WARBURG HOCKEY & SKATING ARENA CLUB RECEIVES GRANT OF \$1,000,000 for PHASE II

On January 13, 2023 president Rob Wenzel of the Warburg Hockey & Skating Arena Club received a letter from the Minister of Alberta Culture informing him that their Community Facility Enhancement Program (CFEP) Large Grant Application was approved. This means that Phase II of the Warburg Arena upgrades can begin.

In the June 16, 2017 issue of the Warburg Bugle it was announced that the Warburg Arena was about to begin a \$6.5 million upgrade project through a cost share program between Leduc County, Village of Warburg and Provincial Grant Support. This upgrade was to be done in two to three phases.

Construction for the first phase of the Warburg Arena Upgrades started in September of 2018 which included new dressing rooms down the west side of the building and a separate entrance for players and officials. The official grand opening for phase one was in October 2019.

According to the article in June of 2017, the second phase is much larger and includes:

- Gutting the existing front end of the building and then updating and modernizing the same area
- · Moving the upstairs bathrooms
- Adding a commercial kitchen upstairs, so this area can be used as a rental area for functions that don't need as large an area as the hall.
- The downstairs will be gutted and a viewing and seating area installed
- The concession will be moved to the bottom level. This area will be available for rent, along with ice time for celebrations such as birthday parties, etc.

- There will be bathrooms, a managers office and skate sharpening on the main floor
- An elevator will be installed so that the arena is wheelchair accessible
- The plant room and zamboni room will be enlarged and updated
- Storage rooms will be added to the east side of the area
- The entire outside of the arena will be done to match the outside of the hall and curling rink
- The rink area will feature more seating
- A gate will be installed in the south end boards, so there is outside access from the ice area
- Many other features just to bring the arena up to date.

Congratulations to the Club, all of those involved in making this happen. We will keep you informed once confirmed plans for phase 2 are released.
