"One Ring-A-Dingy, Two Ring-A-Dingy" Or Two Shorts and a Long

I know the younger readers of this article will have a puzzled look on their faces as to ... what does two shorts and a long mean. Before the days of social media, both good and bad, there was the local telephone operator and party lines. Oh, I can envision the seniors of the community starting to reminisce about joys of a party line and rubbernecking. Don't feel bad, the writer of this article is also part of this age group. For the young'un's, a party line was like having ALL of the community as one of your friends on Facebook, without the advantage of Messenger.

Breton's telephone operator was Eleanor Reid... let the stories begin. Eleanor and her husband George moved to Breton in 1945 where George worked as a mechanic, and later as a trucker delivering supplies to the lumber camps. In April 1947 Eleanor became the operator of the telephone office. Eleanor had experience working as an operator in Westlock before she was married. The job of a telephone operator was one which many young women had in the first half of the 20th century.

At that time the exchange consisted of four lines, one for long distance and three local business lines. Remember this was just for Breton. You know you live in a small town when your phone number is 4. Within a few years phones were becoming more common, so more longdistance lines were added and the switch board enlarged to accommodate additional local telephones.

Fire destroyed the telephone exchange in 1950 but it was soon rebuilt. During the 1950's Eleanor not only had Breton customers, but two rural telephone mutuals: one for the rural Breton area and one for the Funnell District, and later a switch board for the Breton Hospital.

In the case of the Funnell Telephone Mutual which started in 1958 with 25 customers, ON ONE LINE, and was connected to the Breton Exchange. After five years, as more customers wanted telephone service the Funnell Mutual was expanded but this time there were only eight customers to a line. Which brings me to the term "Rubber-Necking", the dictionary definition is ... to stare wonderingly or inquisitive. It also was used to refer to the listening in on a telephone conversation. As more people quietly picked up the telephone receiver to listen in, the poorer the connection became. And you thought that Facebook spread news fast.

Eleanor ran the telephone exchange until 1965 when the telephone system was automated. Even after the automation of dialing, the party line continued. By the time we received phone service in the late 1960's, the lines were installed underground and each line had a maximum of 4 customers to a line. It wasn't until the early 1990's, under Premier Don Getty, that private phone lines were installed in rural Alberta.

Recently the Breton Museum received, as a donation, the head set which Eleanor Reid used in the Breton Telephone Exchange. I have to wonder what juicy conversations that headset has heard.





Counselling Subsidies

Breton and Area FCSS is pleased to offer Counselling Subsidies.

A subsidy is available for individuals, couples and/or families who are struggling with common, everyday issues to access short-term preventative counselling services. The goal is to:

- Improve relationships with better communication and conflict resolution skills;
- Improve mood with anger management and emotional support;
- Enhance personal growth with creativity, spirituality, self-esteem, self-awareness, goal setting;
- Improve parenting skills by focusing on attachment;
- Reduce stress with life balance; and/or
- Learn new skills and behaviors

The cost of counselling can be a barrier for many individuals and families. This subsidy is available to those who do not have access to coverage through health benefits or employee benefits, such as an Employee Assistance Plan (EAP), and whose family income is less than \$75,000 per year. Fees are determined according to a sliding scale based on income and family size. Fees range from \$15 per session to \$50 per session. The maximum number of sessions available is seven for individuals and nine for couples or families.

Counselling services are provided through a

partnership with Karunia Counselling from Leduc.

We know that in this current environment many may have additional stress and anxiety. We also know that transportation may be an added barrier. These sessions can be arranged to be in person in the Karunia offices in Leduc, over the phone in your own safe environment or virtually on your computer.

Counselling services are provided by Karunia Counselling by Registered Psychologists, Registered Provisional Psychologists, Canadian Certified Counsellors and Masters or PhD level student interns under the supervision of a qualified psychologist. All applications will be kept in strict confidence.

Her name was Tayna. She pulled up in her car that was packed right full. The line at the border this evening was long and there were more cars than there had been in the past. We asked around as to why the increase and were told there has been some 'activity' on the Ukraine border side and people were trying to get out of the way, this also explained why

the border patrol security became more present this evening.

Tanya noticed our table and slowly made her way to grab a hot coffee. She had this glazed look about her, tired and worn out and a bit nervous kind of look. Our eyes met and I asked her Yak spravy? (How are you?) She answered in the little English she knew, and we hit it off and for the next five hours she shared her story.

She was on her way to go be with her mom and her two children who were 11 and 14. In March they left their home in Ukraine when things grew progressively worse all around them. In freezing temperatures, they waited at the border crossing for 3 days in their car. She had no idea how she made it out. Her husband had to stay behind, and she was unsure if she was ever going to see him again. The men need to stay and fight, she tells me, and we will do what we can to save our country. They made their way into Poland to stay with her brother,' he doesn't have a big house, but we can stay there', she shared with me. She continued her story, sharing that a week ago she made her way back into Ukraine to load up the car with her children's favorite things. She asked me if I had children and I nodded,' then you understand' she tells me as kids need their things to feel safe. The car was full of bikes and skateboards, stuffies and games, all kinds of things they missed.

Tears started to roll down her cheek. 'I don't know what the future holds for them. I don't know what we will do. When can we return?' Why is this happening? How could it happen? I held her hand not having any words to share, just mutual tears shedding down our faces. Her husband is ok. He was asked to stay on where he works, keeping the cell towers working. She was grateful that he was ok, and she was able to see him for a few days.

She had no idea where to spend the night after she was released from the border. We were able to help her find a safe shelter for w o m e n i n th e nearby city, phoning ahead to make the arrangement. She



was so grateful for our care. I was so grateful for meeting her. She ran back to her car and when she came back, she handed me some cookies for our team to share and she gave me a little stuffed animal to give to my girl, it belonged to her girl. My heart was so humbled, and I accepted the gift, letting her know that I will always be thinking of her and her family.

I prayed with her and for her journey and hugged her. There is not a day that goes by that I do not think of my new friend, Tanya and her family. I pray she made it safe to the shelter and to her brother's home. I pray God protected her, as she is so vulnerable to be alone and a woman driving across a country she is not familiar with. There is a very large increase in human trafficking of woman and children in Poland during the last few months. One of our main goals while at the border is to help women become aware of the dangers and to help them look for safe transportation and places to stay.

I pray she is safe and well. If you think of it, can you also lift her up in prayer today? Who else can you be thinking about and praying for? Reach out to them, you never know what kind of impact you will make on someone's else's life with just one kind word.


