

## & THE WARBURG CULTURAL SOCIETY

Warburg Cultural Society members were very grateful when they were presented \$5,000 toward their renovation project from Wawanesa Insurance. Gord & Carol Enders of Direct Line Insurance in Warburg nominated the Cultural Society to receive this funding through Wawanesa's "Capital" Donations program. This program supports infrastructure, investments, equipment/technology improvements, programs that have a significant start-up cost, etc. (but not endowments), and are generally of a one time nature. Projects and programs must support one of their five focus areas: Arts & Culture; Community Activities; Education: Health: and Social Services and charities which provide wide community support and broad community benefits will be considered first. Some of the prior campaigns have included: building a garden gazebo at a nursing home, purchasing a new van for a High School for their field trips, assistance to a large

affordable housing project, CT Scanner donation to a public Health center and donation for the purchase of Chromebooks to an inner city school.

Direct Line Insurance has been temporarily working out of the Warburg Cultural Centre since December of 2021. Almost a year ago on November 28, 2021 a stolen front end loader was driven through the building in an attempt to remove the safe. The criminals attempt was unsuccessful but they managed to destroy the building so it could not be salvaged. It has been a long process and due to the delays and shortages still felt by "COVID" the hole remains where their building used to stand. Thankfully they are hoping to break ground in the next month according to owner Gord Enders.

Gord expressed his appreciation of the Cultural Society for allowing them to rent the building over the past year and to all of their customers and clients. This was a blessing in disguise for the Cultural Centre who had to shut down anyway during much of the time therefore they could still bring in a steady income. The Cultural Centre is excited to begin renovations once Direct Line's building is completed, hopefully by next summer.

We invite youth to join all Canadians as we honor and remember the contributions and Sacrifices of our Veterans, and those who died serving their country.



## WARBURG SCHOOL WALL OF FAME

Warburg School has a tradition of "excellence in all endeavors", which for many years was the school motto. Our Student Wall of Fame reflects this motto and also encompasses our present Leader in Me practice and our school mission statement:

The inductees on the Wall of Fame are a representation of Warburg School alumni who have been nationally or internationally recognized in achievements from many different paths in life. We believe that all of our students have the ability to achieve great things and be proactive in their life goals...and here are the 2022 Wall of Fame Recipients

FARAH ELAWAR (WS Grad '11) was inducted onto our Wall for her achievements in research focusing on respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) strains - the leading cause of child hospitalizations worldwide. Farah was a core member of the research team that solved the 80 year mystery of the receptor for R.S.V. This was first published in Nature, the most prestigious journal in the field of science. Farah had presented her research internationally, including Argentina, Ghana and the U.S.A. During her studies at the University of Alberta she was awarded a coveted graduate fellowship by the Women's and Children's Health Research Institute that supported her doctoral studies. Farah was also honored with the John Thibault Good Citizen memorial award for exhibiting good citizenship in the department of Medical Microbiology and Immunology.

Tragically Farah was killed in a car accident on July 18, 2021. To honour her memory, and to encourage & inspire our current students, the Elawar family have set up the Farah Elawar Memorial scholarship.

## NANCY FARMER (WS Grad '84)

was nominated by Angie Hrihorow and selected by committee to be inducted onto our Warburg



School Wall of Fame for her accomplishments in her 23.5 year career with the Calgary Police Service achieving the rank of Inspector, and now as a Sergeant in charge with the Tsuut'ina Nation Police Service.

Nancy held certification as a hostage negotiator and was a Nationally certified Critical Incident Commander for the Calgary Police Service. In 2017, she was selected to be the only female commander in Canada in charge of a Support Section. This section comprises the Mounted Unit, Canine Unit, Air Services Unit, Crisis Negotiations Unit and Tactical Units. She instructed components of the Incident Command course and the Basic and Refresher Crisis Negotiator courses held at the Canadian Police College in Ottawa, Ontario.

She was one of the facilitators for the rollout of R2MR – Road to Mental Readiness training for the organization. This program builds awareness of mental illness and operational stress injuries through education in reducing stigma. She served as the Secretary and Treasurer for the Senior Officers Association for several years and she currently sits on the Board of Directors for the Alberta Women in Policing (AWIP) committee. Inspector Farmer is a recipient of the Chief's Leadership Award (2018), the Exemplary Service Medal (2017) and Alberta Emergency Services Medal (2018). She believes that kindness is not a weakness and that accountability for everyone including herself in any organization is critical to having a successful workplace.







