a Little Bit Of Thorsby History THORSBY LIBRARY

When Thorsby was just a hamlet, the Ladies Aid Society started a reading club and loaned out books for 10 cents each. They had a collection of 25 books and they were stored originally in the office of the United Church, and then later in the Rolston Building on Main Street.

In 1965, the United Church Women started a lending library with about 200 books, and books were also borrowed from the Extension Library for the cost of \$5.00 for a box of 30 books, which could be kept for 3 months and loaned out to members.

In 1967, meetings to organize a formal community library were held with the community members and the Supervisor of the Libraries of Alberta. Donations were solicited from organizations in the Village and area, with the goal of being eligible for matching provincial government grants. A library board was established and on March 9th, 1968, the Thorsby Community Library was officially opened. Later the Village agreed to be responsible for the rent and the

library assumed the cost of books and supplies, actively raising money in the community for those needs. The library was located in the Action Center which was formerly the first school built in Thorsby.

Yellowhead Regional Library was formed in 1970 and Thorsby became a member, benefitting from their services and funding. When the Thorsby



Recreation Complex was opened in 1981, the library moved to the recreation complex and expanded their selection of materials to loan to patrons and services available. In 2016, the library checked out an average of 788 books per month and had 1386 active patrons.
