NEW SKILLED TRADES COLLEGIATE SCHOOL COMING TO CALMAR

Nisku, Alberta (May 5, 2023) - The Black Gold School Division is excited to announce that it recently received notification of funding approval from Alberta Education for an addition to Calmar Secondary School that will house the Calmar Secondary Collegiate School.

Construction on the new school has begun and the facility is expected to be completed next fall for the start of the 2024 - 2025 school year.

"The Board's goal with this new collegiate school is to maintain a strong focus on career exploration, readiness, and preparation for a meaningful career path for our student population," said Board Chair Esther Eckert. "We want to increase awareness and create opportunities for students to take courses in the skilled trades. Reducing barriers to entry into apprenticeships can lead to highly rewarding careers in the trades needed to support Alberta's growing economy."

A collegiate school offers specialized programming in a particular subject or field, and provides all students with a clear pathway into post-secondary education and careers in their chosen field, whether in the skilled trades route or other pathways.

The primary focus of the Calmar Secondary Collegiate School will be to provide students the opportunity to complete their first period apprenticeship training and related work/registered apprenticeship program placements as part of their high school graduation. The school will continue to provide excellent academic

programming as well as providing specialized programming for students in grades 7-12 for careers in the skilled trades (enhanced career explorations, work experience and/or registered apprenticeship programs)

In the first year, the focus will be on carpentry, electrical and plumbing. Grade 12 students enrolled in the trades pathway will work on projects such as bunkies (small cabins under 108 sq. ft.) and eventually tiny houses, which will be marketed to local communities.

Calmar Secondary Collegiate School will continue to offer a full range of academic programming. Students who choose not to pursue the skilled trades pathway can take courses in business, finance, management and entrepreneurship; fine arts and design studies; sports; technology, and more. They will also play a central role in marketing the projects made in-house.

Currently, the Division has in place a robust Dual Credit program that supports students in their transition to post-secondary; however, until now there has been a gap in dual credit programming for students who choose to enroll in an apprenticeship program. The new collegiate school addition and our partnership with Northern Lakes College will open up new pathways and opportunities for students across the Division and beyond.

"Students in our rural schools have historically lacked access to the degree of specialized programming available in our urban schools, due to the lack of lab spaces, equipment, and scheduling challenges," said Curriculum Manager Terri Reid. "The collegiate school will be close to the Nisku Business Park, centrally located within our school division and easily accessible to partner school authorities, business and industry."

The Black Gold School Division welcomes other school divisions and First Nations education authorities across the province to enter into agreements with Black Gold for their students to attend Calmar Secondary Collegiate School alongside Black Gold students. FLOWER WATERING CONTRACT 2023 SEASON

Thorsby Communities In Bloom is currently looking for a passionate community minded individual to water all the planters for the 2023 Summer Season in the Town of Thorsby.

The Responsibilities Include:

- Work directly with Thorsby Communities In Bloom to achieve a beautiful planter display.
- Watering all plants in the planters once a week and fertilizing as scheduled by CIB.
- June will include surface planter watering till plants are established.
- July, August, September will include filling the water reservoirs that are built into the planters.
- Estimated time is 3 hours per watering. If extreme warm weather occurs, 2 waterings may be required as per direction of CIB.
- The contractor will be responsible for all weeding of the planters throughout the season if it is required.
- The contractor must have a valid Thorsby Business License for 2023 along with proof of WCB and Liability Insurance (minimum \$1 million).
- Use of the utility trailer will be provided for the summer that has a watering tote, water pump, hose, and wand on it.
- Water and fertilizer are provided by Thorsby CIB.
- Watering the plants may start as early as the last week in May and run till the last week in September weather dependent. This would mean the contractor would be required to water 17 times throughout the season.
- The contractor must provide their own vehicle to pull the utility trailer.






