# TOWN OF THORSBY REPORT

by Shawna Ofstie

First of all I want to thank CFO Cindy Van Leest for her detailed report last week. It is important that we know where our tax dollars are going and that policies and procedures are in place so this won't happen again. It is time to put an end to the trend in Thorsby over the last two decades. This is all public information and if you have questions feel free to contact our CAO or CFO. As a taxpayer of both business and residential in Thorsby who attends most meetings, I am grateful we have such a knowledgeable and transparent administration and Council in 2022 who are easy to work with and willing to move forward and support our community!

Here are some of the other items discussed at the COW meeting that didn't make into last week's Target.

### Leduc Regional Housing Foundation

Executive director Margot Hagarty explained how through partnerships and programs, they support communities by providing quality housing solutions and services to seniors, individuals and families. It is a misconception that they only support seniors. In 2021 27% of clients were children, 30% adults and 34% children. She also expressed the high need for funding. All seven local Municipalities provide a representative from their community to sit on a Board of Directors with the exception of Leduc County who has 2 representatives. With Government funding and grants, the foundation helps individuals and families access affordable housing, however there is a waiting list for some of the programs. www.leducregionalhousing.ca

### **Regional Water Feasibility Study**

This was reported on last week but I wanted to clarify that this study is only the first step in formalizing a regional water system and other communities are not required to participate. The surrounding communities have to agree to participate in this free study of their infrastructure that could potentially save them money and possibly result in more grant money. Projects to improve water and wastewater services and access to clean drinking water for rural communities are happening all over the province and a huge priority for the current UCP government.

### Bylaws - Fees & Services / Commercial Dev

The Town of Thorsby previously did not have a current Fees and Services Bylaw so administration has drafted one for Council to review. Did you know you need a permit for a Commercial Business sign, Event Sign, Magnetic sign or if you get a bin? Did you know that you need a development permit for a deck or storage shed over 10' x 10' or for demolitions? They are also looking at changing back to annual fees and permitting instead of lifetime for dog control due to the difficulty keeping track of animals when owners get rid of them or they pass away. These are only a few of the fees that are collected and will be in the new Bylaw.

The Commercial Development incentive policies were reviewed and will now be in a bylaw because it is a "Tax" and part of the financial governance policy section. Incentives will be reviewed as well in hopes of attracting new business into Thorsby.

### **Communities in Bloom**

Administration and Communities in Bloom have identified an ideal location for the fruit trees to be planted. A pathway running from the Lions Campground into the trails provides shelter and protection for the fruit trees and edible bushes in a natural environment. The Rural Mental Health Grant that was shared between Warburg and Thorsby provided the funds for the tree planting and signage to identify them.

The CAO and Recreation Manager will be working with CIB to ascertain a new MOU regarding their involvement with the trails, a new trail plan and proper oversight on the trails and naming systems.

### Water Treatment Operations

After the heavy rains it became apparent that we need upgrades to our stormwater system and a grant will be sourced out for a storm/wastewater study so the town knows where to upgrade properly.

### **Recreation Department**

The Recreational Complex and Arctic Spas have finalized the sponsorship agreement.

The active membership for July was 52 compared to 22 in 2019. This is a significant increase in the use of it.

Summer programs saw an increase of approx 40 kids.

The skateboard park has been unloaded into the Tennis Courts. This park will be open 24/7. Councillor Cory Gilbert and previous Councillor Nathan Raymond have volunteered to set it up.
