

- 1957 saw the continued growth of bigger taller tail fins on new cars and more lights, bigger with more powerful engines and an average car sold for \$2,749.
- The Soviet Union launched the first space satellite Sputnik 1.
- Movies included "Twelve Angry Men" and "The Bridge Over the River Kwai", and TV showed "Perry Mason" and "Maverick" for the first time. The final new episode of the classic television comedy "I Love Lucy" aired on CBS
- The music continued to be Rock and Roll with artists like Little Richard, Elvis Presley & Jerry Lee Lewis
- The popular toys were Slinkys and Hula Hoops.
- The continued growth of the use of credit was shown by the fact that 2/3 of all new cars were bought on credit
- The first frisbee toys were purchased and released by toy company Wham-O. The frisbee was originally named the Pluto Platter.
- The Asian Flu pandemic claimed over 150,000 lives world wide.







#### BRETON JULY 1ST CELEBRATIONS PAST AND PRESENT

by Allan Goddard, Breton Museum

Well, another July1st has come and gone in Breton. As I visited with people, at the museum, during the day the conversation turned to past July1st. Ted Grzyb and Theo Westling wrote a comprehensive article in the "Ladder of Time" history book detailing the history of the Breton Community Club. In the article there is reference to old timers talking of a Sports Day held July 1st, 1926. We do know that by 1929 the Antross community held a picnic at Breton on July 1st. So, it's safe to say that July 1st has been celebrated in Breton for more than 90 years. It seems that the term "Sports Day" was used in the early days when referring to July 1st activities.



The museum's collection holds the record book from the Breton Community Club for the years 1937- 1959. In the minutes from June 1944, they discuss what events would take place on July 1st: included both baseball and softball, tug of war and races of all kinds. Oh, did I mention that horse races were included with an entry fee of \$1.00 per horse. For many years baseball was the big event with prize money for the winning teams. Admission to the grounds was set at twenty-five cents for adults with school children admitted free. To round out the day there was a show featured in the Community Hall and a dance at Nelson's Hall on Main Street. Yes. Breton had two halls back then, both hosting a variety of functions, sometimes on the same night. There is a note at the end of the minutes that rain in the early morning delayed the schedule by two hours... "but a good time was had by a record crowd".

Nellie Whalen, daughter of Floyd and Elizabeth Hayes, related a wonderful story about an early Sports Day in Breton when a hundred pounds of flour was put up as a prize, to the largest family. On the day of the Picnic and Sports Day they discovered that they were not the only large family in the community, when another family also showed up with nine children. Now a hundred pounds of flour was a major prize, especially to a large family in those days. The prize was split with each family receiving fifty pounds. Elizabeth was sure the other couple had borrowed someone else's child, and for some time after, whenever she saw the family, she would count their children. She remarked to her husband Floyd some time later... "I guess those children did belong to that couple".

The parade is frequently mentioned as a highlight of the day. Remember Ray and Jenny Ellis and their team of sheep which he had trained to pull a small wagon with them in parades. A visitor to the museum related remembering a Mid Way set up north of the present-day community hall.

While the activities have changed over the years from a focus on sports events, to a gathering with family, friends and old acquaintances, July 1st is still an important annual event in Breton. Here are just a few of the events that come to my mind from the past: the crack of the bat, as both baseball and fastball were major events, horseshoes and horse pulls, bingo in the hall for twenty cents a card, chicken poop bingo, Lumberjack Days, fiddler jamborees and Gwen Hooks' releasing her book Keystone Legacy. Everyone will have their own special memories of July 1st in Breton. After two years of not being able to gather, it was nice to see July 1st in Breton back to normal.




