WARBURG WALL OF FAME

I was honoured to attend my very first Wall of Fame ceremony. There were two recipients who will have their accomplishments displayed at the Warburg High School on the Wall of Fame.

Nancy Farmer was born and raised in Calgary Alberta until her and her family moved to Warburg in 1981. She graduated from Warburg school in 1984. Nancy joined the Calgary police force in October of 1995 where she had a great career with many accomplishments being the first female officer to achieve multiple positions throughout the police force. Nancy recieved the Alberta Emergency Services medal, Police Exemplary Service Medal and the 12 and 20 year Long Service Medals. After retiring from the police force, Nancy started policing for the Tsuut'ina Nations Police Service in March of 2021. Nancy was the first female to received an affirmed position to Sergeant on the Eagle Feather. She has reached many milestones throughout her career and continues to do so.

Farah Elawar graduated from Warburg School in 2011. In 2015 she graduated from the University of Alberta with her bachelor of science. Farah was a gifted scientist and one of the core researchers that uncovered the Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) that millions of newborns are affected by daily. Farah volunteered with many different organizations at the U of A. Farah was the founder of the "Science to Business" student group. Farah was awarded a fellowship by the Women's and Children's Health Research Institute and honoured with the John Thibault Good Citizen memorial award. She was two months away from reaching her PhD in virology when she passed away on July 18, 2021 at the age of 28 years, in 2022 Farah's brother accepted her Phd from the University of Alberta. Farah was an extraordinary young woman who accomplished so much in such a short time.

ALERT's Internet Child Exploitation (ICE) unit has noticed an increase in the prevalence of sexual extortions taking place, primarily over the social media applications Snapchat and Instagram. The suspects are demanding banking or credit card information, gift cards or other means of online payment from the youth or their parents. The predominate age group targeted are boys aged 12-17.

Sextortion typically starts as a new friend request via social media, usually with the suspect masquerading as young woman. The suspect will create the appearance of a promising online relationship and obtain sexually explicit pictures from the victim.

Once obtained, the youth are blackmailed and threatened that this material will be released to friends, family, or shared on the internet, unless a payment is made. Since the offenders often show the victims' friends list from their social media profiles, the demands are repeated and unrelenting.

ICE offers the following tips if you're being extorted online:

- Immediately stop all communication;
- Do not comply with the threat;
- Speak to a trusted adult and report it to police; and
- Keep the correspondence.

Victims are encouraged to contact local police and seek out help if they are struggling.





