FARM-RESTRICTED CLASS 1 LICENCE

Get a farm-restricted Class 1 driver's licence to drive to and from your farm. from www.alberta.ca

Overview

Effective April 1, 2024, eligible farmers and their family members will have the option to apply for a farm-restricted Class 1 driver's licence.

Upon successful completion of a Class 1 knowledge and road test, vision-screening, and submission of a driver's medical assessment, the driver will be issued a farmrestricted Class 1 driver's licence with condition code "P", indicating they must comply with farmer restrictions. The driver will not be required to complete pre-licensing training.

The driver must meet all other requirements of a Class 1 driver's licence, including the Air Brake (Q) endorsement. For more information, check the Air Brake Program.

Farm-restricted Class 1 drivers may also be subject to licence code restriction "N" which means the holder may not operate vehicles or combinations of vehicles which require a Class 2 or 4 driver's licence unless that person has completed the required knowledge and road tests as well as completed any other conditions of a Class 2 or 4 driver's licence.

Eligibility

- A farmer is defined as a person:
- actively and directly farming, in Alberta;
- responsible for management decisions and operating costs;
- having control of the farming assets, either by holding title to the assets or having a rental agreement with the person holding title; and
- having annual farm commodity production worth at least \$10,000 or \$5,000 to \$9,999 if the only other significant sources of income are Canada Pension Plan or Old Age Security.

For the purposes of this exemption, a farmer is a person engaged in any of the following:

the cultivation of land;

- the raising of livestock, including diversified livestock animals within the meaning of the Livestock Industry Diversification Act and poultry;
- the raising of fur bearing animals, pheasants or fish;
- the production of agricultural field crops;
- the production of fruit, vegetables, sod, trees, shrubs and other specialty horticultural crops;
- the production of eggs and milk;
- the production of honey; or
- the operation of agricultural machinery and equipment including irrigation pumps;
- the application of fertilizers, insecticides, pesticides, fungicides and herbicides, including application by ground and aerial spraying for agricultural purposes;
- the collection, transportation, storage, application, use, transfer and disposal of manure, compositing materials and compost.

A family member of a farmer who meets the above criteria is also eligible for a farm-restricted Class 1 driver's licence. "Family member" is defined as:

• the spouse or adult interdependent partner of the farmer, or whether by blood, marriage or adoption or by virtue of an adult interdependent relationship, a child, parent, grandparent, sibling, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew or first cousin of the farmer.



BRAZEAU COUNTY COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

April 2, 2024 Regular Council Meeting

Recreation Board Bylaw 1175-24

Council gave third and final reading to Bylaw 1175-24, which establishes a Drayton Valley-Brazeau County Recreation Board.

The Board will initiate and provide direction for sport, culture, and recreation programs as designated by the councils of the Town and the County, and is directly accountable to the councils. It will be made up of two County councillors, two Town councillors, and two members-at-large, one a Town resident and one a County resident.

The Board will make recommendations to the councils on the management and operation of the recreation and cultural facilities as agreed to by both the Town and County and as identified in the Recreation and Culture Cost-Sharing Agreement.

The Board is advisory and all recommendations must be approved by both councils in order to take effect.

Assessment Update

Bob Daudelin and Ray Fortin of Accurate Assessment provided Council with the County's 2023 Assessment Highlights.

In general, assessment rose across the county by about nine percent between 2022 and 2023. There were 60 new roll numbers added to the property list, and 84 development permits issued. Seventy-five new wells were drilled in 2022.

Support for Drayton Valley Pro Rodeo

Council approved in-kind support of \$1,347.75 to supply and haul sand to the Drayton Valley Omniplex for the 9th Annual Drayton Valley Pro Rodeo, May 2-5, 2024.

Changes to agricultural policies

Council approved changes to two agricultral policies, AG-2 Rental Equipment Policy and AG-4 Predator

Control Policy, based on recommendations from the Agricultrail Service Board.

Item 14 of the Rental Agreement has been amended to indicate valid insurance is required and may be requested, and that item H of the AG-2 Policy has been amended to include that the renter must have valid insurance.

The AG-4 Policy has a number of changes to keep Brazeau County's policy and program for coyote control in line with current legislative standards and organizational structures.

I believe he was originally from Ontario but in 1980 he drove a cement mixer truck for Apollo Ready Mix which was based in Warburg. Apollo had started in 1979 and in those days it shut down for the winter months. I also started at Apollo in 1980. I remember Jim talking about starting a newspaper for the local area when Apollo would shut down for the season.

This he did. I don't know if he printed and published it himself or if he had that done by someone else. Likewise I don't know if he gathered the news stories himself or if someone else reported them. There wasn't internet or emails those days so if he gathered them himself, he was a busy man.

Judging by the quality of the stories and layout of the paper, Jim must have had previous newspaper experience.

Jim didn't return to Apollo in spring of '81 and moved away after presumably finding employment elsewhere thus ending what could be called a forerunner of the Breton Booster.
