## DO YOU RECOGNIZE THIS FOOTBALL TEAM?

In 1975, sponsored by Vern Muth Sales, the T.W. Bearcats began playing tackle football with the Edmonton and District Bantam Football League. Players from Thorsby and Warburg practiced in Thorsby and played games on the Kinsmen Field in Edmonton, coached by Sam Kobeluck.

According to the "T.W. Bearcats Thorsby Bantam Football Team" booklet, in 1975 Sam Kobeluck won coach of the year while player Phil Pichonsky won most Sportsmanlike player. In 1976, now in grade 11, Phil became the defensive coach while fellow grade 11 student Rick Harding coached offense and Constable P. Hays was their trainer.

The Bearcat team made Leduc Representative headlines throughout the mid to late 1970's. In a story from November 30, 1977 the communities of Thorsby and Warburg honored their local Football team at a supper in the Ukrainian hall in Thorsby. Here are few highlights...The team was congratulated by sponsor Vern Muth, Gordon Bernes (Deputy Mayor of Thorsby), John Rovinsky (Thorsby Lions Club) and other locals. Mr Dave Ross on behalf of president A. McKenzie and Pioneer Branch No 144 Thorsby Legion commented that if everyone cooperates as the Thorsby and Warburg boys do, Canadians would not have to worry about confederation. Joe Sieben who had been the master of ceremonies was also presented a plaque, trophy and sweater for his managing abilities, publicity and fundraising skills. Coach Sam Kobeluck presented Ernie Tremblay, assistant coach, with his coaches' whistle after 4 years of coaching. The Thorsby and District

#### Number of rides

Seniors 65 years to 79 years are eligible for five free round trips for medical appointments.

Seniors 80 years and older are eligible for 10 free round trips for medical, recreational, social or supportive needs.

#### Memberships

All program participants are required to purchase a Drive Happiness annual membership. Membership fees are determined by Drive Happiness and are based on household income.

The cost of transportation can be a barrier for many rural seniors. Leduc County FCSS provides a subsidy to eligible older adults aged 65+ who need transportation for medical appointments. Drive Happiness is a non-profit that provides safe, reliable and affordable assisted transportation to low-resource seniors.

If you are a senior who needs a ride to a medical appointment or who prefers not to drive in the city, this program could be for you. If you have ever gone for a medical test or procedure that prevented you from driving, you may need a ride and this program could help!

#### Eligibility

- 1. At least 65 years of age
- 2. Resident of Leduc County, Town of Calmar, Town of Thorsby, or Village of Warburg
- 3. Have sufficient mobility to enter and exit vehicles independently

#### Number of rides

- Seniors 65 years to 79 years are eligible for five free round trips for medical appointments.
- Seniors 80 years and older are eligible for 10 free round trips for medical, recreational, social or supportive needs.

#### Memberships

All program participants are required to purchase a Drive Happiness annual membership. Membership fees are determined by Drive Happiness and are based on household income.







## SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY LEADS TO CHARGES

Media Relations RCMP Alberta

Leduc, Alta. – On Aug. 31, 2023 at approximately 1:35 a.m., Leduc RCMP received a report of suspicious activity where a person was observed removing a licence plate from a vehicle parked at a business on Sparrow Drive in Leduc.

Police made patrols in the area, located the suspect vehicle and a traffic stop was initiated. A licence plate query showed the plate was not a match to the vehicle and the licence plate had been reported stolen out of Edmonton. The three occupants of the vehicle were arrested.

A search of the vehicle resulted in the seizure of 28 grams of cocaine, bear spray, an extendable baton and various types of ammunition.

Anthony Whitford (31), a resident of Edmonton, was arrested on a Canada wide warrant for violating conditions of his Federal parole and was charged with the following:



- 1. In the 1400s a law was set forth in England that a man was allowed to beat his wife with a stick no thicker than his thumb. Hence we have 'the rule of thumb.'
