HI BUSINESSES NEW CHANGES!

Changes to our New Business Bylaw were made in September 2022

Here are the new changes: Business Licencing Bylaw 2022-08

- Resident Businesses (Home Based) \$125.00
- Non-Resident Business \$250.00
- Non-Resident General Contractor \$350.00
- Hawkers/Peddlers \$50.00/Day \$200.00/Year
- 39/20 Alliance Business License \$50.00 (Services Breton, Warburg, Thorsby, Calmar)
- Event/Craft Market (CAO Authorized)

For a craft sale, a rummage sale, a flea market or a residential garage sale, as long as the sale is less than seven consecutive days.

Exemptions under the Business Bylaw are as follows:

- a. Charitable or Non-profit Organizations or Licensed Family Day Home
- b. Minors
- c. Non-Resident business delivering their own goods into town
- d. Resident businesses only, who purchase a Thorsby Resident Business Licence which will entitle them to work within any 39/20 Alliance member communities without the purchase of an additional non resident licence within those same communities
- e. Newspaper publishers and distributors
- f. Craft fairs/Trade Shows
- g. A business carried on by any person as part of the Thorsby and District Public Market

Businesses are exempt from licensing under the Provincial or Federal Statute (doctors, lawyers). They don't require a licence or fee, but we will issue the Thorsby Business License to them as a courtesy for their wall.



The online fillable application form is the fastest way for employers to apply online, while the Grants and Contributions Online Service requires the user to create an account before submitting an application for CSJ.




