

# DONATION OF LAND BY THE HUTCHINSON FAMILY TO RUNDLE'S MISSION

Rundle's Mission has been the recipient of a large donation of land by the family of Gerald Hutchinson who had a long history with the area. The land consists of 144 acres and is regulated by the Nature Conservancy of Canada. It is a natural area and is where the trail for cross-country skiing and walking are. Previously Rundle's Mission had an agreement with the Hutchinson family for the use of that land, but has now been gifted it. A celebration and acknowledgement of the land donation and title transfer was held in June with members of the board of Rundle's Mission Society and Ken, Beth and Rob Hutchinson, the children of Gerald Hutchinson. Plans are for a wood bench to be placed on the top of the hill by the natural amphitheater acknowledging Rev. Gerry Hutchinson's contribution to the Mission Beach Area. The bench will be made from local wood and constructed by a local carver. Ken Hutchinson, son of Gerald Hutchison, was asked to write about his dad and his connection to the area.

"Gerald (Gerry) and Miriam (Mim) Hutchinson with children Ken and Beth moved to Telfordville in 1949. Gerry has studied agriculture both at Olds School of Agriculture and at U of A. He was interested in helping find ways to make the grey wooded soils of the area productive. They were active in getting both power and telephone service to the community.

Gerry was curious about the name Mission Beach and in searching for answers met Hobart Dowler. The two of them became the nucleus of what became Rundle's Mission and getting the lodge built in conjunction with several friends.

After serving the Telfordville Pastoral Charge for 19 years Gerry and Mim moved to Calgary where he was the first Executive secretary for the Alberta Conference of the United Church. At this time they bought the Freiman farm located immediately west of Rundle's Mission for a place they could retire to and because of the strategic location of the property between Rundle's Mission and the Youth camps.

For several years they share-cropped the property with Bill Woods. This was marginal for both parties and Gerry and Mim entered into a Nature Conservancy Agreement for the property. They lived there until health issues had them relocating to Edmonton. The property was transferred to their children and last year the children donated the property to Rundle's Mission."

Rundle's Mission Society Board and members are very grateful for this land donation and the contribution of Gerry Hutchinson and family both to the history and current operation of Rundle's Mission often referred to as "The Meeting Place".

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



# NOTICE ON LAND TITLES DELAY CAUSING LATE PENALTY FEES

Due to ongoing delays with Land Titles document registration processing times, recent ownership and mailing address changes may not be reflected on municipal property tax notices. Albertans who recently purchased a property may not have received a tax notice from their municipality.

If you recently purchased a property, did not receive a tax notification from your municipality, and paid a late payment penalty due to non-payment, you may be eligible for reimbursement of your late payment penalty from the Government of Alberta.

# **Eligibility**

You can submit a request for reimbursement of your late payment penalty if you meet all of the following criteria:

- you have purchased a property within 3 months of your municipal tax deadline
- you or your legal advisor have submitted the required land title registration documents to the Land Titles Office, but the land title transfer was not completed between February 23, 2022 and July 30, 2022
- you did not receive a property tax bill from your municipality prior to the date your taxes were due
- you paid a late payment penalty to your municipality

# How to apply

If you think you are eligible for reimbursement of your late payment penalty, email <a href="mailto:pt.penalties@gov.ab.ca">pt.penalties@gov.ab.ca</a> and provide the following documentation:

- property owner name(s) and municipal address
- owner's mailing address (if different from above)
- legal land location (if known)
- urban (lot, block, plan number) or
- rural (quarter, section, range, meridian)
- date of property purchase
- document registration request (DRR) number, if known (provided when you or your legal advisor submitted title transfer documents to the Land Titles Office)
- proof of payment of your property taxes and late penalty, through an itemized statement of account from your municipality

The personal information collected through the property tax late penalty reimbursement program is for determining whether a land title transfer has been delayed and subsequent eligibility for property tax penalty reimbursement. This collection is authorized by section 33© of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. 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# TOWN OF THORSBY COUNCIL MEETING NOTES

July 26, 2022

- CONX Wireless is a company that provides access and monitoring to bulk water stations. It is designed for Municipalities, Counties and Townships. The Town is looking at upgrading their system as there are many benefits with it. There is cell phone access and control, automatic shut off as well as the use of a FOB. Our existing Bulk water system has many limitations, including limited revenue. The Council has received the information and will consider it after more discussions.
- There is a Commercial incentive for new and existing businesses. If approved an established and existing business will be eligible for a 50% break on the first year of the municipal portion of taxes, followed by 25% for years two and three. There is a five-year development incentive for new business construction.
- The Federation Canadian Municipalities is a program designed to unite and drive federal investments in infrastructure, housing, transit, and more. By joining the FCM there are new grant possibilities for infrastructure.
- Council has approved the skate park to be set up temporarily in the tennis court area.
   Signs will be posted: Enter at your own risk.
   There are some concerns with asphalt vs a concrete pad but for now public works will set up the skateboard park.
- The Town of Thorsby will become a member of the Chamber of Commerce. Councillor Tracy Musson will represent the Town at the Chamber meetings.

• Naming Rights Agreement: Arctic Spas Recreation Complex is again the official name of our recreational Complex. The agreement term is from June 2022-January 2031. Mark Bogusky, Marketing Manager, and Dennis Kellnor, President of Arctic Spas have signed the agreement with our Mayor and interim CAO. Major projects are proposed to be completed in the next 5 years at the complex. There is also an incentive for Arctic Spa employees to have a discount on memberships monthly or annually.
