

Warburg to get New Airport

Someday, when one of your rich friends comes for a visit, you can tell them to fly on into Warburg, that is if they have anything up to and including a D.C. 3. The old air strip will be closed this summer, (with a possible extension), due to the new subdivision which was completed this fall. Council has begun the preliminary steps to find a new location and with grants from the government and anyone else they can talk into it, they plan

of getting us a fully paved airport. It will only be a single runway, but it will be the best we have ever had.

The local flying club is quite happy and the Edmonton Para Club has already shown interest in using our area for jumps.

Plans and hopes are for partial use (grass strip) by late this summer and fall use, paved runway by the summer of 1982.

Sunnybrook Post Office to Close

The Post Office is the front of an old house. The boxes are crammed into what used to be part of the living room, and if more than one person tries to collect their mail at one time the place is overcrowded. But it is still your Post Office, and now, unless someone buys the old house and retains the Post Office or someone else sets up a new location for it you will have to go to either Thorsby or Warburg to collect your mail.

The Sunnybrook Post Office was first established in 1929 about 1 mile west of town on property now owned by Mike Zukowski and was moved into town in 1932 to where the Sunnybrook General Store is now located, and was operated by Mr. Griffin. In 1942 it was moved to its present location. For 27 years at both locations you could find Mrs. Monds working at keeping everything going right. Mrs. Monds is still a resident of Sunnybrook. In 1972 the position was filled by Mike Faluk until 1980 when Mrs. Maureen Morey took over.

It would be a shame if Sunnybrook lost its Post Office, leaving several hundred people without local mail service. Hopefully someone will either buy the existing site or find a new location for the mail outlet.



UPDATE ON THE ARRIVECAN SCANDAL

From Gerald Soroka's February 2024 Update

During the COVID-19 pandemic, the Liberal government outsourced the development of the ArriveCAN app, intended to streamline customs and immigration processes for travelers. Typically, government-developed apps cost around \$80,000, but the ArriveCAN project's expenditure ballooned to a staggering \$54 million, prompting a Conservative-led investigation into the financial discrepancies.

Scrutiny intensified as it was revealed that a significant portion of the contracts, including \$20 million awarded to GC Strategies - a company operated by just two individuals from a basement - resulted in no real work. This discovery, among others, led the Auditor General to release a report indicating the project's costs had actually exceeded \$60 million. Due to poor financial records, the true cost remains unknown.

Conservatives had opposed the app's funding from the beginning and have been proactive in seeking accountability. We have successfully passed a motion compelling GC Strategies to testify before committee or face arrest.

Furthermore, an investigation by the RCMP is underway, and a motion has been passed demanding the government disclose the total expenditures related to ArriveCAN and recollect the taxpayer money from contractors who did no work.

Our commitment to holding the NDP-Liberal government accountable is steadfast. We demand transparency and insist that those responsible for the mismanagement of taxpayer dollars, including Trudeau and his ministers, be held fully accountable.



A MOOSE HUNTERS DREAM

Never in my wildest dreams did I think that I would see five huge moose so close. We had been hunting this area for a while and we had seen the moose tracks in the snow, so we knew that they were in the area. It was a cold November day in western Alberta and the mountains in the distance were majestic as they rose from the earth and stretched toward the heavens. What a beautiful day for a walk in the masterpiece that God had created.

As normal, we each left the truck with a plan to meet at a certain time. We would each take a different area so that we could cover more territory and check for tracks. I had my gun ready and loaded with the 30:06 shells that a friend had made for me. I had rubbed the shells together in my hands to warm them a little before loading the gun, as if somehow this was going to help. With a small snack in my pocket and my gun over my shoulder I headed to the far side of a frozen marsh toward a cutline that looked like it needed exploring. It is funny, but every time I head into the forest, I always expect to see something at every turn. Every cut line, every path, every hill I mount there is the expectation that there is something there.

There could be a deer, an elk, a bear or maybe a moose just around the bend, just over the knoll. Today we were looking for a moose though. As ready as I thought I was, I was not really expecting what I saw this day.

I had walked through the snow about two hundred yards down the cut line when I heard a sound in the brush a few hundred yards ahead of me. I quickly got down on one knee and waited for further indicators that might give me a clue as to what the sound was coming from. It's funny. When you are out in the quiet of the mountains forests, even an acorn or a woodpecker sound loud. Your mind can begin to play games with you and you start to wonder if you even heard anything at all.

Standing still or sitting still in this freezing cold gets to you pretty quickly. Moving my fingers in the mitts and my toes in the boots, I regained some warmth that had been lost in crouching there. I stood to my feet and gently and methodically began to walk ahead. That is until I heard some cracking of sticks in the woods. This was no squirrel or woodpecker, nor was it a wolf. When you spend time in the forest and listening to the sounds of nature you begin to know the difference. I was frozen in my tracks, almost literally, with my eyes fixed on the trees ahead of me. Watching for something to emerge, I positioned my gun tightly on my shoulder and raised the scope to my eye.

How could one moose make so much noise, I thought. Then I saw the reason. It was just the snout at first, then the head. What a huge animal. But it was a cow moose, a female, and only the males, the bulls, were in season to

harvest. But there was another moose coming right behind this one, then another. That's right. Three cow moose a couple hundred yards away on the same cut line as me. These large animals filled the cut line and they stood and stared at me, not sure if I was a threat or not. They may have wondered where that strange little tree came from, but I remained stiff and focused on them not wanting to scare them off. Where there are cows there are usually bulls, maybe around the next corner or over the next hill. I heard a heavy deep grunt, but never saw any movement from the cows. The last of the three cows kept turning her head back to the direction that they had come from. Was she considering running out in that direction?

Then as quietly as can be a huge bull moose seemed to just appear from the trail the cows had made. My heart was about ready to leave my coat through my long johns, shirt, sweaters and coat. He walked slightly behind the one cow and I carefully kept my scope on him waiting for a clear shot. This would certainly fill our freezer and each of the hunting buddies would have a box full too. My feet were so frozen that I felt that by this time I couldn't move. Then, as quietly as that bull moose was, another huge bull with a massive rack walked right into the opening and stood side by side with the other bull.

They looked like bookends. This was my time to do what I was here for. I took a deep breath, let it out slowly and pulled the trigger. The click could be heard a mile away. Yes, I said click, not bang, boom, pop or some other descriptive word signifying the release of a bullet. However the click was plenty loud enough in the stillness of the forest to raise a red flag for these five moose. I had there undivided attention and now they were slowly beginning to head into the other side of the forest. Since that shell never fired, I had to eject it to load the other one which was ready in the chamber, but doing so was certainly going to spook them into running. There was no choice since they were getting ready to head off.

I ejected that shell and engaged another one. Now they were moving. I took aim, and click. Quicker than they had appeared, over 4,000 pounds were crashing through the forest and completely out of sight. On average an adult moose stands 5 to 6 feet tall. Males weigh from 850 to 1180 pounds and females 600 to 800 pounds.

My mouth dropped open in disbelief. So close yet so far. I followed their tracks for hours and had the others with me surround the huge section and we all looked for the rest of the day and never did see them again.

Why did my gun say click instead of bang? Turns out that my friend who packed these shells for me used a batch of bad primers. Needless to say, I never used his re-packs again. How I wish that I had my camera with me to capture this shot. It will be forever etched in my mind. Somewhere in Alberta, on a cold snow covered plateau, there are moose standing in a circle passing down this story to their calves, the story of a frozen hunter who had a gun that went click instead of boom. I think I have heard moose laughing in that area.


