

TAX NOTICES ARE OUT!

Keep an eye out in the mail for your 2023 tax notices. If you do not receive your notice in a timely manner, please feel free to come into the Town Office, with **proof of identification**, to receive a copy of your tax notice.

If you are waiting for land titles to process, please contact the Town Office as you may not receive your tax notice before June 30th.

If you are not a registered land title holder of a property, subject to FOIP, the Town will be unable to provide information regarding **tax notices**. These are not the same as tax assessments, which is publicly available information and can be found on the Town website.

Please note taxes are due on **June 30th** of every vear.

If you are looking for a way to spread out payments over time, with <u>no penalties</u>, sign up for the Tax Installment plan can be done at any time over at the Town Office during regular business hours. Feel free to call the office for more information on how the Tax Installment plan can help you with taxes every year.

If you make your tax payments online, please remember to give 2-3 business days for the payment to reach us. The Town does not take tax payments via credit card.

FIRE RESTRICTION IN EFFECT

S. 546(2) (b) take action or measure to mow the property at the expense of the owner. The only exceptions will be severe drought and/or excessive rain.

Adopt Leduc County/Town of Thorsby Intermunicipal Development Plan and Repeal Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework between Leduc County and Town of Thorsby

TUESDAY, JUNE 13, 2023 AT 1:45 P.M.

In 2019. Leduc County and the Town of Thorsby worked collaboratively with input from the community to prepare an Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP) and an Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework (ICF). Policies in the IDP and ICF require that these documents be reviewed every 4 years to ensure that the principles. policies, and intermunicipal service delivery remain current. In keeping with this requirement, Councils for Leduc County and the Town of Thorsby reviewed the IDP and ICF and are proposing minor revisions, primarily housekeeping in nature, to both the IDP and the ICF. As the MGA now allows municipalities party to an ICF to each approve the ICF by resolution, Leduc County and the Town of Thorsby are proposing to repeal the ICF and approve the updated ICF by resolution to streamline processes.

Details of the proposed bylaws to repeal and replace the Leduc County/Town of Thorsby IDP and repeal the ICF between Leduc County and the Town of Thorsby can be found on the County's website on the public participation opportunities web page. 



TIPS for Great Grilling

This summer let your kitchen be lonely. Turn your oven off and take your family outdoors to fire up the grill for sizzling, healthy, meals on a sunny day. TOPS club encourages the nutritious alternative of cooking on a grill.

Get creative and don't just use the grill for meats. Add vegetables and fruits to add more texture and flavor to the meal.

Using a grill basket is a great way to grill peppers, zucchini, sweet potato slices and even corn on the cob.

For a sweet dessert, try grilling pineapple and papaya slices. These tasty fruits are a great way to end an outdoor meal. Add a little cinnamon for increased sweetness.

Healthy Grilling Tips

Keep food out of the danger zone (4 C and 60 C) Bacteria can multiply quickly if food is kept in this temperature zone. Keep hot foods hot, using a meat thermometer to check the internal temperature. Keep cold foods below 4 C by keeping them in coolers that have adequate ice.

Cook beef to a minimum of 160 F or until the center is no longer pink and juices are clear. Cook ground poultry to 165 F and poultry parts to 180F.

Marinades are great to reduce the charring of meats, which reduces the risk of developing Heterocyclic Amines (HCA's). These food components can increase risk of certain forms of cancer.

Marinades that contain red wine, beer, or fruit juice (such as papaya or pineapple juice will tenderize the meat and prevent charring from taking place. This may reduce the amount of HCA's produced by an estimated 90%.

Use a marinate that contains lemon, lime juice or vinegar. The acidic nature of these marinades will reduce the amount of Advanced Glycation End Products 9AGE's) that are formed. AGE's can cause inflammation in the body and increase risk of chronic

diseases such as cancer, heart disease, diabetes, and stroke.

Never reuse marinades that have been used for raw meat, chicken, or fish.

Trim excess from meat before grilling to lower the fat in the end product.

Grilling Turkey-Add Flavor with Adding Fat

Lean ground turkey breast may be a good alternative to ground beef. It is important to read the labels when buying ground turkey products. Look for products that are at least 93% fat free.

Healthy BBQ Sauce

1 cup low sodium ketchup

1T. brown sugar

2t. chili powder

1 t. vinegar

½ cup onion, minced

½ t. garlic powder

1 T. butter

Directions: Sauté onion with butter until golden brown

Mix all remaining ingredients with onion.

Bring to a boil, then simmer for 20 minutes.

Add extra chili powder or hot pepper sauce.


