Elizabeth Kugyelka

The Breton Museum board and staff were saddened to hear of the recent passing of Elizabeth (Vidok) Kugyelka. Our sincere condolences go out to her family.

A long time resident of the Funnell community, Elizabeth spent the majority of her life in the community. She married John Kugyelka in 1958 where they farmed on the Funnell Road until they retired to Vancouver Island in 2015.

Elizabeth was known for her beautiful vegetable and flower gardens that graced the farm yard. She was also an avid sewer. In later years her passion turned to quilting.

In 2005 the museum approached Elizabeth and her friend Mary Nelson to see if they would donate their talents to create a heirloom quilt, for the museum to raffle as a fund raiser, to celebrate Alberta's Centennial. The

museum supplied the materials for the quilt and their only condition was that they got to pick the pattern.

Community Volunteer Income Tax Program – FREE INCOME TAX PREPARATION - For Low Income Persons, Families, seniors and students. Although this is something that most of us would like to avoid thinking about and doing, I am afraid that this is unavoidable. You need to file your income tax each year, even if you have no income to report. By doing this you may receive benefits that you did not know you were eligible for. Also, in the event of the death of your spouse, benefits can easily be transferred to you, if you have filled a return for the last calendar year. The focus of the Community Volunteer Tax Program is to assist those individuals who have limited income. This includes seniors, families, and students. If your income is approximately in one of the following categories, you may qualify for assistance. 1 person - \$35,000 / Couple - \$45,000 / Family \$52,500

We are not able to complete returns with income from the following sources: *Capital Gains or Losses, Farming Income, Rental Income, Self-Employment, Interest exceeding \$1, 000, Bankruptcies, Deceased Persons*

This service is FREE to those who qualify. If you require this service, please gather your information, and bring it to the Village of Breton office Monday to Thursday between 8:30 – 4pm. Clients will be notified when your return is completed. The program will run until April 30.

Changes to Alberta Government Payments - Albertans who rely on the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) and Income Support programs will get their payments four business days before the first of the month. Here are the next few payment dates: **April Payment - March-25**

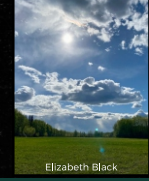

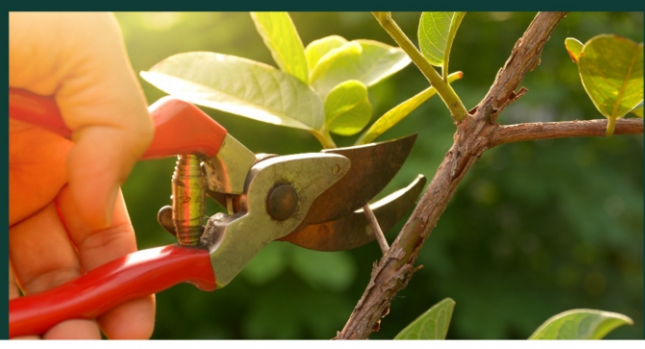



March is fraud prevention month due to increased activities surrounding the filing of taxes. Scammers love to take advantage of people in stressful times, and that doesn't only happen in March. Thorsby and Breton RCMP want to share some fraud prevention tips to help you stay protected all year!

FRAUD Prevention Tips:

- If you receive random emails asking you to click links....DON'T DO IT!!
- If you receive a text message from a random number claiming to be your child or grandchild needing help because their phone broke and they can't access their online banking....CALL THEM ON THE NUMBER YOU USUALLY DO PRIOR TO ENGAGING IN THE CONVERSATION OR SENDING MONEY!!
- If you are offered an "investment opportunity" that requires you to pay large amounts of money up front with the promise of making double or triple....RESEARCH THE COMPANY FIRST!! MOST COMPANIES ARE NOT GOING TO ASK YOU TO SEND AN E-TRANSFER!!

- If you receive emails claiming to be the CRA or your bank.....CHECK THE EMAIL ADDRESS FIRST!! Banks and the Canada Revenue Agency do not send emails asking you for money. Be safe and call before you click!!
- If you enter into a new relationship online or over the phone and the person wants to develop a quick relationship or profess their love quickly then asks you for money for travel expenses to come see you in person....DO NOT SEND MONEY ASAP!! Video call them, get to know them and make them wait. Loneliness is something scammers prey on – protect yourself and make sure you are dealing with a real person.

Fraudsters like to use time to their advantage. They will often make demands and tell you something needs to happen ASAP or the opportunity will pass. They will grill you with questions to learn more about you to use in future scams. They try to make every conversation seem genuine, but there is usually a panic element to try and make you act fast and send money before you think things over.

Not every call from an unknown number or email you receive is a fraud, but those are the most common ways to reach victims.

Things to Remember:

- You are not alone, lots of people are being victimized by fraudsters daily
- Do not be embarrassed, seek assistance right away
- Legitimate companies will never ask you to send money via iTunes or Google Play gift cards
- If someone claims to be your family, make the call and confirm
- Fraudsters work in teams, so when you hang up on one, another one will contact you claiming to want to help you and investigate the fraud – Deal with your bank and the police yourself, not with a random "helper" over the phone

The Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre collects information on fraud and identity theft. They provide information on past and current scams affecting Canadians. If you think you're a victim of fraud, report it!

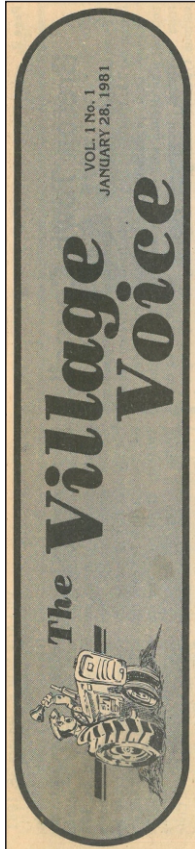
