LEDUC WEST ANNUAL EXPOSITION 2023

This weekend the Leduc West Antique Society which is located west of Leduc 1 km off Highway 39 (49541 RR260) will be having its annual exposition. One unique feature is the Callaway descendants marking the 100th anniversary of their immigration to the Thorsby district in 1923. The camp wagon they rode on their journey, which had been restored in 2000, will be in the parade on Saturday. Lowell Ross submitted this story:

"While her husband P.B. Callaway finished tending his last crop before immigrating to Alberta, Maud Callaway got a head start in the summer of 1923 with a homebuilt camp wagon and team of horses for the arduous 600 mile trip to Leduc from far south of Spokane, Washington.

This was an ambitious, possibly reckless trip for a 39-year-old mother of two young teenage daughters, Helen and Edith who rode horseback, and her little 3 year old Gwendolyn, as well as 25 milk cattle. The venture was overland through Spokane, Sandpoint, Bonners Ferry, and on to Kingsgate. The final leg from Kingsgate to Leduc was via rail with camp wagon, cattle and effects loaded on to rail cars.

They arrived many weeks later in Leduc, tired but alive. The old wagon was stored on the Callaway farm property southwest of Thorsby but deteriorated badly over the

passing years. Eventually it found its way to Fort Edmonton but did not have as cheduled date for restoration so the Ross family was able to retrieve the wagon. Gwen Callaway Ross funded the

wagon restoration in 2000 which included such contents as—bed, stove, cream separator, cream can, etc.

This year marks the Centennial of this unique immigration. We'll hopefully see the great-grandaughters Kianna and Brooklyn Green of Maud Callaway riding in the camp wagon during the Leduc West Antique Society's annual exposition parade on Saturday, July 22. Gwendolyn, at age 93, last rode the

wagon in the 2013 parade which marked the 90th anniversary. With the prohibitive cost of liability in surance, we'll draw the wagon with a small tractor rather than with a team of horses."

Council Highlights

The Council and Administration of Thorsby are pleased to provide Council Highlights every two weeks. Here are the highlights of July Committee of the Whole

July 11, 2023 at 7 p.m.

- Administration and the Mayor have been discussions with Petrus regarding their water needs and their water station at the Town reservoir
- The Financial reports were approved at a Special meeting in June to approve the 2022 Financial statements. The Town did not have to request a Ministerial order this year to extend, and all paperwork has been filed with the Alberta Government
- We have a new librarian, Paula Bosse. Please drop in and give her a warm Thorsby welcome
- Vacant lot and un-mowed residential lots are being monitored for compliance. So far, the Town has only a few offenders for visits from Administration. Please keep up the great work
- 4 files have been referred to the Calmar Community Peace Officer for follow-up and advisement
- The CAO congratulated the Lions Club for the hard work in cleaning up all the foliage and underbrush from the Thorsby Lions Campground Sign. It looks great.
- The electronic sign is awaiting all the line locates. You will notice the poles are out and two orange lines are marked for the screw piles to go in to hold up the sign. Updates will come as things are happening
- Administration is taking pothole calls and are being as proactive as we can. We acknowledge that the worst offending road needs to be rebuilt as it is crumbling even under our equipment. At this time all we can do is keep the gravel in the holes as it is the most economical solution, not the preferred one.
- New pumps and rebuilt ones at the water intake are on the capital budget and have grants attached so we can accomplish a great deal of work this summer. As well, the sewage lift station pumps will be rebuilt and a new one purchased as well. This is exciting for the Town as they are worn out and it's only a matter of time that they fail.

- New water readers will be going on your meters so that we can start reading from our offices and provide better monitoring service to everyone. There will be new features that we will educate you on once they are installed. As well, we may be able to install actual new meters to the biggest offending meters that are causing us the most concern as to their age and serviceability. Stay tuned.
- During the rain, it's important to know that our treatment operator Dave is always monitoring. For example, in the last rain fall on June 19, we were required to open the bypass valve at the lift station at 7 p.m. The level came up fast and submerged the sensor. Our operator called the provincial regulator and received a contravention number (this means we have to discharge into weed creek over and above our regular approved time). This is standard procedure. As well we had to throttle back the valve at 1 p.m. on the 19th of June as the system was still full and would have gradually flooded basements if it was completely closed. There is no science to this, just operator experience.
- Council and Administration are starting the budget process in August this year (right on time for the Provincial requirements) and that is a great accomplishment.
- Council as well will be very supportive of your ideas for a 75th Thorsby celebration before the end of December so that they can deliberate it for the budget. Please get your suggestions into Donna at dtona@thorsby.ca
- And we fixed a water main break on 52 avenue very successfully.





KEEPING KIDS SPORTS AFFORDABLE

Alberta families and non-profit organizations can now apply for funding from the Every Kid Can Play program.

Sports play an important role in the early stages of a child's life. They teach teamwork, build confidence and promote healthy lifestyles that can last well into adulthood. Unfortunately, registration fees can make participation in sports unaffordable for too many families.

Albertans can now apply for funding from the Every Kid Can Play program to access affordable sport, physical activity and recreation programs for children and teens. To support the program's success, Alberta's government is providing \$3 million to KidSport Alberta to subsidize registration costs for families that are struggling financially.

"Sport and recreation opportunities should be affordable and accessible for all, especially young children and youth. We are committed to supporting initiatives that makes access easier for families, helping to build healthy and fit communities through sport and recreation." Joseph Schow, Minister of Tourism and Sport

Introduced in Budget 2023 with a commitment of \$8 million, the Every Kid Can Play program is funded by the Government of Alberta and administered in part by KidSport Alberta. The program increases access and affordability for families across Alberta with kids and teens participating in sports and recreational activities. Through KidSport Alberta, families can apply for support to offset registration fees.

Provincial and community non-profit organizations can apply for grant funding to increase access to sports and recreation programs. Every Kid Can Play is expected to provide direct financial support to more than 8,500 children and youth and support up to 200 child and youth-focused community-level programs throughout Alberta. Applications are now open.

"The benefits of sport extend beyond the field and too many families miss out on the social, mental, emotional and physical health benefits of physical activity due to financial barriers. With the support of the Government of Alberta, KidSport is determined to give every child and youth the opportunity to find and reclaim the joy of sport. The Every Kid Can Play program will provide equal access to sports in our province and drive lasting change for kids, their families and communities." This program will not only support individual participation, by making programming more affordable and accessible, it will also strengthen the MNP Community & Sport Centre through increased use, thus extending the reach and benefit of the program." QUICK FACTS

- Applications open on July 18 for both families applying for government support through KidSport, and communities and provincial non-profit organizations that provide sport and recreation programs, applying on the Government of Alberta's website.
- KidSport Alberta will administer grants of up to \$350 per child registration to eligible families to assist with program costs for sport programs across the province. The family income eligibility is the federal low-income cut-off guideline plus 50 per cent.
- The deadline for non-profit organization applications is Sept. 30.
- The \$8 million in funding is broken down as follows:
 - \$3 million to help eligible families to offset registration fees.
 - \$3 million for grants to provincial scope nonprofit organizations.
 - \$2 million for grants to community-level nonprofit organizations.


