CANADA'S POPULATION MAY DOUBLE TO 80 MILLION IN 26 YEARS

Submitted by James Kohut, champion for legalized real democracy.

Canada's population may double to 80 million in 26 years based on current 2.7% growth rate.

The Chief Statistician of Canada, Anil Arora, in the 2023 Manion Lecture (see www.youtube.com/watch?v=nm4r99ExphY time 19:00 minutes approximately) stated that Canada's population will double in the next 26 years based on our current 2.7% population growth, which is primarily immigration fed. Like compound interest, this will mean our population will grow undemocratically by 40 million people in the next 26 years to 80 million people and this will create many negative disruptions to the way we live.

The social ramifications from our Federal Government's undemocratic policy to grow the population so fast is going to be a major disruption for most Canadians and this will lead to ongoing inflation in many areas, particularly in real estate and rents. It is unlikely the government will build enough housing for the people when the population grows 2.7% per year and the costs will be horrendous and lead to greater deficits, reduced government services and likely higher taxes unless the government seeks out greater non tax revenues through crown corporations. If you think our cities, institutions and parks are crowded now and housing is expensive, just wait a few more years or so. It is going to be very tough on young and senior Canadians in the future as a result of our "Liberal Conservative NDP majority government" undemocratic desire to grow the population so excessively, against the wishes of Canadians.

Increased population will lead to a great degradation of Canada's environment as our history record has shown. More forests will be clearcut, greenbelts will disappear, more air and water pollution will occur, natural environments will be overrun with people which will lead to extinctions of wildlife, more animals and fish will be poached for cheap food, less farmland will be available for crops and so many more other environmental problems will occur. With a higher population, there will be less freedom of movement in our parks and wild areas as congestion will be controlled by governments. Many parks will have restrictions on travel by foot and car.

The more people that come into Canada, the less resource wealth per capita will occur. Consider if Alberta's population doubled today how oil will no longer be counted on to balance budgets with oil revenues. Increased population will lead to increased taxes to pay for social programs, -taxes such as provincial sales taxes which Alberta does not have currently. The former Mayor of Calgary Nenshi said the higher the city's population grows, the higher the taxes go to pay for upgrading and building new infrastructure. It is the people in cities that will likely face the highest tax burdens via property taxes with massive population growth. This will lead to higher rents as landlords will increase rents to pay for tax increases while also taking advantage of low rental space availability with massive influxes of people. This is not the Canada the people want.

First Nations have not been consulted or accommodated in regards to the Federal Government's massive immigration policy which will reduce their natural food supplies with more people overrunning their traditional lands. More people in

Canada will lead to more food foraging, hunting and poaching which will disrupt First Nation's traditional holistic food supplies. First Nations deserve a say on immigration levels but the Federal Government will not allow that. Every single First Nations and Inuit person should be given a right to vote in a democratic referendum on immigration levels along with every Canadian citizen.

If Canadians lived in a legalized real democracy, where you have the legalized right to introduce and vote on government bills, you can bet that Canadians would not accept such a high population growth rate in Canada due to immigration and Canadians would set the immigration rate at a level they are comfortable with rather than our anti-democratic colluding government parties which are bribe and foreign influenced.

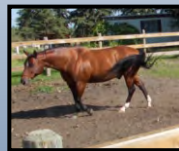
