Seniors' Week – June 5 to 11

During the first full week of June, show your appreciation for Alberta's seniors and all that they contribute to Alberta. Since 1986, Seniors' Week has celebrated and recognized the contributions seniors make to enhance the quality of life in Alberta. Check in with your local FCSS office to find events happening in your community.

Seniors Assisted Transportation

Beginning in fall 2023, Leduc County is launching a pilot project that will subsidize transportation services for seniors. We are partnering with Drive Happiness to provide this service, which will be available to seniors residing in Leduc County including the communities of Warburg, Thorsby and Calmar. Eligible seniors will be able to apply for the subsidy, which will provide up to ten free round-trip rides per year to seniors older than 80 years of age for medical, recreational, social or supportive needs. Seniors 65 to 79 years will be eligible for five free round-trip rides for medical appointments.

Right now, we are looking to find volunteer drivers. Drive Happiness is looking for generous, compassionate individuals to volunteer their time driving seniors. You choose when, where, and how often you drive; you create your own volunteer schedule; and Drive Happiness provides a gas reimbursement. Thorsby Library is closed on Saturdays now until fall, as most people are enjoying other forms of recreation. Please visit us during our weekday hours of Tuesday 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM, Wednesday 12:00 Noon - 6:00 PM, Thursday 12:00 Noon - 7:00 PM, Friday 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM.

Earlier there was an invitation made to encourage you to put your name on a list of volunteers for programming at the library. Thank you to the people who have signed up! We will contact you throughout the year based on your availability and interests. A major volunteer opportunity I want to shed light on is Library Board Member. The Town of Thorsby Library Board is in charge of overseeing the library and information services provided to the Thorsby Library Community. Our community includes people who live in Thorsby, Leduc County, Pigeon Lake and other places. Public library boards are independent entities in the province of Alberta, which means that even though Thorsby Town Council appoints the Library Board, Council does not give direction as to how the library is run. The Library sets our own Plan of Service, and we request a yearly budget allocation, which Town Council either approves or denies as they wish. The library is also funded by Leduc County, Province of Alberta, and generous individual donors.

Each year the library looks for new volunteer board members in September, to serve a three-year term. The Library Board may have up to ten members, and the responsibilities include a minimum of one meeting per month (except for the summer), as well as volunteer roles as is necessary. In early September, the Library Board will put out a call for board members (also called library trustees). The process is to gather people who are interested in serving as a library trustee. If, for example, we have 4 people interested and only 2 openings, the Library Board will match the skills of those people applying with the needs of the Board at that time, and make recommendations to Council, keeping in mind that Town Council has complete authority to appoint whomever they want to the Library Board.

All this background is intended to encourage those interested to consider, over the next few months, and apply to be a Library Trustee in early September. If you want to see what our meetings are like ahead of time, please contact me about attending our June meeting, on the third Wednesday of the month, June 21 at 7:00 PM. 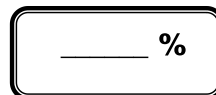



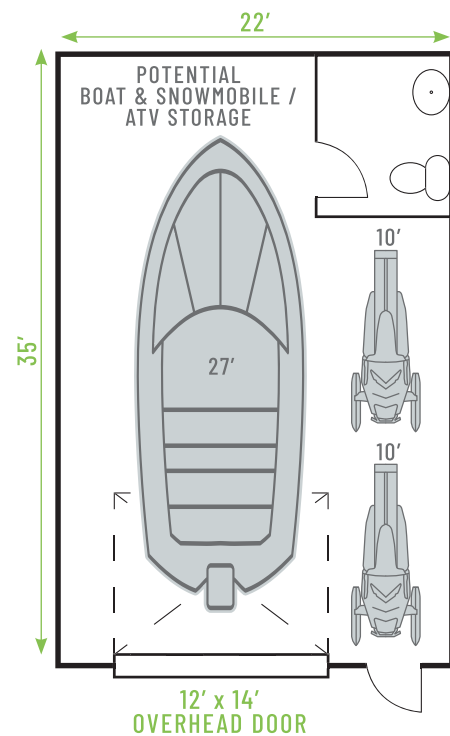

A Future I Will Get Behind

The best leaders aren't the ones who spend their time simply talking about how to fix a problem - they're the ones who roll up their sleeves and do it.

With the help of community members, Andrew worked to deliver drinks and food to the firefighters and other frontline responders at the tactical base near Trestle Creek. He also helped rally heavy equipment operators to put them in touch with the fire response for more support. He even joined the Safety First team and helped to monitor for hotspots.

In the last few days, he delivered flowers to a group of seniors who were evacuated. He took supplies to multiple groups who were struggling, he continued to work to support business owners who needed information.

The problem with Andrew is if I didn't write this, no one would ever know it happened.

This election is a simple choice between the talkers and the doers. I want someone who will do the right thing, not go with the flow, and someone who actually cares about the world around him.

That's why making my choice in this election was simple. That's why it should be simple for you.

That's why I stand with Andrew.

Thomas Lukaszuk, former conservative Deputy Premier of Alberta and Allan A Warrack, a former Progressive Conservative MLA and cabinet minister are both endorsing Rachel Notley in the upcoming provincial election. Why would dedicated conservatives support an NDP candidate for Premier of Alberta?

Notley appeals to former PC's because she represents the political centre, is a careful steward of Alberta's resources and facilitated the Trans Mountain pipeline expansion project and many have observed that her governance is similar to that of Peter Lougheed.

On the other hand, the UCP bears little resemblance to past conservative governments. In recent years, the conservative movement itself has been shifting gradually toward the right. However, the individuals presently controlling the UCP are more radical than any previous government, yet continue to brand themselves as conservatives.

In 2020 The Canadian Association of Journalists (CAJ) bestowed upon the Government of Alberta the "Code of Silence Award for Outstanding Achievement in Government Secrecy". Silence, Distraction through chaos, blaming the Federal government or the Opposition, twisting the truth and outright lying are all strategies this government has used while calling itself conservative. Albertans are waking up to see that this is not the government they anticipated.

I will share a few examples: (For more information search 'UCP Cuts and Impacts' on Facebook.)

- The UCP blame higher utility costs on the NDP ending the use of coal when, in fact, costs went up when the UCP took the NDP cap off of utility bills.
- The UCP say that Albertans will never pay to see a doctor, yet I know Albertans who are already paying to see physicians through programs such as 'Maple'.
- After Danielle Smith's assertion during the debate that the NDP caused \$183,000 jobs to be lost was quickly refuted by Trevor Tombe, economist, who confirms that actually 42,400 jobs were added during the NDP's governance.

- Kenney's lifting of pandemic restrictions was not based on science, and he failed to reimpose measures despite the rise of covid-19 infections and hospitalizations. Alberta had a higher death rate per capita than other provinces.
- The percentage of funding to charter schools is three times higher under Danielle Smith's UCP government than that allotted to public schools. Sounds a lot more like neoliberal capitalism than conservatism to me! Neoliberal capitalists are known to defund public services to the point that they become less effective while propping up private services, so they look more attractive to voters.

I could go on and on, but I think I have made the point that the NDP are both more conservative and more progressive than the UCP.
