Alberta High School Rodeo Queen last year.

National Police Federation Call to Action

Council approved a motion to join the National Police Federation to call on the Government of Alberta to halt the idea of a new provincial police service and to invest the proposed new monies into underfunded critical services within Alberta, which would have a larger and more immediate impact on the health and well-being of all Albertans.

Three-year road plan

Council directed Administration to prepare a three-year road plan based on Council road priorities, and to research all funding options, including expropriation.

Reflections 3/10



My first morning in Poland started off with an amazing breakfast at the Hostel we had stayed at. It included some amazing rich coffee which I was excited to find out that it is pronounced the same in Polish as it is in Slovenian, Czarna kawa...I figured I can manage anything with some 'czarna kawa' in me!

I soon started to realize that the landscape that surrounded me was stunning. The spectacular view of the greenery was all around me, it felt familiar to me in some way.

I was picked up by our OM leader, Aneta who is from Poland and with her she had 3 other team members that had arrived that morning. Here we sit in our van, strangers from all over the world who will soon be friends, praying for each other and depending on one another.

We drove for about 30 minutes and found ourselves at the house that we will call home for the next few days. The host family has an amazing story of radical generosity and hospitality. A few years ago, the host family had started to fix up their home adding more rooms and



bathrooms without really knowing why. Their children had all left and are married with their own homes, so they did not need to do this, yet they felt led. When the war started in Ukraine, Aneta felt like she needed to do something immediately, so she got in her car with what she thought refugees might need and drove six hours to the border to see what OM could do in order to provide

humanitarian aid during this critical time for people. Through her church, she found out about this couple who she could stay with, and the couple saw the need to not only host her, but her whole team as the teams started to come in from all over the world.

It is not easy to give up your whole home and have complete strangers 'take' over. It is hard enough sometimes to share the space you have with your own loved ones; I can't imagine complete strangers every week!

It is not easy to share your personal space. It is not easy to give up and surrender. Yet here they were, doing just that.

I had gotten to know the host family, in particular Gosia, who is the woman of the house. God called this couple to let go of their home to surrender and really open up their home to strangers every day for the last 100 days and who knows how many more days. She wanted this to be a part of her story yet giving up her home was challenging as the kitchen is packed with food everywhere, and her upstairs space is filled with supplies and people. She shares with me it stretches her as she sees things

that may need to be cleaned up, picked up, as people walk in and out week by week. Yet God has been teaching her to let go and to surrender, and to trust Him to provide what needs to be as people share their space.

Her husband works away a lot and is not home, so she appreciates the full house and company. Her gift of hospitality and her example of radical generosity is something I will not forget.



We spent time together at her kitchen table sharing czarna kawa and stories about our lives. It was so fun to meet her best friend of 40 some years and get to know her too. I am forever grateful that God has provided the comfort of this home for those being called to leave their own home. There is a sense of peace and safety here, that is what I want for my home to all those who enter it. A sense of peace, safety, and the ability to offer radical hospitality.

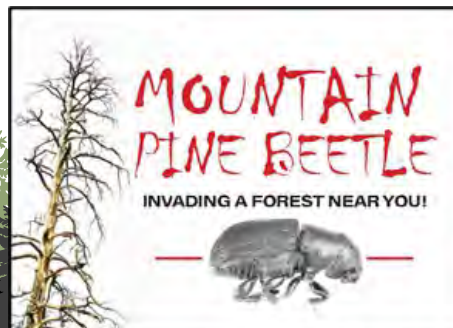

ELECTRICITY REBATES TO START ARRIVING ON JULY BILLS

Beginning in July, almost two million Albertans will receive rebates on their electricity bills to help them manage high electricity costs.

More than 1.9 million homes, farms and small businesses will receive monthly credits of \$50 on their July, August and September electricity bills, for a total of \$150 in rebates.

The Alberta government's \$300-million rebate program will help alleviate some of the high utility costs that many families and businesses have faced during recent months.

Quick facts

- All utility customers currently connected to the electricity system that have consumed electricity within the past calendar year, up to a maximum of 250 megawatt hours per year, are automatically eligible for the rebates.
- Consumers will receive the rebate as a credit to their electricity bills from the utility provider that provides their electricity.
- The rebate will appear as an individual line item on the electricity bill as the "GOA Utility Commodity Rebate."
- Consumers will receive \$50 each month for three consecutive months, with most rebates starting to show on July's electricity bills.
- Consumers who believe they meet the eligibility criteria but have not received the rebates by the end of July should contact the Utility Consumer Advocate at 310-4822 or UCAhelps@gov.ab.ca for assistance.

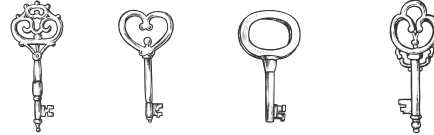
