OCTOBER IS BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

Key facts

(from www.who.int/news-room/fact-sheets/detail/breast-cancer)

- Breast cancer caused 685,000 deaths globally in 2020.
- Roughly half of all breast cancers occur in women with no specific risk factors other than sex and age.
- Breast cancer occurs in every country in the world.
- Approximately 0.5–1% of breast cancers occur in men.

Screening for Breast Cancer

(from www.cancer.ca/en/cancer-information/cancertypes/breast/screening)

Screening tests help find breast cancer before any symptoms develop. When breast cancer is found and treated early, the chances of successful treatment are better. Follow breast screening guidelines even when you feel well and healthy.

Women should be aware of the benefits and limitations of screening mammography based on their age and risk factors to help decide if it is right for them. Talk with your doctor to help make your decision.

If you are 40 to 49 years old, talk to your doctor about your risk for breast cancer, along with the benefits and limitations of having a mammogram.

If you are 50 to 74 years old, have a mammogram every 2 years.

If you are 75 or older, talk to your doctor about whether having a mammogram is right for you.



Seniors Housekeeping Subsidy

We are committed to supporting people to maintain their independence and quality of life as they age. We offer a subsidy to help seniors and adults with disabilities access affordable housekeeping services.

Eligibility

- Be a senior (65+) or an adult with a disability or inability to complete household tasks.
- Meet specified income thresholds. Income thresholds may change annually each July to reflect changes to the Seniors Financial Assistance programs provided by the Government of Alberta.
- Be a resident of Leduc County (including New Sarepta), Calmar, Thorsby or Warburg.

Services

All housekeeping services are provided by Serving Hands Senior Care Inc. Through the subsidy program, you can receive up to four hours of light housekeeping each month. Housekeeping rates are on a sliding fee scale (\$0-25/hour) based on household income and eligibility for other subsidies.
