Jesus said "The Father judges no one, but has committed all judgment to the Son, that all men should honor the Son, just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him. Truly, truly I say to you, whoever hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has eternal life and shall not come into condemnation, but has passed from death into life" (John 5:22-24). Paul wrote in his book to the Romans, "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, who walk not according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set me free from the law of sin and death" (Rom. 8:1-2). Jesus has judged us to be free from the punishment for sin, and He has judged us to be free from sickness. In Matthew chapter 12 Jesus healed a man with a withered hand in the temple. Then He went out and was followed by a multitude of people, and He healed them ALL. Then Matthew quotes a prophecy from Isaiah chapter 42 to indicate that the healings Jesus did are a judgment to victory. Here is his quote of the prophecy, "Here is My Servant, whom I have chosen, My Beloved, in whom My soul is well pleased; I will put My Spirit upon Him, and He will render judgment to the Gentiles. He shall not struggle nor cry out, nor will anyone hear His voice in the streets. A bruised reed He will not break, and a smoldering wick He will not quench, until He renders judgment unto victory; and in His name will the Gentiles trust" (Mat. 12:18-21). Psalms 103:6 says, "The Lord does righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed". Please read all of Psalm 103. God is not judging you by making you sick. His judgment is that you are healed and free!! Jesus healed All the sick in the multitudes of people. He NEVER made anyone sick. Acts 10:38 "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with **Him.**" Notice that the infirmities which Jesus healed are referred to as oppression of the devil. The infirmity came from the devil. If you believe in Jesus as your Lord and Saviour, He has declared a judgment of freedom and victory for you!!
