If you live in the Town of Thorsby, CAO Donna would like to invite you to be on the Trail Committee and have a voice in the future of the trails. We are looking for a more streamlined, resident centered approach for trail management and development.

The Town has taken the trails under its Parks and Recreation department as they are on municipal land with the exception of two on private land requiring legal agreements and open collaborative communication with landowners.

We are interested in holding meetings every two months starting in mid-spring, and depending on the final committee formed, a meeting schedule can be arranged that will work for all involved. Those meetings will involve CAO Donna Tona, Parks and Recreation Manager Kelley Probe, and Public Works Manager Andrew Kearley with the exception of emergencies and prior appointments.

To all those who want to have a say but don't want to be on the committee, we will always accept and read letters, calls, and emails from community members during the meetings, incorporating your ideas into our discussions. We look forward to this new collaborative approach to the trails.

Leduc County FCSS & FRN Annual Update

Dean Ohnysty, Sarah Russell (FCSS) and Carol Tabone (FRN) presented their partnerships and services. Keep reading each week for articles & information or go on the Leduc County Website to learn more.

Thorsby & District Chamber of Commerce Delegation

Shawna Ofstie, president of the Thorsby Chamber, talked about the Chambers accomplishments since the new Board started May 31, 2021. The Chamber is finally a Society as of January 13, 2023. Membership has over doubled. Shawna also told Council the benefits of being a member. They hosted a community collaboration meeting to make plans for the May long weekend at the end of February. Plans are coming together for May 20. Activities included are a parade, cornhole tournament, beer gardens, free family dance, 50/50, BBQ, market, Recreation complex activities, slow pitch tournament, and other possibilities. Next meeting is March 16 at 6:30 at the Recreation Complex.

Gord Bamford Concert

The Chamber is in partnership with Arctic Spas and the Town of Thorsby to bring Gord Bamford to Thorsby May 6. It will be held in Thorsby Arctic Spas Recreation Complex Arena. Proceeds from the event will go to much needed Maintenance & Upgrades at the Complex.

Thorsby Lions Campground MOU draft

An MOU between the Town of Thorsby and the Thorsby Lions Club regarding the campground was discussed. The draft went back and forth between both parties many times but no final decision has been made regarding the Campground. Discussions are ongoing.

Thorsby Communities in Bloom MOU draft

The MOU outlines the purpose, objectives, responsibilities, budget, grant funding, and terms of agreement. To be effective both parties must sign the agreement. Discussions are ongoing.

One concern raised by a resident was the CIB Shed which has to be relocated out of the Town of Thorsby's compound due to safety concerns. The Town offered help in finding a suitable location and moving the shed and a suitable location may have already been found.

The CAO & CFO were clear that all agreements with groups that are asking for taxpayer dollars have the same base type of agreement including providing the Town with current audited financial statements.

Thorsby Network of Trails

It was addressed that there is no MOU for all Trails in the "Back Country" North of the Lift Station and they are addressing this issue. Technically right now its private property and not for public use.

February Report from the CAO

The community Animator Ms. Rempel and the CAO Donna Tona worked on a grant application through the ARMH to bring a wellness event to the Town in November. The grant notification of approval should be presented sometime in April. Also discussed was the opportunity for Community Engagement of Town residents regarding the trail systems. The CAO has initiated a Trails advisory opportunity for Thorsby residents to engage and express their opinions and suggestions.

Thorsby FCSS Update

Mikayla Liebel is pleased to announce that the GO-GIRL program is currently in the works and is planned for April 29, 2023. This is for all girls ages 7-17.

February Report from the CFO

UPDATE ON DAVIN

After Davin's accident, he spent 103 days in the hospital between the U of A and Glenrose Rehabilitation Hospital. He has been home now nearly 2 months and is settling into new daily routines. Davin travels to Edmonton 2-3 times a week for outpatient Physical and Occupational Therapy and also to participate in a research study for FES cycling therapy. **(Check out FES Cycling on the old google, it's very interesting)** As part of Davin's therapy, he has just started

participating in wheelchair basketball and rugby. Weekends allow Davin to take some time to relax from his busy week. Davin is able to take in a few outdoor activities he has always enjoyed like fishing, making the weekend dump runs and even went for a couple short rides on ski-doo. We still have some modifications to do on the skidoo to make things easier for Davin, but he's determined to not let the wheelchair slow him down.



SHOULD YOU TRANSFER LAND INTO YOUR CHILDREN'S NAMES WHEN CREATING YOUR ESTATE PLAN?

A question that we often hear at West of the 5th Law is whether it's a good idea for parents to transfer land into their children's name as a means of planning for the transfer of assets to their children upon the parent's deaths. It is a popular idea, and there may be circumstances where it is a good thing to do, however, in Alberta for most people, the answer is that it's not a good idea. There are 4 reasons for why:

1. Joint ownership means joint liability.

Your children may be good people, but as we all know, bad things happen to good people. If your child's name is on your land and your child ends up being sued for money then the creditors may be able to take your land in satisfaction of your child's debt.

2. Reduction in control over assets that parents may need.

By putting your child's name on title to your land you cannot sell it without your child's permission, it also grants your children the right to keep half of the money when it's sold. Most people believe that sharing control with their children won't be an issue, however, when money is involved it can really begin to hurt relationships; along with the rise in elder abuse it's generally advisable to retain as much control for as long as possible.

3. Taxes

If you leave land to your kids in your Will, then your estate will pay the taxes on the increase in value from when you bought it to when you died. Your estate will likely also have access to substantial amounts of capital gains exemptions which can be used to reduce the actual taxes paid. If your kids' names are on title before you pass, then your children will likely not have access to your lifetime capital gains exemption and so will need to pay the capital gains taxes themselves when they either sell the property or pass it on to their kids.

4. No real benefit.

In Alberta, there is no inheritance tax, the highest government fee is \$500 for filing the application for probate. The lawyer's fee will likely increase by a small amount as it is often determined as a percentage of the estate, but that percentage is significantly smaller than what you and your kids may end up paying in extra taxes because of this decision.

Estate planning is a complicated task and most people require the assistance of a team of professionals, not just lawyers, but accountants and wealth advisors as well. 




