

Anyone receiving monthly benefits through AISH, Income Support, Alberta Seniors Benefit or services through Persons with Developmental Disabilities (PDD) will get their payments automatically but will need to apply for additional payments if they have kids under 18.

Breton FCSS can assist with helping you navigate through this process if you need to apply.

#### Community Volunteer Income Tax Program

FREE INCOME TAX PREPARATION - For Low Income Persons, Families, seniors and students. Although this is something that most of us would like to avoid thinking about and doing, I am afraid that this is unavoidable. You need to file your income tax each year, even if you have no income to report. By doing this you may receive benefits that you did not know you were eligible for. Also, in the event of the death of your spouse, benefits can easily be transferred to you, if you have filled a return for the last calendar year. If you did not file a tax return in 2021 you may not be receiving benefits from the government that you are eligible for. The focus of the Community Volunteer Tax Program is to assist those individuals who have limited income. This includes seniors, families, and students. If your income was approximately in one of the following categories, you may qualify for assistance. \*1 person - \$35,000 / Couple -\$45,000 / Family - \$52,500



#### WORKING TOWARDS A NEW STOLLERY CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

Budget 2023 invests \$3 million over three years to advance the planning for a new, stand-alone Stollery Children's Hospital.

The Stollery is the second-largest children's hospital in Canada by bed count, second only to the Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto. However, unlike most children's hospitals in Canada, it is not a stand-alone building.

About 300,000 children go to the Stollery hospital each year. This includes nearly 55,000 emergency room visits and more than 12,000 surgeries. With almost 40 per cent of inpatients coming from outside the Edmonton area, the Stollery is a highly valued part of the health care system in Alberta and for outer parts of Canada.

"Every parent who has ever had to take a child to a children's hospital knows how valuable facilities like the Stollery are. Children's health care needs are unique, and a world-class, pediatric, stand-alone hospital for the Stollery will allow it to continue to be one of the leading children's hospitals in the country." Jason Copping, Minister of Health

The additional funding shows the government's commitment to invest in the treatment and care of Alberta's children both now and in the future.

A new children's hospital in Edmonton will provide more beds in private rooms, more space for kids to be with their families and supports, better teaching space and technologies that will enhance quality care for kids.

"At Alberta Health Services, we're continually working to improve the health care journey for patients and families. Exploring the potential of a new stand-alone Stollery Children's Hospital is immensely exciting for us. The Stollery serves an area far beyond Edmonton, with more than 300,000 patient visits each year. We're grateful for the opportunity to continue to explore new options to deliver world-class pediatric health care well into the future." Mauro Chies, president and CEO, Alberta Health Services

The investment in Budget 2023 is in addition to the \$1-million investment made in 2021, which was matched by the Stollery Children's Hospital Foundation. The Stollery Children's Hospital Foundation will also match the Alberta government's investment to further speed up planning for the new children's hospital — a project that government is fully committed to building once planning is complete.

The planning process will consider several needs and priorities facing the hospital, including increased capacity to serve Alberta's growing population, larger clinical spaces, more private rooms, and spaces built especially for children and the families that support them during their time in the hospital.


This commitment supports initial planning while the business case is being finalized. A full business plan is expected to be completed this summer.


