Public Works Open House

Proclamation for Public Works Week is May 21-27. On Wednesday May 24th, from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm there will be an Open House at the Water Treatment Plant including a tour and BBQ.

Intermunicipal Development Plan

Every 4 years there is a Municipal review between Leduc County and the Town of Thorsby regarding the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework. A letter from Rebecca Shulz, Minister of Municipal Affairs reminded Thorsby of the updated resolution of future projects, land development, shared services, and agreements. There will be two different public hearings in May for discussions. A motion was passed to repeal and replace the bylaw. All in favour. Carried

Update on RCMP Retroactive Salary Costs

In the most recent Federal budget, it will not be meeting the request to absorb the retro active costs associated with the latest RCMP collective bargaining agreement. We are a Town of a population around 1000 and we are unable to know if the Municipality of Thorsby will have to subsidize the RCMP services. There are no guarantees that Thorsby will not have to pay. Writing letters to our MLA and MP and posting on our website and local paper was encouraged.

Audit 2022

The auditors met with our CAO and CFO on May 5th and determined the 2021 Audit balanced. It was discussed in Council on May 13. The 2022 audit will be completed and on June 2 they will meet with the auditors. There were two different accounting programs used in 2021, Quickbooks and Great Plains. It has taken the CFO many hours to merge the two programs into one Municipal accounting system which is GP (Great Plains). There will be a special Audit meeting on June 6th at 7:00 pm in the Council Chambers. Cindy Van Leest has worked very diligently to determine that over the last 10 years Thorsby has lost 1.3 million dollars.

Thorsby has two Water Licences

Good news - Thorsby accessed their Water licence in 1995 for \$20,000. This allowed access to the North Saskatchewan River by way of a water line. Imperial Esso initially sold the water licence to Thorsby. In 1951 a water licence was given to

Thorsby to access the raw water in Weed Creek and the sewage lagoon. Details of the agreements are outlined and found at the Town office. For many years Water Licences were not available for communities to purchase so ours are very valuable and will never expire!

We have a water allocation and water treatment facility that uses 6-11% of its capacity. It should run at 75%. The Town is exploring options for becoming a regional water service provider to not only the Town of Thorsby, but the Village of Warburg, the Village of Breton, the Hamlet of Mulhurst Bay and other communities within Leduc County and the County of Wetaskiwin. Several communities are interested.

Select Engineering has conducted a front-end engineering study, and a proposal on behalf of WaterSMART Solutions Ltd. who has expertise in provincial regulatory system water licensing as well as familiarity with municipal water, wastewater, and stormwater management systems.

Dentons Law Firm has provided their legal assistance. Dentons have confirmed ownership of the Waterline and right of way and have offered to explore funding. A motion was made to pay Dentons Law Firm \$10,000 for Legal fees and in turn they have offered to meet with Federal Ministers and hopefully obtain funding. All in favour. Carried

What are the risks for Thorsby?

Time & effort, slow process, looking for partners, looking for Government assistance, knowing the right connections.

What are the rewards for Thorsby?

Possibly a no tax policy in the future...

Profits for future water sales will go towards Thorsby's underground infrastructure.

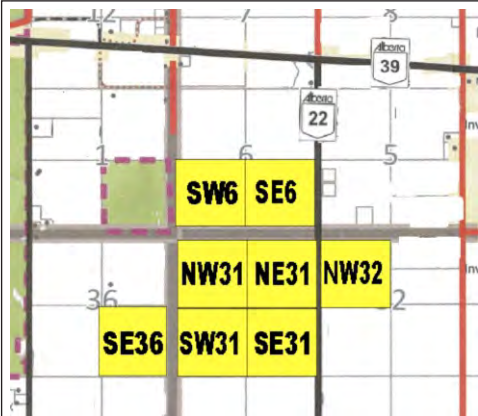

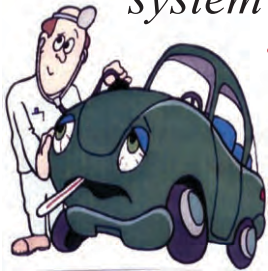
